



Hall Rentals Basics

Can I Rent the Hall?

Any person over the age of 21 may rent the hall. The hall can be rented for independent group programs, presentations, and personal events such as birthday parties.

When Can I Book Hall Rentals?

Hall rentals must be booked at the Lake office. You must come into the lake office to book your rental, as we must go through a rental contract and necessary information with you.

What Do I Need to Rent the Hall?

You need your photo ID, payment for the hall rental, and a damage deposit cheque for \$400 at the minimum. If you will be having alcohol at your event, you must obtain a liquor license and Party Alcohol Liability Insurance. Proof of these must be given seven days prior to the event.

Lake Fees

Arbour Lake annual fees are overdue as of February 1, 2023. If you have not paid your fees yet, be sure to do it soon, as interest is accumulating on your overdue balance at the rate of 18% per annum, compounded monthly. Please be advised that this fee is mandatory, and you cannot opt-out of paying it. Your access to the lake is also currently denied until your fees are paid in full. Fees can be paid in person at the ALRA office by cash, cheque, debit, Visa, or MasterCard (there will be no additional charges if you pay by credit card). Fees can also be paid through online banking by adding Arbour Lake Residents Association as a payee and using the account number listed on your invoice; if you are not sure of your account number, contact the office and we can assist you.

4-H Members Learn to Shape Cakes and Hats

Making something with one's own hands can be one of the most rewarding activities. The feeling of accomplishment and satisfaction that is received can possibly make even the most challenging undertaking worth it in the end. Members of the Prairie Winds 4-H Club got to experience this feeling while attending workshops about handmade items.





One very hands-on workshop was the cake decorating workshop. Attendees were given a premade top cake and bottom cake that they decorated to make into a magical fairy house. First, members were instructed to cover the sides and top of the cake in fondant, to make the surface easier to work with. This was also done so that the delicious buttercream icing

didn't get all over everyone's hands. Next, white dots were added to the red top to make it look more like a mushroom. After this step everyone was allowed to decorate the rest of the cake in whatever way they wanted. All the fairy houses were very creative, and members were able to bring them home to eat.

Another experience for the club was touring a local hat making factory. Participants were led through the history of the factory, as well as the step-by-step process of shaping hats from the basic shape into a more elaborate one. Using steam, the hat is made much more flexible. While the shaping was reserved for the staff, called "Hatters", it was interesting to see how much care is put into making the premium hats.

Overall, members of the Prairie Winds 4-H Club were once again exposed to a variety of neat and engaging activities that require a great deal of meticulous hard work.

Lemon Chicken Salad

Nothing says fresh like lemons.

Believed to have originated about eight million years ago, lemons are a hybrid between a bitter orange and a citron. The lemon's ancestors are the mandarin orange, pomelo, and citron, but the lemon is the most used of the citrus fruits

Lemons start small and green but turn yellow as they grow and ripen. A lemon tree, properly cared for, can live up to a hundred years and can produce six hundred pounds of lemons per year. Lemons play an important economic and cultural role in our world. They are used to make medicines, beauty products, candles, cleansers, preservatives, and even invisible ink.

Regarded as one of the world's healthiest foods, lemons are rich in Vitamin C and fiber and are an important ingredient in the preparation of food such as tarts, meringues, liqueurs, the flavouring and seasoning of poultry, fish, and of course lemonade.

The acidity of lemons is perfect for salad dressings as shown in this lemon chicken salad recipe.

Prep Time: 25 minutes Cook Time: 35 minutes

Marinade Time: 6 to 24 hours

Servings: 3 to 4 **Ingredients:**

• 3 boneless, skinless chicken breasts

• 1/3 cup fresh lemon juice

- 2 garlic cloves, finely chopped
- 1 tbsp. Dijon mustard
- 1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
- 34 tsp. salt
- 1/2 tsp. coarse black pepper
- ¾ cup extra virgin olive oil
- 2 tbsp. honey
- 1 large head of organic romaine lettuce
- 1/2 pint of cherry tomatoes
- 1 cup seedless black olives
- 2 cups seasoned croutons
- 1 cup grated parmesan cheese

Directions:

 Prepare lemon dressing by combining lemon iuice. garlic, Diion mustard, Worcestershire salt, pepper, sauce. honey, and olive oil in a small bowl. Stir well or pour dressing into a small blender and blend



for about one minute. Transfer dressing into a Mason jar for easy storage.

- Place chicken breasts on a cutting board and pat dry with a paper towel. Use a mallet to flatten any parts of the breasts that are more than 34 inch thick. Transfer chicken breasts to a bowl and add 3 to 4 tablespoons of lemon dressing. Cover and refrigerate for a minimum of six hours or a maximum of 24 hours. Refrigerate remaining lemon dressing.
- Pre-heat oven to 400 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Remove chicken from marinade and place in a large non-stick frying pan. Allow the breasts to brown or caramelize, approximately two minutes on each side.
- Place browned chicken breasts on a baking sheet lined with foil. Bake uncovered until cooked, about 25 minutes or until a meat thermometer placed in the thickest part of the breast reads 165 to 170 degrees Fahrenheit. Remove from oven, cover, and let sit for about 10 minutes.
- In a large bowl, prepare salad by tearing romaine lettuce into bite size pieces. Add cherry tomatoes, olives, croutons, and lemon dressing to taste. Portion salad on four plates and add sliced chicken breasts topped with a little lemon dressing to each one. Sprinkle with parmesan cheese, garnish with lemon slices, and serve.








CONNECTIVE WELLNESS

Myofascial release is considered to be the most important and effective form of therapy in the history of healthcare.

A form of massage, it is safe, gentle and consistently effective. Using gentle sustained myofascial pressure into restrictions, pain and headaches are eliminated and the body's motion restored. Traditional massage therapy only produces limited and temporary results.




