Seniors Remember - Call for Peace at Remembrance Day Ceremony

In true ceremonial fashion, the Seniors group held their annual Remembrance Day celebration in the warmth and comfort of their Association Hall.

There were a few distinguished military veterans and Peacekeepers present, and the ceremony was enhanced with speeches and recollections of visits to war memorials and related stories.

This year's distinguished guests included:

- Lt. Col. (Ret'd.) Rick Wright Calgary chapter president of the Canadian Association of Veterans in United Nations Peacekeeping (CAVUNP). Rick reminded us that this year marked the 75th anniversary of Canada's Peacekeeping missions and recollected some of his experiences as a Peacekeeper for a nation committed to UN peacekeeping from its early days.
- Linda Wright winner of the Sovereign's Medal for Volunteers shared her stories as a former nursing officer with the Canadian Armed Forces and wife of an active Peacekeeper.
- SLt. Don Figol was accompanied by Cadets of the Royal Canadian Sea Cadet Corps, Petty Officer Reisner and Master Cadet Simms.
- Tony Norman President of the Marda Loop Communities Association welcomed the audience and spoke to us about his visit to the Marzague War Cemetery in France to pay his respects to family member Private Robert Charles Anderson lost in WWII.

- · Historian Darlene Zdunich came up with a spectacular presentation on an unusual topic entitled "Art of the Western Front". She spoke to us about Canadian artist Mary Riter Hamilton who undertook a project from 1919 to 1922 for the Amputation Club of B.C. to paint the World War I scarred landscapes where Canadian Corps had fought and died. Her paintings depict the impacts of that war on France and Belgium but also serve as signs of hope and renewal. She donated her paintings to Library and Archives Canada. In 2020, Canada produced a stamp featuring one of her paintings.
- Derrick Clough nine-year-old History student buff shared his memories of a recent tour of historical sites in Europe and left us spellbound with his confidence and flawless delivery. Needless to say, Grandma (yours truly) and Grandpa Bhatty were lapping up the kudos with great pride.
- Trudy Fosse-Bugler, graced us with her presence again this year and played the Last Post and Reveille adding reverence and goosebumps to some.

The ceremony ended with a Prayer for Peace recited jointly by everyone present.

Non-perishable items were generously donated towards the Veterans Food Bank.

Thank you, one and all for a really special Remembrance Day celebration.


