The Butterfly Effect: A Tribute to Hope and Renewal

The butterfly is one of nature's most beautiful creatures. Its colorful wings and movements delicate have inspired poets, musicians, and artists for centuries. But for some, the butterfly holds a deeper meaning, symbol of hope and transformation.

I spent the summer of 2019 in Ontario with my mother after she was diagnosed with terminal cancer. In my free time, I found solace in painting. As an artist, I have always been drawn to the beauty of nature. My mother loved her gardens and our house was surrounded by beautiful blooms. During this difficult period, I wanted to create something full of life and I was drawn to the flowers.

One of the pieces I created shortly before she passed away featured a butterfly landing on a flower. The butterfly is a symbol of transformation and rebirth, often associated with the idea of the soul transcending the physical world. It represents the metamorphosis that occurs when we let go of the past and embrace the future. And so, my painting of the butterfly was not just a tribute to my mother but a tribute to the power of hope and renewal.


After she passed, something extraordinary started happening. Everywhere I went, butterflies seemed to follow me. They would flutter around me and even land on my shoulder to accompany me during long walks. I took it as a sign of comfort and reassurance, a reminder that my mother was still with me in spirit.


Recently, at a market, I told someone the story behind my butterfly piece, "Take Flight." She explained that her friend had been seeing butterflies everywhere since her mother's passing and she felt a deep connection to them. I have learned that it's not uncommon for people to have spiritual experiences or see signs and symbols after the passing of a loved one. With her friend's birthday quickly approaching, she purchased the print as a gift for her. I was elated and humbled to know that she was moved to tears when she received it

The fact that my work resonated with someone who had experienced the same phenomenon was incredibly touching and validating. For her, my painting is a tangible representation of her connection with her mother, and a reminder that even in the darkest of moments, there is always the possibility for renewal and optimism. This experience has reminded me of how powerful art is. Art has the power to challenge our assumptions and beliefs, broaden our perspectives, and inspire us to think and feel differently. It is a means of self-expression, allowing us to communicate our innermost thoughts and feelings to others. Whether we create or appreciate art, it has the capacity to move us, connect us, and enrich our lives in ways that are profound and meaningful.

14 Street SW Widening Between Anderson Road to Canyon Meadows Drive Begins!

As part of a continuing program of major road restoration, The City is planning to complete road reconstruction on 14 Street SW from Anderson Road to Canyon Meadows Drive SW. There will be no changes to the number of lanes on the roadway as part of the current reconstruction project. A design will be completed for a potential future upgrade of this section of 14 Street SW from a two-lane road to a four-lane parkway, which may be warranted in the long-term.

The City will also be looking into the possibility of constructing a new walking and wheeling connection. These upgrades will bring the design of the road up to modern standards, enhance safety, and improve traffic flow, while improving connections for pedestrians and cyclists.

The project will include:

- Pavement reconstruction and realignment of existing traffic lanes
- Installation of a new stormwater system
- Possible utility relocations
- Potential addition of new walking and wheeling connection

A noise study will also be completed to determine if sound walls are required on the east side of the road adjacent to the community of Canyon Meadows. 14 Street SW is a popular, high-use corridor which extends from north to south Calgary, connecting to important routes and destinations throughout the city. On the south end, the segment from Anderson Road to Canyon Meadows Drive SW is a two-lane rural road in need of rehabilitation.

The proposed reconstruction project would enhance safety and provide a more comfortable experience for all modes of travel, while helping to ensure the roadway remains in good condition for years to come.

Hoisin Pork with Pineapple Rice

Deliciously yellow fruit, a pineapple is neither a pine nor an apple but is a group of berries fused together.

Pineapples are indigenous to South America and are believed to have originated in the forests of Brazil and harvested by tribes who lived in the area. Christopher Columbus is credited with introducing the pineapple to Europe and "Pina Des Indes" or "Pinecone of the Indes" were the names used to describe the fruit by the Spanish.

The pineapple plant has a life span of up to fifty years, can take up to three years to grow and mature, and only one pineapple is produced by a plant in a season.

Pineapple goes well with ham, seafood, chicken, tofu, yoghurt, and cottage cheese.

The combination of hoisin pork and pineapple rice fuses together delicious flavours and can be prepped and cooked in a relatively short amount of time. The filet or tenderloin used in this recipe is one of the healthier cuts of meat and is just as lean as skinless chicken breasts.

Prep Time: 15 Minutes

Cook Time: 30 Minutes

Servings: 2 to 3

Ingredients:

- 1 pork tenderloin
- 2 tbsps. hoisin sauce
- 2 tbsps. soya sauce
- 1 tbsp. grainy Dijon mustard
- 2 tsps. honey
- 1 ½ tsps. rice vinegar
- 2 tbsps. vegetable oil
- 4 cups cooked white or jasmine rice
- 2 tbsps. butter
- 1/2 tsp. red chilli flakes
- 2 tbsps. chopped coriander leaves
- 1 can (398 ml) pineapple tidbits, drained
- ½ tsp. salt





Directions:

- In a small bowl, mix together hoisin sauce, soya sauce, honey, Dijon mustard, and half a teaspoon of rice vinegar. Spread the marinade all over the tenderloin and let it sit for ten minutes.
- Preheat oven to 400 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Add two tablespoons of oil to a large skillet and place the tenderloin in it. On medium heat, brown the tenderloin on all sides, approximately three to four minutes. Remove tenderloin from skillet and place on a foil-lined baking tray. Pour any remaining marinade over it and then place it on the middle rack of the oven. Bake uncovered for 20 minutes or until cooked through.
- · On medium heat, melt butter in a wok or skillet, add drained pineapple pieces, chilli flakes, chopped coriander, one teaspoon of rice vinegar, and salt. Stir fry for a couple of minutes and then add the cooked rice and gently blend all the ingredients together. Remove from heat and garnish with coriander leaves and a few pineapple pieces.
- Remove tenderloin from oven, cover and let stand for five minutes. Serve sliced tenderloin with small bowls of Pineapple Rice and use Hoisin sauce as a dip if desired.




Happy Birthday, Charlotte Brontë!


