

4-H Members Learn to Shape Cakes and Hats

Making something with one's own hands can be one of the most rewarding activities. The feeling of accomplishment and satisfaction that is received can possibly make even the most challenging undertaking worth it in the end. Members of the Prairie Winds 4-H Club got to experience this feeling while attending workshops about handmade items.





One very hands-on workshop the cake decorating workshop. Attendees were given a premade top cake and bottom cake that they decorated to make into a magical fairy house. First, members were instructed to cover the sides and top of the cake in fondant, to make the surface easier to work with. This was also done so that the delicious buttercream icing

didn't get all over everyone's hands. Next, white dots were added to the red top to make it look more like a mushroom. After this step everyone was allowed to decorate the rest of the cake in whatever way they wanted. All the fairy houses were very creative, and members were able to bring them home to eat.

Another experience for the club was touring a local hat making factory. Participants were led through the history of the factory, as well as the step-by-step process of shaping hats from the basic shape into a more elaborate one. Using steam, the hat is made much more flexible. While the shaping was reserved for the staff, called "Hatters", it was interesting to see how much care is put into making the premium hats.

Overall, members of the Prairie Winds 4-H Club were once again exposed to a variety of neat and engaging activities that require a great deal of meticulous hard work.



Spring brought renewal and awakening of Mother Earth in April. There was a three-hour interpretive walk to connect with cultural landscapes through the ages in Nose Hill Park where attendees could be closer to the stars.

The group at the John Laurie Blvd parking lot began the 2.2 km route on pathway and gravel trail. The leaders were Crystal Many Fingers, a Blackfoot member of the Kainai First Nation of Treaty 7, and Laureen Bryant, a professional archaeologist who focused on human occupation.

Legends and sharing stories are an integral part of an oral culture. The importance of Nose Hill to pre-contact indigenous people is highlighted by sites such as the buffalo rubbing stone for ceremonies, vision questing, and fasting.

A natural area is a City-owned park with a natural/ native plant community. Our primary role is to preserve the natural significance. Conservation protects these (relatively) undisturbed parcels of land. Damage can be repaired while loss can be restored.

Public engagement and feedback from tourists will contribute to Calgary's 20-year Park Plan. After a draft proposal, there comes a final version by spring 2024, before presentation to City Council. For more information, visit https://engage.calgary.ca/parksplan.

Woodpeckers Knocking on Your Garage Door or Drumming on Your Metal Chimney Cap?

While some people are working from home still, they might hear the drumming of one of the many woodpecker species native to Calgary. Or you may have noticed driving on your street, the taped over holes of your neighbour's garage doors! While it is an annoying season that can cause a lot of damage, the Northern Flicker Woodpecker is protected under the Migratory Birds Convention Act in Alberta and once they have nested and laid eggs, they are illegal to move.

Here are some tips for protecting your home and potentially your sanity!

- · Check for bugs in your siding.
- Prevent nesting; cover your vents with mesh or reflective tape around the outside.
- They do not like loud noises, chase them off by banging on a pot or clapping.
- Discourage them with visuals; plastic snakes or predatory birds help, or strips of aluminum, shiny streamers, or even a shiny Mylar balloon.

NATIONAL BEST FRIEND DAY

In Canada and the US, June 8 is National Best Friend Day! This observance exists thanks to US Congress who, in 1935, decided that a day was needed each year to celebrate close friends. June 8 was selected for its pleasant weather, making it a great day to spend outdoors with friends!





AURORA SKY DISTRICT

New Aurora Sky District Crest

Formerly known as Nitanisak District, we changed our name to better reflect Girl Guides of Canada's commitment to Truth and Reconciliation.

Aurora Sky District serves the communities of Edgemont, Evanston, Hamptons, Hidden Valley, Hanson Ranch, Kincora, Nolan Hill, Sherwood, and Sage Hill.

Aurora is a mystical and romantic name that means "dawn" in Latin. An aurora also refers to a natural light display in Earth's sky called the aurora borealis, or northern lights, visible only in high-latitude regions like the north and south poles.

Being one of the most northern districts in Calgary, when the conditions are right, we are able to see the polar lights in the northern night sky during the summer.

Camp Skills Day

We were very fortunate to have beautiful weather on our inaugural District Camp Skills Day on April 29. We were also very lucky to have a great venue at Charles Butler Memorial Park just north of the city. Being that our district is on the north edge of town, it made for very easy access. We had 97 girls attend the event. The stations were run by the older girls for the younger girls, a wonderful way for older girls to show leadership and teach skills to the youngers ones.

Q: What do I do if I see water pooling in my neighbourhood?


A: During the heavy spring rainfalls, storm drains can take extra time to drain. If the water hasn't drained in around 90 minutes and pooling begins, take a picture, and submit it to 311 via the app or online tool. The pictures help the City prioritize urgent requests. (Reminder to keep your eavestroughs clear and keep an eye on your storm drain!)

Q: When will fluoride be back in the water supply?

A: As part of the 2021 General Election, 62% of electors voted in favour of reintroducing fluoridation of the municipal water supply. In November 2021, Council directed Administration to begin the process. Bids for construction happened in March 2023, and it is expected we will finalize a partner this month. Based on the current projection of timelines, the fluoridation system should likely be in service June 2024.
