

Summer is going by so quickly; we hope you are having a wonderful holiday.

Our Stampede Breakfast was another great success with over 2,300 people being served. We tried to do something different this year to help with correct garbage disposal by hosting a waste station where people simply deposited

their plates and items and volunteers sorted it accordingly, which allowed for us to be able to compost nine bags of food waste, which was half of the garbage collected. Hopefully, next year we will figure out an option for the plastic cutlery because that was the majority of the nine bags of garbage that we had to take to the dump for disposal. Everyone seemed to enjoy the wagon ride, petting zoo, DJ, and marching band. Thank you to all the amazing sponsors and volunteers that stepped forward to make this another successful event.

Remember that with the hot, dry weather comes the high risk of fires, please make sure that you dispose of any burning material accordingly. If you smoke at home, note that planters can be full of peat moss which can catch fire. Please don't toss lit cigarettes out of a vehicle window as most grass fires start that way.

The community garden continues to grow, and we are looking forward to another great year. We are still trying to find options to lock the water tote valves, to prevent them from being drained. We are just awaiting the delivery of the six fruiting trees that will be added to the site as part of the City of Calgary orchard program but expect that it will be a couple of years before we will see fruits: cherries, apples, and pears.

The City of Calgary's Farm Market Stand is back in Auburn Bay, with Broxburn Farms providing a variety of locally grown produce. The market will be set up in the Auburn Bay School parking lot on Saturdays from 4:00 to 7:00 pm. I had the opportunity to stop by and pick up some items to try and found that they were definitely more flavourful than store bought options.

I will have an update on the Casino Fundraiser held on July 26 and 27 in the next edition. I hope we will be able to find volunteers to fill the final few spaces.

The Community Kitchen Good Food Box program continues to grow each month and is a great opportunity to get affordable and delicious produce. You can get a

small box (approximately 20 to 25lbs) for \$25, medium (30 to 35lbs) for \$30, or large (40 to 45lbs) for \$35, delivered once a month. Please check out the post on our website for the google form to place your order. Next order date is August 15 for August 25 delivery.

Auburn Bay has a large number of Facebook groups. There is a Pet Group, Seniors Group, Grillers Group, Ladies Group, Food Lovers Group, Gardening Group, Community Garden Group, Ladies Clothing Exchange Group, Business Group, Buy-Nothing Group... the list is nearly endless. 

- 6. This town is dubbed the "polar bear capital of the world."








The Spotted Lake



City of Calgary – Bylaws for Helping to be a Better Neighbour

from the City of Calgary

Most of the concerns we hear about were pet related.

Cats:

- Under the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw, cat owners must ensure their cats:
- · Have a City of Calgary license.
- Remain on the owner's property.
- Do not disturb the peace by howling or crying.
- Do not damage others' property.
- Do not scatter garbage.
- Do not chase, threaten, or attack a person or an animal.

Fines range from \$25 to \$1,500.

Dogs:

Under the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw, dog owners must ensure their dogs:

- All dogs must have and wear a City of Calgary licence as soon as they reach three months of age.
- All dogs must be on-leash at all times, unless posted signs indicate otherwise, or on property where the owner of the dog has the right of occupation.
- Dogs may not be left unattended while tethered.
- Dogs may only be transported in the back of a truck if the dog is in a fully enclosed trailer, a truck bed covered with a topper, contained in a ventilated kennel that is secured to the truck bed, or securely tethered and not standing on bare metal.
- Dog owners must ensure that they bring along a suitable means to pick up feces.
- Dog owners must pick up all feces produces by their dog both on and off their property.

• Dogs must be under control in designated off-leash areas. This means they must be in sight of their owners and respond to sight or sound commands.

Fines for failing to comply with the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw range from \$25 to \$1,500.

As a dog owner, you must ensure your dog does not:

- Bite anyone
- · Injure anyone
- Chase, threaten or attack a person or animal
- · Bark, howl or disturb anyone
- Cause damage to property or animals
- Scatter garbage

Dogs are not allowed in:

- School grounds
- Playgrounds
- Sports fields
- Golf courses
- Cemeteries
- Wading or swimming areas

While on a pathway, your dog must:

- Be on a leash no longer than two metres
- Remain on the right-hand side of the pathway
- Not interfere with or obstruct other users
- You may not cycle, skateboard or in-line skate with a dog on a leash while on a pathway.

If you know of a bylaw infraction and would like to report it to Animal and Bylaw Services, please call 311 (from within Calgary) or 403-268-CITY (2489) (from outside Calgary).

Hawaiian Rice Bowl

Rice is a grain that grows to 4ft. in height, produces small edible seeds, and thrives in warm, wet climates.

It is the world's largest food crop and evidence of rice farming, dating back ten thousand years, has been found in the Yangtze River valley of China.

There are two types of rice – Asian Rice and African Rice and the length and width of the rice (once it is cooked) determines if it is short, medium, or long.

White rice is more commonly consumed than brown, black, or red due to its ease of cooking and long shelf life. Rice should always be washed before cooking as it will rid the rice of any starch that may be attached to the grain. It also prevents the grains from sticking to each other during the cooking process.

China is the world's largest producer and contributes to the daily rice intake of 3.5 billion people in Asia, Africa, and South America.

Steamed, boiled, fried, or ground, rice shows up as an ingredient in Spain (paella), Italy (risotto), Japan (sushi), India (pillau), Malaysia (nasi lemak), Korea (bibimbap), Africa (jolloff), Brazil (galinhada), or in its simplest form poke or Hawaiian Rice Bowl.

Prep Time: 25 minutes **Cook Time:** 5 minutes

Servings: 4



Ingredients:

- 2 medium size carrots
- 2 small beetroots
- 2 mini cucumbers
- 2 avocados
- 1 can pineapple tidbits
- 20 jumbo size shrimp (shelled and de-veined)
- 2 cups shredded lettuce
- 4 cups cooked white, brown, or black rice
- 6 tbsps. mayo
- 2 tbsps. siracha sauce
- 2 tbsps. rice vinegar
- 2 tbsps. olive oil
- · 2 tbsps. soya sauce
- 4 tbsps. of coriander leaves or nori nori (dry seaweed)

Directions:

- Wash and peel carrots and beetroots and then cut, along with the cucumbers into small even sized pieces.
- Drain pineapple tidbits and set aside. Cut each avocado into half and then slice each half into four pieces.
- In a small bowl prepare dressing by combining the mayo, siracha, and rice vinegar.
- Heat two tbsps. of olive oil in a skillet or wok and then add the shrimp and stirfry for three to four minutes or until the shrimp turn pink and are cooked. Add two tbsps. of soya sauce and toss the shrimp in it and then remove from heat.
- Assemble four bowls by placing a cup of warm rice in each one and arranging the pineapple bits, carrots, cucumbers, beetroots, and lettuce around the edges of each bowl. Add the shrimp and avocado slices and top with siracha mayo dressing. Garnish with coriander leaves or nori nori if desired.

*You can substitute the shrimp for tofu and edamame or corn if you would prefer a vegetarian option.
