


Best Way to Keep Apprised of Development Applications: For the most up-to-date information on any development application, https://dmap.calgary.ca/ and input the address or development permit number. You will then have access to the application details and status, along with contact information for the City of Calgary file manager. This is your best source for current information on specific proposed projects. Additionally, current North Glenmore Park area redevelopment applications are listed on the community association website (https://npgca.ca/area-redevelopment) and on our Facebook page (North Glenmore Park Community Association). Due to publishing deadlines, we are unable to provide a list of development applications in this publication.

Role of the Community Planning and Redevelopment Committee (PARC): The community association's Planning & Area Redevelopment Committee (known as PARC) has no formal jurisdiction or authority in planning matters. Rather than rejecting or approving applications, the committee's role is to provide advice, background information and community context.

How the Redevelopment Committee Helps Community Members with Development Issues: The Planning & Redevelopment Committee (PARC) helps community members advocate for themselves for development that fulfills the vision described in the North Glenmore Park Community Association's Planning Guide but has no jurisdiction over planning decisions. The committee can provide information on developments, advice on how to

navigate the planning process, and can advise individual community members on how to engage in the process directly regardless of their views. However, realizing that residents have a variety of viewpoints, the community association maintains a neutral view on development except in special circumstances. Occasionally, the committee hosts an open house for residents to gain input and discuss a particular proposed project.



Friends,

Some of the most important work on Parliament Hill doesn't occur in the House of Commons, but in Committee rooms. Committees examine selected matters in greater depth than is possible in the House of Commons. These Committees undertake studies on departmental spending, legislation and issues related to their mandate, and deliver their reports and recommendations to Parliament.

As a member of the Environment Committee, I provide input on how Canada's resource sector is doing its part in contributing to a clean environment. Indeed, our resource industry has led the country in reducing emissions, and is the country's largest contributor, by far, in investing in clean technologies.

I believe we need to work toward solutions that both protect our environment and our way of life. Both can be achieved if reasonable policies are put forward, and all factors considered. In my experience, there is never a 'silver bullet' solution that is going to solve one environmental problem without potential negative environmental or societal effects. We need to understand the impacts of increased costs associated with more environmentally-friendly fuels, and understand how that affects escalating costs to society going forward, as well as the over-arching concern of having a reliable energy system – on which all of society depends.

The Environment committee will undertake a study this fall, considering Canada's bodies of freshwater. Some of the topics that will be coming out of this study will be management of freshwater pollution, climate change impacts on freshwater, groundwater, and effective monitoring of our waterways.


