

Exploring Nose Hill: A Hands-On Field Guide by Jill Kirker and Diana Kary was published by Grassroots NW: Environmental Awareness Society; it offers an introduction explaining why people should study Nose Hill Park and "how to" use this guide. There are maps of tours such as the NW Interpretive one and those of Meadowlark Prairie, Many Owls Valley, Wintering Hill, (Buffalo) Rubbing Stone Hill, and Porcupine Valley. After Nose Hill geology and an erratic boulder as part of a glacial lake, there is more about Nose Hill human history.

Check out tepee rings, native stories, the Blackfoot Nation, and exploration and settlement. The six habitats are fescue grasslands, previously cultivated land, shrubs, aspen groves, gravel, and wetlands. Suggested activities are for biodiversity, prairie field study, a mural of the prairie community, a grasslands species and food web, or hands-on weed control. With so many animal types there are also activities related to grouse, raptors, bird migration, ants, grasshoppers, gophers, ground squirrels, and mule deer on the Island Game. Learn more about the food chain, ecosystem, and sampling life in the pond-area wetlands. Studies can lead to other native grass areas of Calgary and designing wildlife corridors. Another important topic that is touched on is the world-wide issue of endangered species and grasslands.

Phase 2 engagement begins in October focusing on Calgary's 20-year plan for how we develop, redevelop, and manage parks. Fall 2023 feedback will be on public park policies. Input is also needed from businesses, agencies, and organizations. A 'What We Heard' report from Phase 2 will be published in winter 2023. Phase 3 engagement will inform a draft plan. By spring 2024, the 'Connect: Calgary's Parks Plan' will be final and then presented to City Council in summer 2024. Have your say at engage.calgary.ca/parksplan.

North Haven Snow Shovelling Program

The North Haven Community Association is once again organizing five months of snow shovelling from November 1 to March 31. The program matches local kids with North Haven customers who would like to have a snow shovelling service at a reasonable rate. This program provides many kids with their first employment opportunity.

Fees for areas to be shovelled are assessed on an individual basis, and all fees collected (except GST) go directly to the shoveler. Customers can sign up for the full five months, or for as little as a weekend.

North Haven Learning Grounds Update

Construction of Phase 2 of the Learning Grounds at North Haven School is complete!

We are particularly proud of the 24 new trees that have been placed in the schoolyard. How many trees were there before the project started, you ask? None! It will be quite some time before we have substantial shade produced, but a wise forester once said "The best time to plant a tree is 20 years ago, the second best time is today."

We've heard some questions over the summer and have assembled a Learning Grounds FAQ.

Q: When will the fences around planting areas be taken down?

A: The wildlife fences around planting areas will remain in place for three growing seasons. This will give planting time to establish while they're still small and susceptible to damage.

Q: Will the area around the amphitheatre be mowed?

A: The Phase 1 grasses growing among shrubs will not be mowed; they are indeed quite long, but have also been producing seed heads which will help fill in remaining bare areas. This planting style has become more common in City of Calgary natural areas and encourages wildlife through habitat creation.

Q: What is the area between the play structure and the swings?

A: It's an obstacle play area! The existing boulders in a horseshoe shape have been connected to pathways constructed of stepping stones, and larger boulders of various sizes. The area is opposite a plaza sitting area with benches and a perfect place to park a stroller while smaller children clamber about. We understand the students like to play 'Alligator Tag' on the existing boulders.

Q: What's Alligator Tag?

A: No idea!

Q: What's the story with the leaning trembling aspen from Phase 1? The one with very small leaves?

A: Our design team figures the root ball had poor contact and the roots haven't taken quite as well as the other two trembling aspens. The good news is that with extra water and heavy pruning next year, it will catch up to the other two aspens in three years. These are fast growing trees so it should recover.

Q: Is the area only for use by the school?

A: The North Haven Learning Grounds is for everyone! Students at the school will certainly benefit from the Learning Grounds, with the easiest access and learning opportunities, but the space is for everyone.
