

SAFE & SOUND

Sledding Safety

by Alberta Health Services

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) would like to remind parents and children about a few toboggan/sledding safety tips as the winter season continues. Injuries may result from collisions with stationary objects on the hill, such as trees, poles, rocks, or even collisions with other people. Unprotected falls can also result in more serious injury if you lose control at high speeds. However, everyone can be safe and have fun on the toboggan hill by following these reminders.

Equipment

- · Always ensure your toboggan, or sledding device, is in good repair. Inspect it for any damaged or missing parts before each use.
- Be certain the operator is fully capable of staying in control of the sled at all times.
- Wear a ski helmet, designed for use in cold weather and high speeds.

Hazards

- Avoid hills that are too steep or too icy.
- Choose hills free of all obstacles such as trees, rocks, utility poles, benches, or fences.
- Beware of loose scarves, or clothing containing drawstrings, which could present a strangulation hazard if they become caught or snagged.
- · Look out for others. Move quickly to the side after finishing a run and stay to the side of the sliding path when walking up the hill.
- · Children should be supervised by an adult; never toboggan alone.
- · Tobogganing at night is not advised.

Plan Ahead

- Dress warmly in layers and anticipate weather changes.
- Consider bringing extra sets of gloves and toques to exchange wet garments for dry ones.
- Take breaks out of the cold to warm up.
- Attempt to cover any exposed skin.
- Even when properly protected from the elements, the fingertips, toes, ears, the tip of the nose, and other high points on the face, such as the forehead and cheek bones can be affected by frostbite.
- If frost bite has occurred, treat it by first removing the individual out of the cold environment. Gently warm the affected skin by placing a warm hand over it, or by placing the affected part in warm - not hot - water, until re-warmed.

Tips For Joining a Gym

If your goal is to lose weight, get in better shape, or improve your overall health, deciding to join a gym may be the first step. However, don't just sign up at the gym you see or visit. Before signing on the dotted line, research all options first!

Get the most from a gym membership by considering these tips from BBB.

- Determine your fitness goals. Determining your goals in advance will help you select a facility that is most appropriate for you. Consult with your physician before embarking on a new fitness regimen, especially if there are medical conditions that might be a concern.
- Figure out your priorities. What is most important to you? Will a convenient location and extended hours help you stick to your fitness plan? Will a variety of equipment or classes keep you motivated? Do you work out while traveling and prefer a chain with numerous outlets? Determine your top priorities before you start shopping around.
- Take a tour. Make sure the gym has the equipment, classes, and trainers you need or expect. Pay attention to things that are important to you, whether it's the cleanliness of the showers or the availability of Wi-Fi. Ask questions and make sure you understand all the rules. Ask about busy times, wait times for equipment, whether classes require pre-registration, availability,

and cost of trainers, etc. Ask how the gym staff is maintaining the cleanliness of the facilities.

- Ask questions about limited free trials. Gyms often give a one-week free pass for potential members; this is a great way to see if the gym is a good fit for you. Try the gym at different times to see how crowded it is and whether there is a wait for certain equipment. Check out classes if they are offered.
- Don't feel coerced. Do not give in to high-pressure sales tactics to join right away. A reputable gym will give you enough time to read the contract thoroughly, tour the facilities, do some research, and make an informed decision.
- Calculate the true costs. Gyms often use special introductory offers to encourage new members, but the price could go up more than you budgeted once the initial period is over. Make sure you understand what the regular monthly fees will be and what they include.
- Understand the terms. Read the contract carefully before signing. Make sure that all verbal promises made by the salesperson are in writing. What matters is the contract and the terms within it, so don't just take a salesperson's word for it. What happens if you move, or the gym goes out of business? Will the membership renew automatically at the end of the term? What is the cancellation policy and under what circumstances?

ENMAX Community Solar Fund

The Lake Bonavista Community Association(LBCA) is pleased to share that we have been selected as one of the solar installations under the ENMAX Community Solar Fund.

The ENMAX Community Solar Fund is a partnership between the City of Calgary and ENMAX to deliver \$5-million of solar energy installations at community buildings across Calgary. The fund is a one-time contribution that is being used for the design and construction of solar photovoltaic energy generation systems benefiting local neighborhoods. The City of Calgary is administering the program and ENMAX Energy is providing the solar equipment and hiring tradespeople to install the equipment.

Community Associations will take on the ongoing operations and maintenance responsibilities to ensure longevity and performance of the solar systems. The solar installation will yield a long-term benefit to the LBCA as the average lifetime is between 20 to 25 years.

The LBCA Solar Installation will:

~Produce more than 500,000 kWh of green electricity each year, enough to offset about 80% of the facility's electricity usage. This amount of electricity would be enough to power 70 average Calgary homes

~The system will reduce the amount of GHG emissions sent to the atmosphere by more than 150 tons in its first year of operation. These emissions reductions are the equivalent of reducing over 680,000 km traveled by passenger vehicles

~This is also equivalent to the amount of carbon sequestered by roughly 2750 tree seedlings grown for 10 years.

Installation started on October 19th, 2023
and completion is expected by February 2024
(or sooner if the weather cooperates)
Installation will not impact the daily operations of the LBCA. All materials will be on the LBCA roof and not visible from the street.

We thank the City of Calgary and ENMAX for the generous funding of this project that will yield lower energy costs to the association and support long term sustainability.





Happy New Year!

2024 is starting off with some exciting news for clean energy. The recently announced Dow's \$9 billion Path2Zero project in Fort Saskatchewan marks Alberta's largest private sector investment in 15 years. This initiative, a global first, establishes a net zero Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas emissions integrated ethylene cracker and derivatives site. The project enhances Alberta's ethylene and polyethylene capacity, boosting export potential and reinforcing the province's leadership in emissions reduction and clean technology. It will also create around 6,000 jobs during peak construction, and around 400 to 500 permanent jobs – meaning more families can count on good jobs.

Alberta has surpassed its methane emissions reduction target ahead of schedule, achieving a 45% reduction from 2014 to 2022 through collaborative industry efforts, early action programs, regulatory requirements, and improved leak detection. The government's commitment to success is evident through initiatives like the Alberta Petrochemicals Incentive Program and the Technology Innovation and Emissions Reduction Regulation.

Finally, I have heard a lot of concerns regarding how the government is capturing feedback for the potential of an Alberta Pension Plan (APP). A workbook with sections covering various APP-related topics is available for public input until February 28, 2024.
