



Bored? Think Twice Before Taking That Facebook Quiz

Social media is used as a fun distraction for some people, and taking a Facebook quiz may seem like a harmless way to pass the time. But are you giving away more information than you think?

How the scam works

A fun quiz pops up on your Facebook feed or another social media platform. A few questions are answered to prove how well you know a friend. Or a short personality test is offered to match you with a character from a favourite TV show.

These guizzes appear to be meaningless, but the intent behind them is to collect information. For example, questions like: "What was the first car you owned?", "What is your mother's maiden name?", or "What is the name of the street you grew up on?" These are common security questions for insurance, banking, and credit card accounts. Sharing this information can lead to accounts being hacked, and personal and financial information being stolen.

Not all social media quizzes are data collection scams; however, BBB cautions users to be careful about what they share online and to check the privacy settings on the account. Social media data and guiz answers can be used to steal identity or enable a scammer to impersonate you to your friends and family.

Tips to avoid social media scams

- Be skeptical: Before answering a guiz, figure out who created it. Is it a brand you trust? Just because something appears to be fun and innocent, doesn't mean there isn't an inherent risk.
- Adjust privacy settings: Review the social media account's privacy settings and be strict about any information that is shared - and be mindful of who you are sharing it with.
- Remove personal details from your profile: Don't share information like your phone number or home address on social media accounts.
- Don't give answers to common security questions: Be cautious if the questions in a quiz ask for things like your mother's maiden name, street you grew up on, previously owned vehicles, favourite foods, or the name of your high school.
- Monitor friend requests: Don't accept friend requests from people you don't know. Also be wary of a second friend request from someone you are already connected with; the second profile may be an imposter trying to access your data and your friends list.

Preventing Cervical Cancer

Did you know that regular Pap tests and follow-up care can prevent about 90 percent of cervical cancer cases? A Pap test checks the cervix for any abnormal cells that can lead to

cervical cancer. When needed, these abnormal cells can be treated or carefully followed.

Almost all cases of cervical cancer are caused by the human papillomavirus (HPV). HPV infections are common and usually do not cause symptoms, so most people do not even know they have it. Even if you've been immunized for HPV, it's recommended that you start having Pap tests at age 25, or three years after becoming sexually active, whichever is later.


Pap tests are quick and can be done at your healthcare provider's office or at a women's health clinic. Regular screening means any abnormal changes can be followed closely to make sure they clear up or are treated. It's important to attend any appointments for follow-up testing if recommended by your healthcare provider. The earlier abnormal changes are found, the easier they are to manage and the less likely they are to develop into cancer.

For those who are unsure of when they had their last Pap test, or are due for another, please contact your physician or call Health Link at 811.

In addition to regular Pap tests, HPV immunization is an important tool in preventing HPV- related diseases. The HPV vaccine is offered to all Grade 6 students in Alberta schools who haven't had the HPV vaccine yet and works best in children and teens before they have any type of sexual contact. Some adults may also benefit from the HPV vaccine. Talk to your doctor or pharmacist to find out if it's a good idea for you.

People pleasers are constantly getting manipulated. You are not responsible for other people's emotions.





Dear Neighbours,

Alberta's government presented Budget 2023: Securing Alberta's Future.

With a forecast surplus of \$2.4 billion, and an economy poised to lead the country in economic growth, Budget 2023 is an opportunity for the government to invest in Alberta's future. Alberta's responsible fiscal management over the last three years made this possible – growing the economy, creating good paying jobs, strengthening health care and education, and keeping communities safe.

Alberta's government is setting new records for spending in health care. Our province has the best front-line health-care workers in the world and Budget 2023 provides the right supports to ensure Albertans get the care they need when and where they need it. An additional \$965 million in operating expense this year will help build a stronger healthcare system and ensure that government can do what's needed to improve wait times for ambulance services, emergency rooms, and surgeries. The budget also includes \$158 million this year to attract, recruit, and train more doctors and nurses, with a focus on family physicians for rural areas.

Your government is growing and diversifying Alberta's economy. According to a recent report from the Canadian Venture Capital and Private Equity Association, Alberta smashed its venture capital investment record for the fourth year in a row, attracting \$729 million in investment in 2022 – a 30% increase over 2021. The increase in year-over-year values stands in stark contrast to Canada as a whole, which saw a near 30% decline in venture capital dollars invested in 2022.

Alberta is attracting big names in the technology world and undoubtedly, 2023 will be another big year for our technology and innovation sector. That means more high-paying jobs for Albertans. Calgary Herald business writer Chris Varcoe recently wrote that "despite a global slowdown and layoffs in the [technology] sector, Alberta technology companies continue to attract the interest of investors." And Alberta Enterprise Corporation President and CEO Kristina Williams said, "Alberta's tech sector has become a force to reckon with in Canada and beyond."

Government is also setting up Indigenous communities for success. Fourteen Indigenous community-owned businesses are receiving an economic boost through the Aboriginal Business Investment Fund. Five million dollars in grants will be distributed through the fund, supporting the growth of Indigenous communities, community-led job creation, and economic development. Grants will go toward capital costs like equipment purchases and infrastructure builds.
