

# **Community Beautification**

### **Update on 18 Street Landscaping**

Despite the lack of visible results, RCA has been working hard to improve the landscaping along 18 Street.

### What has the approach been to date?

The focus has been on the stretch of 18 Street between the pedestrian crossing at Riverview Close/Riverwood Circle and 21 Street as this stretch needs the most attention. We have been working with the City of Calgary Parks, City of Calgary Roads, and City of Calgary Transportation departments to address the unacceptable state of the lawns on the median (center) and on the boulevards (sides). We wanted to make the City aware of the unacceptable state of the lawns, the negative impact it has on the Riverbend community at large, and work with them to develop a plan to address it.

### What has been done so far?

In late 2022, after much negotiation, the City of Calgary Parks agreed to conduct a pilot project using salt grass. Normally, salt grass needs to be transplanted by hand, but the City wanted to test a new method of planting it. They seeded the salt grass in the median in late summer. Unfortunately, there was no rain, they did not water it regularly, and it was too late in the season and the grass didn't grow.

In 2023, we continued to advocate for something to be done so the City added some gypsum (to amend the soil) and grass seeds to the median and to the sides. They have been watering and mowing regularly. Unfortunately, the results are not satisfactory. There are slightly fewer bald patches and a bit more greenery but unfortunately, it is mostly weeds that have sprouted.

### Why does nothing want to grow in this area?

The City of Calgary Parks believes grass and trees will not grow on that median. It is not clear what the reason for this is as grass and trees grow just fine in other spots of 18 Street (for example between Riverbend gate/Riverglen Rd at McDonalds and Rivervalley Drive/Riverglen Drive at the community centre). They suspect it is because of the low parts/dips in the pavement, which causes more salt, gravel, and water to splash onto the median in that area. In addition, the median seems to be too low, which causes the water and salt and gravel to pool there, which affects the soil and prevents plants from growing.

### What are other options for this area?

We explored other options with the City of Calgary and there aren't many. The City will not support decorative rocks, high grass, or wildflowers. Communities that have paid for it on their own have had mixed success as it gets very weedy within a few years. Gravel and salt from the roads splash onto the median and it would be impossible to keep it looking nice.

The City will not pay for anything. For whatever we want to pursue, we would need to find our own funds for it. There are grants we could leverage, or we could possibly pursue fundraising activities as a community. We will also need to secure approval from the City for our design before we start anything.

# Why don't our median's look as good as in Quarry Park?

Quarry Park's landscaping, including boulevards and medians, are being maintained by the Quarry Park Land Owners Association. Every homeowner, as well as commercial lot owners, pay additional fees to maintain the curb appeal of the community at a higher than City of Calgary standard. One of the additional features includes an irrigation system for their boulevards.

#### What is next?

The Calgary Parks is focused on maintaining parks. We suspect that it is unlikely that they will spend any more money on this issue. They have tried twice over the past two years only because of our extensive advocacy. We are currently reviewing options of what would be the most feasible next step.

One option is to hire a contractor to elevate the median and replace the soil in it and to try to seed the grass again. The likelihood of success with this approach is unclear. Currently, RCA has no funding available to support this option from its operational budget.

Another option is to come up with a completely new approach/design for something that doesn't require any maintenance. This will require community engagement, securing funds from grants/ fundraising, and obtaining approvals from the City of Calgary.

### What can you do to help?












### **Deerfoot Trail Improvements**



The Deerfoot Trail Improvements Project was launched in early 2023.

Project scope currently includes redesign of Glenmore Trail interchange, Southland Drive Interchange, Anderson Road interchange, and Ivor Strong bridge upgrades.

We are very excited about the anticipated benefits that the Deerfoot Improvements Project will bring to all drivers utilizing this major freeway. However, we are also very concerned about the prospect of further increased traffic and the safety of pedestrians and cyclists using this street, as drivers will want to bypass the construction on Deerfoot Trail.

In May 2023, Riverbend Community Association sent a letter to MLA Tanya Fir, Office of the Minister of Transportation and Ward 11 Councilor Kourtney Penner to flag our community's concerns and advocate for preventative measures to be put in place.

We will continue to advocate to engage with the officials and with our community residents to determine long term solutions that will:

- Keep 18 street safe for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Reduce cut-through traffic volumes through our community.
- Optimize traffic flow to ensure our community residents can get in and out of our community safely.





## **Signs You May Have Depression**

For many people with depression, symptoms are usually severe enough to cause noticeable problems in day-today activities, such as work, school, social activities, or relationships with others. Some people may feel generally miserable or unhappy without really knowing why.

Although depression may occur only once during your life, people typically have multiple episodes. During these episodes, symptoms occur most of the day, nearly every day, and may include:

- Feelings of sadness, tearfulness, emptiness, hopelessness
- · Angry outbursts, irritability or frustration, even over small matters
- Loss of interest or pleasure in most or all normal activities, such as sex, hobbies, or sports
- · Sleep disturbances, including insomnia or sleeping too much
- Tiredness and lack of energy, so even small tasks take extra effort
- Reduced appetite and weight loss or increased cravings for food and weight gain
- · Anxiety, agitation, or restlessness
- Slowed thinking, speaking, or body movements
- · Feelings of worthlessness or guilt, fixating on past failures or self-blame
- Trouble thinking, concentrating, making decisions, and remembering things
- Frequent or recurrent thoughts of death, suicidal thoughts, suicide attempts, or suicide
- · Unexplained physical problems, such as back pain or headaches

### Some differences in symptoms you may see in teens and children:

- In younger children, symptoms of depression may include sadness, irritability, clinginess, worry, aches and pains, refusing to go to school, or being underweight.
- · In teens, symptoms may include sadness, irritability, feeling negative and worthless, anger, poor performance or poor attendance at school, feeling misunderstood and extremely sensitive, using recreational drugs or alcohol, eating or sleeping too much, self-harm, loss of interest in normal activities, and avoidance of social interaction.



### Differences in symptoms seen in older adults:

Depression is not a normal part of growing older, and it should never be taken lightly. Unfortunately, depression often goes undiagnosed and untreated in older adults, and they may feel reluctant to seek help. Symptoms of depression may be different or less obvious in older adults, such as:

- Memory difficulties or personality changes
- Physical aches or pain
- · Fatigue, loss of appetite, sleep problems or loss of interest in sex — not caused by a medical condition or medication
- Often wanting to stay at home, rather than going out to socialize or doing new things
- Suicidal thinking or feelings, especially in older men

For some, depression is caused by a neurochemical deficit. While for others, depression is brought on by an event such as a breakup, death, job loss, postpartum, or a major stressful life event. Those with a neurochemical imbalance may need to seek life-time pharmacological treatment and therapy. Others, with less severe symptoms may recover quite well with just therapy alone. Some may need a combination of both for short term (four to six months). Never stop an antidepressant cold turkey as you can have life threatening side effects. Always speak with your doctor first and follow their protocol.

No matter what age group you or a loved one may fall under, it is important to seek help if your symptoms last for more than two to three weeks.
