

#### **Ingredients**

- 1/2 cup of butter or hard margarine
- 1 cup of sugar
- 4 over ripe bananas
- · 2 eggs
- 1 1/2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

#### **Directions**

- Cream butter and sugar together.
- In a separate bowl, mash bananas and then blend in eggs. Add butter/sugar mixture and combine.
- · Whisk or stir together the flour, baking soda, and salt with a fork before adding to the mix and blending.
- · Lastly stir in vanilla extract until smooth.
- · Pour batter into an oiled and floured loaf pan and bake at 350 degrees for about 60 minutes.


