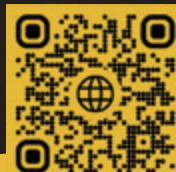


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## MESSAGE FROM THE CECA BOARD

Most residents are paying an annual fee of \$105 (homeowner fees), which is used for ongoing operations and maintaining community entrance features and feature park sites. CECA does not receive any portion of the annual homeowner fees. All of CECA's activities are funded through membership sales, grants, and generous donations of businesses and residents.

### Traffic

#### Snow and Ice

We may not have received a lot of snow this winter, but please help your neighbours and yourself by not shoveling the snow from your driveway onto the road. It should go onto your yard. Also, do not plow your street without a permit from the city. There are insurance requirements for this. Also, be aware of ice at intersections. Stop with enough room so that you will not go into the intersection if you are bumped from behind. Careful when approaching an intersection, as they can be icy, and you may not be able to stop.

#### Fish Creek Boulevard

We are continuing to work with the city to see what changes can be made to slow down traffic on the boulevard. Now that it is a connector to the ring road, it goes by two schools, and we are not seeing enough traffic slow down in the playground zones, or the dangerous S bend with low visibility and bus stops.

### Safety

#### Crimes of Opportunity

Keep your doors locked! This includes car doors, garage man doors, house doors, and garage doors. Please follow a 9 pm routine to lock your vehicles and doors before going to bed.

#### Operation Cold Start

Again, this winter the CPS will be conducting Operation Cold Start. People are often looking for unlocked cars left running to warm up. If you must start your car in the morning, either stay with the car or invest in a remote car starter.

#### Other Nuisances in the Community

Marshall Springs School has reported continued breaking of windows using a BB gun. Also, a solar light installed near the Evergreen community ice rink was damaged by someone. We request that everyone keep an eye out for anyone carrying out these kinds of destructive activities. As all these facilities are near playgrounds, please have a conversation with your kids to help in identifying people responsible for these activities.

#### Please Clean Up After Your Dog!

Please clean up after your dog when you take them out for a walk. Many walking trails have been reported to be littered with dog droppings. Please consider it a duty toward our neighbours. Bylaw services issue fines if you are caught not picking up after your pet. Consider the P.U.P.P.Y. program: <https://www.calgary.ca/csp/parks/programs/puppy-program.html>.

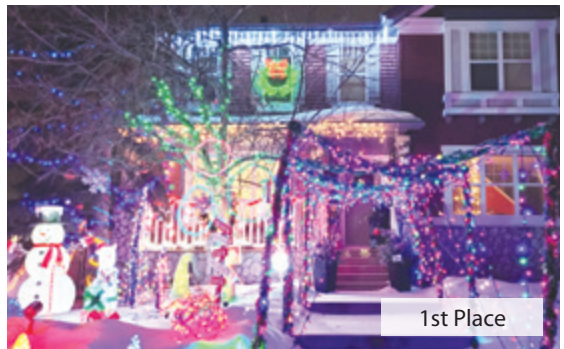

## February Is Heart Month

Do you know the signs and symptoms of a heart attack and what to do if someone experiences these? Knowing may make the difference between life and death. Recognizing and responding immediately to the warning signs of a potential heart attack may significantly improve survival and recovery. February is Heart Month: take the time to be heart safe and learn how you can reduce your risk.

### Common Signs of a Heart Attack

(Any, or all, of these signs and symptoms may occur)

- Chest discomfort described as simply a mild pressure up to a 'crushing' pain; may also be 'squeezing' or a 'heavy' sensation.
- Discomfort may move to the shoulders, arm, neck, or jaw.
- May include shortness of breath, sweating, or nausea/vomiting.
- Signs may vary person to person and can differ between men, women, and the elderly.

### Heart Attack Risk Factors

- Obesity\*
- Sedentary lifestyle\*
- Smoking\*
- High cholesterol\*
- Age/Gender
- Family history

Speak with your doctor about how to treat your modifiable (\*) risk factors and learn to be heart safe.

### What To Do When Seconds Count

- Call 911, immediately. Early treatment can greatly reduce heart damage and be the difference between life and death.
- Treatment starts the moment EMS arrives. Paramedics can provide oxygen, start an intravenous, and perform an electrocardiogram (ECG).
- Paramedics can also administer important medication(s) in the early minutes of a heart attack to lessen heart damage.
- During transport, EMS will share information with the hospital so that definitive treatment can begin immediately upon arrival.
- Take a CPR/AED course. Training is widely available from many reputable organizations. It's easy and could make a significant difference in the outcome of someone experiencing a heart attack.
