# How to BEE a Community Scientist

## Help us document the different pollinators in Calgary!

-  Go to **inaturalist.ca** or download the app.
-  Look around your favourite park or backyard for any **insects visiting a flower.**
-  Take at least **2 clear photos of an insect**, preferably from multiple angles.
-  Take at least **1-2 photos of the plant** where you can see (1) the flower, and (2) the leaves/whole plant.
-  Upload your photos to iNaturalist. **Tip:** Create a separate observation for the insect and plant.
-  Add your insect observations to the Calgary Pollinators Project. **Tip:** Link your insect and plant observations together.

 **Alberta is home to hundreds of different pollinators** – more than 330 kinds of bees, as well as flies, beetles, wasps, and other insects that are critical to our local food supply. We want to get to know the pollinators that call Calgary home and what plants best support them, and you can help! **Community science** involves the collaboration between scientists and the general public to collect and analyze data. The data you uploaded to iNaturalist can be used in research around the world, and close to home!

## DEERFOOT TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS



### NOTICE

Alberta's provincial government, to better accommodate current and future traffic demands on Deerfoot Trail, is funding a series of projects to improve the safety and reliability for Calgarians. Deerfoot Trail is currently Alberta's busiest freeway, and a critical component of Calgary's transportation network for commuters and the local economy.

In January 2023, preliminary construction work began adjacent to Deerfoot Trail near 64 Avenue NE to prepare for the upcoming construction season. Contracts for additional Improvement Areas have not yet been awarded, as the procurement process remains ongoing.

To accommodate the improvements near 64 Avenue NE and other Improvements Areas along the corridor, impacts such as increased travel times, speed limit reductions, and intermittent/ temporary lane closures are expected in the coming months as construction progresses.

**It is recommended that those travelling on Deerfoot Trail plan and give themselves extra time to reach their destination, and/or take alternate routes when feasible.**

Additional information about these improvements and upcoming public events will be provided on the project website as it becomes available. Members of the public who would like to remain informed on the project are encouraged to subscribe to project updates.

## THE EMERALD

## DEERFOOT TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS



### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### WHERE CAN I GO FOR TRAFFIC UPDATES?

Deerfoot Trail is a provincial highway, and traffic updates and road conditions are reported through [511 Alberta](#). For updates regarding City roadways please refer to the City of Calgary's [Traffic Information Map](#).

#### WHY IS THIS WORK NECESSARY

All infrastructure requires regular maintenance and intermittent upgrades to account for regular wear and tear and increased usage presented by population growth.

Deerfoot Trail was first constructed in the 1970s when Calgary's population was much smaller than it is today, and has experienced decades of wear and tear since it was first opened. Improvements are needed across the corridor to ensure that current and future traffic needs can be met and help improve travel times and overall safety for the travelling public.

#### WHAT ARE THE TIMELINES FOR THIS WORK?

Each of the Improvement Areas will have its own unique timeline based on the scope of improvements and the amount of construction required to complete the improvements. Information specific to each improvement area will be posted on the project website as contracts are awarded and more information becomes available.

Construction on Deerfoot Trail to complete the various improvements that are required is expected to occur over multiple construction seasons.

#### HOW WILL THIS IMPACT TRAVEL TIMES?

Traffic impacts will fluctuate over the course of construction based on the work being completed. When feasible and safe to do so, work that requires lane closures will occur outside of peak travel times to limit impacts to the travelling public. It is recommended that members of the public plan ahead and give themselves extra time when travelling on Deerfoot Trail is required to reach their destination. Where possible, consider taking alternate routes to reduce impacts to travel times.

Are you finding it hard to keep up with continuously rising prices of fresh produce at your regular grocery store? Have you seen the big GFB truck coming through our neighbourhood or considered giving Good Food Box a try?

Good Food Box (GFB) is a program through which anyone and everyone can access nutritious fresh produce regularly and affordably. Good Food Boxes contain a combination of in-season fresh fruits and vegetables bought directly from farmers and wholesalers. The content varies weekly, depending on what's in season, and each box contains the maximum produce to ensure you get the most value for the price.

### Box Options:

**Small Box:** \$25 15-20lbs\* of fruits and vegetables

**Medium Box:** \$30 25-30lbs\* of fruits and vegetables

**Large Box:** \$35 35-40lbs\* of fruits and vegetables

\*Please note, weights are approximate and will vary depending on produce size and density. While prices remain the same – box weights have slightly changed.
