Impaired Driving

Impaired driving is a tricky subject and can encompass many aspects not just impairment by drugs or alcohol. Impairment can include sleep, fatigue, medical, or distraction.

Impairment starts at just having one alcoholic drink as it affects perception, reaction, judgement, and narrows vision. However, for impairment the Province and Federal laws must attach a number for charging. Studies have shown that a person's diving is impaired at 80mg of alcohol in 100ml of blood.


Impairment is different from drunk, being drunk is the gross extreme of impairment. Signs of impairment can include glassy bloodshot eyes, the smell of liquor on breath, exaggerated motor skills, and slurred speech.

In Alberta, we have the Mandatory Alcohol Screening or MAS. This program allows police, on a lawful traffic stop, to demand the driver submit to a roadside breath test without suspicion or admittance of alcohol consumption. It is illegal to refuse the test.



There are different license suspensions, vehicle seizure times, and fines dependent on previous Immediate Roadside Sanctions, IRS WARN Program. The program was developed for several reasons and is not used in place of criminal charges where injury or loss of life occurs.

With the legalization of cannabis, signs of impairment can still be present and different physical testing is done for drugs.

Calgary Co-op Oakridge Development Update

The newly constructed Oakridge Professional Building is open for business!

Many businesses have relocated from the mall and are now operating from their new premises, including Co-op Cannabis, CIBC, Connect First, Hearing Life, Personalized Bookkeeping, Oakridge Denture Clinic, Oakridge Chiropractic, and The Village Studio. Demolition of the mall is planned to begin this spring and should be completed by fall. Once complete, construction of a new food store will commence with a planned opening for late 2024.


All existing businesses including the food store, gas bar, and car wash will remain open during the construction period and all efforts will be made to minimize any interruption.

Residential Traffic Concerns

from Calgary Police Services

The Residential Traffic Safety Unit (RTSU) is a unit created to specifically address residential traffic issues. Our strategy is to utilize citizen feedback to develop our operational response. We focus on playground zones, pedestrian rich areas, and other high-risk locations identified through collision data analysis. The RTSU is attached to the Traffic Section of the Calgary Police Service.

We strongly emphasize public awareness and education, facilitating citizen engagement by attending Community Association Board meetings to discuss the Traffic Service Request System (TSR). The TSR is a key tool to help Calgary Police Service monitor and track traffic safety issues.

The RTSU also utilizes strong collaborative relationships with City partners on traffic concerns requiring resolutions other than enforcement, such as sign changes, installation of crosswalks, Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons, extension of playground zones, etc.

We can further assist by liaising with established community partnerships. This includes MLA offices, City Councillor offices, and Neighborhood Committee Coordinators as we continue to expand events attended by the RTSU.






Save the Date



Oakridge Community **Association (OCA): Civic Affairs Report**

RioCan Development at Glenmore Landing

An open house on RioCan's plans for its three phased development at Glenmore Landing was held at PBPCA on April 26. Very few details were provided except the approximate shapes and locations of the three residential tower blocks on previously City owned lands adjacent to 90 Avenue and 14 Street.

The first of several 'Land Use Amendment' applications has now been submitted to The City of Calgary. Please review this as it will have a substantial impact on traffic and visibility as you enter our local communities. The three towers will be taller than the current ones on 90 Avenue opposite Bay Ridge Drive with a maximum height of 115 m and a Floor Area Ratio of 11.0. Approximately 1,600 new residences are planned with limited clarity on road access improvements and increased parking stalls. We are not interested in preventing this densification project from proceeding but we think a layout like the Co-op Southland Crossing with residences away from the intersection would be preferred. Additionally, the overall layout should address improvements to the roads and pedestrian traffic, as well as what is planned for the open land on the south side of 90 Avenue.

If you have any comments, we kindly ask that you submit them via https://forms.calgary.ca/pl1285.html or through the Development Map: LOC2023-0130 by the deadline of July 6, 2023. Please provide the OCA with a copy your submission so we can help advocate on your behalf.

Southland Crossing – Co-op Development and **Construction Plans**

Demolition of the existing mall is continuing and should be completed by the fall. Once complete, construction of the new food store will commence with a planned opening for late 2024, although deliveries of electrical gear may push this into early 2025. Once the new food store is open, Coop will demolish the current food store, and begin the final phase of the project which includes residential development slated to be complete for 2026.

Oakridge Area Upgrade Projects

We have completed a survey of Palliser Dr residents to determine if they support a speed reduction and have submitted this to our Ward 11 and City representatives. We continue to support road calming measures at other pedestrian crossings, such as Southland Drive and Oakmoor Way where posted speeds are 60 km/hr. Please also use the City of Calgary 311 line or https://www.calgary.ca/311.html to document any road safety or infrastructure issues. The more residents document their concerns, the more likely it is that the City will investigate and address them.

OCA Facilities

The OCA Board is planning to proceed with a two-phase parking lot upgrade: upgrade of the existing parking lot during 2023 and an expansion to the North in 2024. The City will be contributing some funds for this effort. The OCA is also continuing to support the Enmax solar panel roof project with a planned implementation this summer. We continue to look at other climate enhancing opportunities such as bike racks and electric charging stations as part of an expanded car park, growing trees, working with the Oakridge Community Garden, etc. We are also discussing other improvements with 'Oh My Oakridge' such as bike routes between green spaces. Any other ideas are welcomed!

District 32

Our District 32 Meeting #20 was held on Thursday, June 8, 2023, at Cedarbrae CA. Topics ranged from the RioCan expansion at Glenmore Landing and road safety to 'Development Permits' to future LAP issues.





As we enter the summer Oh MY Oakridge is hard at work finalizing the design of Oh MY Oakridge our new playground for the Upgroding Community Greenspoces Oakridge Way Park, Just a

few short weeks ago we picked the vendor to supply the playground equipment for this project and we can't wait to share the designs with you once we make some adjustments with the vendor. Come check us out at various events through the summer and fall to see what we hope the new playground will look like if we hit our fundraising goals.

Speaking of raising funds, over the course of the summer we have approximately 13 small corporate grants to apply for that will help us reach our goal of \$250,000 for the new playground. We are closing in on \$200,000 already raised with \$30,000 in grants that we are still waiting to hear back from. To raise the remaining funds, we will be doing a fundraising blitz this summer. We are hosting a bottle drive on August 19 to bring in funds for the playground so start saving those bottles. We will also run a 50/50 draw at the Stampede Breakfast; if you will be there, come over to our booth and buy your tickets to help support this project in our community.

Lastly, we will be running a cheque writing campaign to help get us to the goal. As part of the cheque writing campaign, we are hoping to have stretch goals that will give us the flexibility to include more features in the park, such as additional seating and a native garden. Keep an eye on your mailbox for information on that campaign. If you are so fired up about the park project and you just can't wait to make a donation, send us an email and we can provide you with a Parks Foundation donation form for our project.

Another exciting fundraiser we are ready to announce combines fitness and community spirit. Join us for the Oakridge Run, a celebration of our vibrant community and a commitment to a healthy lifestyle.


