If you have any exciting ideas for winter activities that we could start at Kincora, please feel free to email me. As always, please consider volunteering for our various activities and events.



A MESSAGE FROM THE KRA

As the Thanksgiving season has passed, we would like to recognize and extend gratitude to all veterans, past, present, and future for their service to our country, and the globe. The field of crosses will be available to view starting on November 1 and ending on November 11. If you'd like to attend a sunrise or sunset ceremony, information can be accessed online at the Field of Crosses Memorial website.

This month, the pickup dates for compost bins will now occur every second Thursday, for the month of November pickup dates include November 2 and November 16, 2023. Here are some friendly tips regarding composting from the City of Calgary; any yard waste, including leaves, branches, grass, and plants can be placed freely in the green bin. Additionally, extra yard waste should be placed in closed yard waste bags, approximately half a meter away from the green bin. This is also a friendly reminder to not put plastic bags in the green bin, as the bags are not compostable.

The KRA has begun planning for the 2024 budget year; how do you want your HOA fees to be actioned?

We welcome your ideas to continue to keep Kincora a community you want to call home.

Additionally, we are also looking to add additional members to our volunteer board. No experience is necessary. Duties include but are not limited to collaborating with the City and Kincora Community Association, planning, landscaping, communications, budgeting, and advocating for our community we call home. Board meetings are held once per month, excluding July and August. Our bylaw allows for nine board members, currently we have four.
