In the early evening of February 8, 2026, the Fortuna family's life was forever altered by a devastating and senseless accident.

Victoria (21) and her father, Paul (53), were the innocent victims of a tragic vehicle accident that occurred in Edmonton. Sadly, her father succumbed to his injuries at the scene, and Victoria has been left with life-threatening and life-altering injuries. She is currently fighting for her life and receiving critical medical care at the University Hospital in Edmonton.

Hello neighbours,

The time has come for me to step away from the community association administration and to pass the torch to Diana, Laina, and Jen in the office.

When I accepted the Administrator role in the spring of 2020 it was in a temporary capacity to cover Fiona's leave due to the start of the pandemic. Little did I know that I would remain for six and a half years and assume responsibility for all the accounting and administration for the HCA.

Fiona and her husband Garry were mainstays of the neighbourhood during Fiona's tenure as the hall administrator. Their devotion to the neighbourhood was legendary and her dedication to running the hall and its programming was top notch. Then the pandemic hit...

The pandemic created challenges for the HCA. Rental income was reduced and public health guidelines were strict and constantly changing. We used the time and available grants to update spaces including the bright and fun skate shack entrance and the landscaping in front of the building. We also repaved the parking lot and updated floors throughout the building.

The role of the HCA has evolved over the past few years in alignment with community needs. Rentals have increased, but there are fewer HCA programs. Our preschool has fewer students and our Senior's Resource Group and 50+ club have ended. However, we have started successful new initiatives like monthly Lunch & Learns, the Good Food Box, and continued the popular Holiday Luncheon and Winter Market. Farmer's Markets in the summer have brought people together and sports groups have created an energetic buzz in the fields and courts. Please reach out to the office if you have ideas that could come to life at the hall!

I will always cherish my time at the HCA. I created new relationships and supported the neighbourhood, which is the best part of this job! The friendships, support, and love that we can give to our neighbours keeps us all going. I hope to see you all in the community.

Curbside Treasure Hunt: One Weekend, Countless Finds.

On September 12 and 13, join the city-wide Curbside Treasure Hunt! Set out gently used items on your curb and label them with a sign saying “free” for neighbours to take and/or explore your neighbourhood for free finds as well. It’s a fun and easy way to give your things a second life and keep usable items out of the landfill.

How It Works:

1. Clear the Clutter.

Look around your home for items you no longer need, but someone else might love.

2. Label It “FREE”.

Clearly mark each item with a “FREE” sign so people know it’s part of the Treasure Hunt. Download a template at calgary.ca/treasurehunt.

3. Set It Out.

Place your items neatly at the curb Saturday morning.

4. Remove items that are NOT part of the hunt.

Make sure anything on your lawn or on the curb that you plan to keep is removed, put away, or secured so it’s clear what’s free to take and what’s not.

5. Treasure Hunt!

Explore your neighbourhood and discover free finds all weekend long (only take items clearly labelled as “free”).

6. Wrap It Up.

By Sunday, September 13 at 5:00 pm, remove any untaken items from your curb and consider donating them to a local charity.

For safety reasons, **please don’t put out** items that could be hazardous or not safe to reuse, such as:

- Mattresses
- Toilets
- Unsafe or recalled items
- Baby gear or safety equipment that may not meet current standards

Do you live in a condo or apartment? You can participate as well! Coordinate with your property manager to establish a shared drop-off location.

Let’s keep good things out of the landfill. Happy treasure hunting!

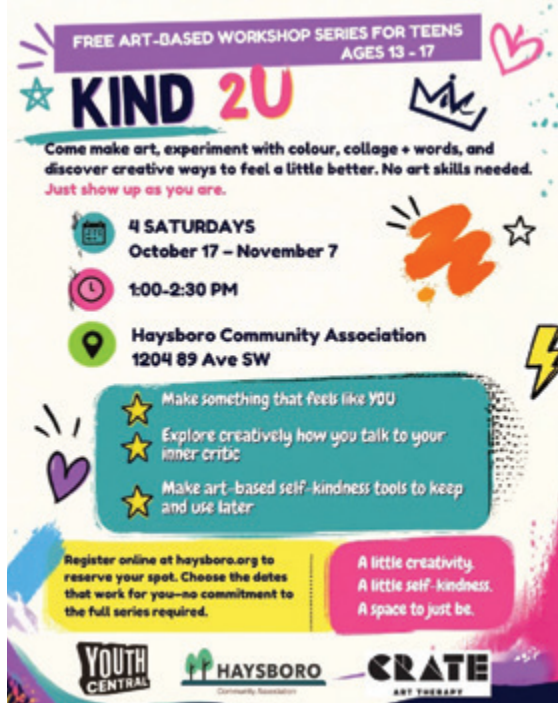

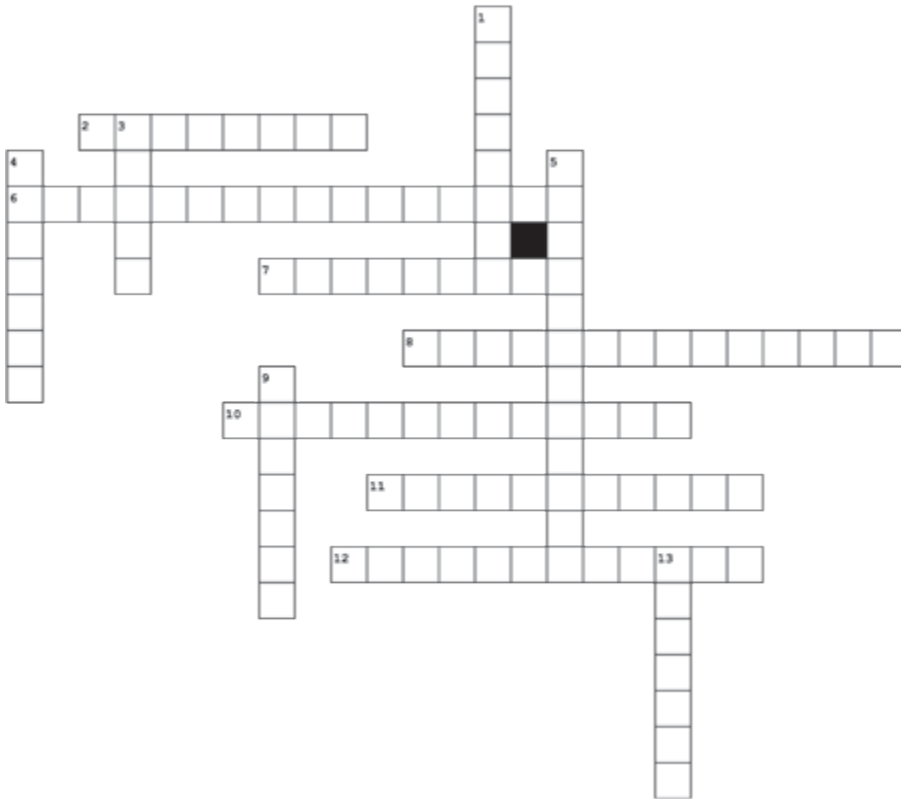
