



## **CRIME STATISTICS**

Cedarbrae Crime Activity was Up in May 2023

The Cedarbrae community experienced 8 crimes in May 2023, in comparison to 3 crimes the previous month, and 18 crimes in May one year ago. Cedarbrae experiences an average of 4.7 crimes per month. On an annual basis, Cedarbrae experienced a total of 56 crimes as of May 2023, which is down 34% in comparison to 85 crimes as of May 2022.
