COOK'S CORNER

Fall Spinach Salad

Combine the spinach, candied walnuts, dried cranberries, Gorgonzola cheese, and chopped bacon in a large bowl. Combine the salad dressing in a separate bowl or jar, and then pour that goodness over the top.



Ingredients:

- 6 cups spinach
- 1 cup candied walnuts
- 2 Granny Smith apples, cut into slices or chunks
- 1 cup dried cranberries
- 1 cup bacon crumbles or pieces
- 1 cup Gorgonzola cheese

Dressing:

- ½ cup maple syrup
- ¼ cup olive oil
- 2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

For the candied walnuts:

- 1 cup walnuts
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon




