PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Every year, an incredible amount of effort goes into making our community gardens, courts, rinks, and soccer fields a success. Our outdoor facilities have thousands of users each year, ranging from the daily use of kids from RT and Maple Ridge to people who drive in from other communities to enjoy our rink, which has one of the best ice crews and some of the best ice conditions in the city.

We are constantly investing in our facility, as you have all seen from our recent tennis court resurfacing, garden expansion, and new sea can mural, but there are still assets that are aging and need to be enhanced, like our parking lots and baseball diamond, and there are many needs we have heard from our facility users, such as the need for shade in the summer.

Good investment needs vision and planning, so in the fall of 2023, WRCA contracted Dialog Designs to help us create a future state vision for our fields. In November, we ran an open house with Dialog, where over 30 people from our community came to participate in a workshop. We also gathered additional feedback from over 60 people via online surveys and social media forums.

WRCA is now in the final stages of working with Dialog on the final conceptual model and we hope to have this new vision released to our community in the next month or so. Our work with Dialog would not be possible without the support from Parks Foundation Calgary, who has been a key partner with us on our garden expansion, playground rebuild, and now our new future state vision. Located outside are two private parking lots, crock curl (in the winter), gaga ball pit, pickleball/tennis courts, lacrosse box/hockey rink, baseball diamond, 50-plot community garden, and a large green space which we use for our WRCA Soccer league in the summer and a pleasure skating rink in the winter.

Our newly renovated, air-conditioned building has the following spaces available for rent!

- The Willow 1,924 sq. ft. North Hall (135 dining/200 standing) with large windows, built-in audio/speakers, vaulted ceilings, wood sprung floor. Perfect for high-impact activities!
- The Maple 1,200 sq. ft. South Hall (60 dining/135 standing) with large windows, separate sink/washing area, additional storage, vaulted ceilings, and a sound system.
- The Herard Room 540 sq. ft. Board Room (25 dining/50 standing) with large windows, available projector, and mounted whiteboard, conveniently situated off the Ridge Lounge. Perfect for small group yoga, art classes, meetings, catering set-up, etc.

The community centre has the following additional features:


