Traffic

Traffic Concerns

Thank you to all that submitted traffic concerns for Evergreen. These have been taken to the city and we are working to see if anything can be done. Much of it is a product of driver behaviour, so we urge you to have patience, slow down, and watch out for each other!

Shortcutting Traffic

Evergreen continues to be a short cutting area of drivers traveling from other areas along Fish Creek Blvd to get to the ring road. Please be wary of this when getting around the Fish Creek Blvd area.

Alleyways

Got an alleyway in need of gravel or that has too many ruts? This past winter has caused some deep ruts in places, and spring rains will cause some damage on gravel alleyways. For bad spots please contact 311. You can also check out when your alley is scheduled for maintenance at http://www.calgary.ca/Transportation/Roads/Pages/Road-Maintenance/Gravel-lane-repair. aspx. Lane repair is done between June and October.

Potholes

The potholes are really an issue this year. Please do your part and report potholes and sunken utility cuts. Contact 311.

Safety

Car Prowlings

Once again, we are seeing posts and reports of people going around the community and checking car doors and contents. Please make sure you lock your cars and the house and do not leave any valuables in sight. If you witness this, please report it to the police at their non-emergency number. Info could be tied to other reports.

9pm Routine

Practice the 9pm routine and lock up every night. Make sure your garage door opener is not left in sight in your car, because if your man door is left open, they will have access to your house.
