#### Join DRCA Environment Committee!



#### **LETTER FROM THE BOARD**

Hello everyone,

A few updates for December.

First, DRCA Christmas Parade of Lights, the DRCA encourages residents to put up festive lights to create a special winter land feel for everyone in the community to enjoy.

Second, the city of Calgary recently posted a profile of Discovery Ridge based on the 2021 federal census. The profile can be found at this online address: www. calgary.ca/communities/profiles/discovery-ridge.html.

A few interesting data points about the community. A population of 4,330 people with 68% between the ages of 15 to 64, 17% between 0 to 14 years (means 730 kids) and 14% between 65 to 84. The profile shows a total number of 1.630 households, but this excludes the new area of Discovery Ridge Pointe which includes townhomes and single-family homes.

Third, congratulations to our DRCA membership contest winner Andrea Baghino who won two Cineplex movie tickets. Thank you to all who renewed or for the first time purchased their membership. So far as of November 15 we have 405 members or only 25% of households.

Please note memberships and bottle shack donations are the two main sources of DRCA revenues, while our costs mostly consist of liability insurance and operating costs for our facilities, financial statement audit costs and hosting community event costs. Every membership makes a difference. If you haven't yet, please renew your annual DRCA membership fee of \$25 at our website: www.discoveryridge.com/membership/. At only seven cents per day, you help support your community.

Fourth, we are looking for rink volunteers. Our existing volunteers have done an amazing job, and we would like to thank them. If you are interested, please email: volunteer@discoveryridge.com and in the subject line please state Rink.

#### **Membership News**

Thank you to everyone who has renewed their 2024 memberships! DRCA could not operate without your support. If you have not yet done that, please head to the discoveryridge.com website and join your community.

You may not be aware of what the Community Association does for the community so here are a few things that we have done in 2023:

- Maintain the tennis courts and rink this year we have improved the lighting in this area.


