CKE Community Garden

With the late arrival of quantities of snow this year, it's hard to believe that we typically start to garden in April. But once the melt is on and the spring sun starts to shine, we'll be eager to get our hands into the soil. And one of the tasks best done early is getting a head start on weeds.

Perennial weeds like dandelions have roots that survive over the winter, so are ready to start growing as soon as conditions allow. Digging these out early will prevent them from flowering and going to seed. Some of the truly troublesome garden weeds are summer annuals, relying on the production of copious amounts of seeds that laid dormant over the winter, germinate in the spring, then grow into mature plants.

But a second type of annual – winter annuals – also rely on massive amounts of seeds but their lifecycles are slightly different. Their seeds are produced earlier in the summer in time to germi-nate and produce a low, green plant called a rosette. These rosettes lay dormant under the snow cover, ready to produce flowers and seeds incredibly early the next spring. As soon as the snow has retreated, they can be found in the garden pushing up stems with flowers ready to bloom be-fore we even notice. So, take some time this spring and scout for winter annual weeds such as stinkweed, shepherd's purse, and chickweed.

Stay tuned for dates for our spring cleanup in the community garden. We are fully booked this year and have some new gardeners joining us. There's sure to be some winter annuals that we can tackle!

Crustless Spinach Quiche Recipe

If you are looking for a fast-to-make dinner or brunch dish, this recipe is for you! It takes five minutes to prepare, and can be made in one bowl!

Ingredients:

- 1 pkg frozen chopped spinach, defrosted
- 1 500-gram container of cottage cheese (2 cups)
- 1 cup milk
- 1 cup flour (can sub 1 cup gluten free flour or potato starch to make this gluten free)
- 2 cups grated cheese (cheddar, mozzarella, or whatever's your favourite!)
- 6 eggs
- 1/2 tsp of Mrs. Dash or no salt seasoning

Method:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Spray a 9 x 13 baking dish or pie plate with non-stick cooking spray.
- 3. Mix all ingredients together in a large bowl.
- 4. Pour into prepared baking dish and bake for 45 minutes, 1 hour until slightly golden brown on top.

What do I love about this crustless quiche recipe?

- It is fast to make! Seriously, you can prepare this recipe in five minutes. While it takes 45 minutes to cook, I can be doing something else during that time...cleaning up the kitchen, organizing, answering emails, etc.
- You can enjoy this recipe as a quiche or cook this recipe in muffin tins for quiche-muffins, which are great for packing lunches, as well as grab-and-go meals and snacks.
- You can prepare this quiche and freeze it.
- You can substitute other cooked vegetables in place of the spinach.
- This recipe works for dinner, but also would be an excellent breakfast, brunch, or lunch.

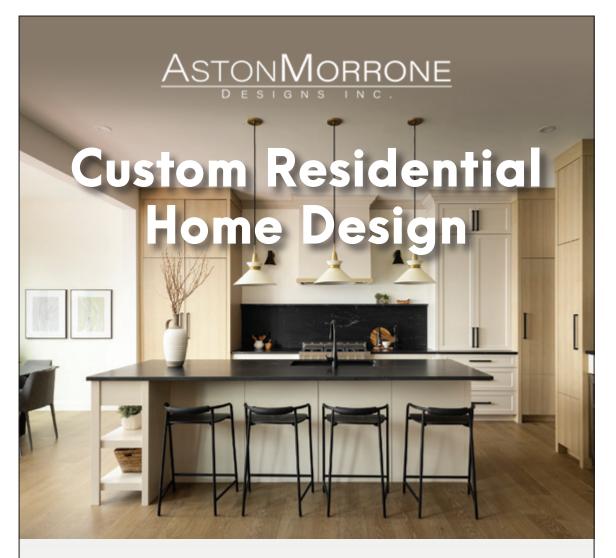
