

Winter Cart Placement Tips

by The City of Calgary

Follow these winter tips to keep your cart collection safe and on schedule:



- even ground. Don't place carts behind or on top of snowbanks.
- · Leave enough space around your carts to easily walk between and around them.
- · Store carts in a sheltered spot and move them out on collection day, so they don't freeze to the ground. Move carts back by 7:00 pm on collection day.
- Clear snow off your carts and keep lids closed. Snow in your blue cart ruins recyclables and makes them difficult to sort at the facility, meaning they can't be turned into new products.
- Prevent food and yard waste from freezing inside your green cart. Use compostable bags or place crumpled newspaper or a pizza box at the bottom of the cart.

Getting Help with Substance Use

by Alberta Health Services



One life lost to overdose is too many. The impacts are far reaching.

AHS is here to help. Support and treatment are available to individuals struggling with substance use, including help for family and friends left behind.

Resources and Treatment

- AHS Addiction and Mental Health Community Clinics: Services are available to serve children, families, and individuals. If you need to speak to someone, call the Mental Health Helpline at 1-877-303-2642 or the Addiction Helpline at 1-866-332-2322. Trained staff are available to offer support at those numbers 24/7.
- Opioid Agonist Treatment Clinics in Alberta: Provides treatment to people dependent on opioids and helps them access services they need to live healthy lives. Individuals can self-refer, or referrals can come from any healthcare professional or a community agency. Services are voluntary and confidential. For more information on how to access care, individuals can walk in or call any AHS opioid dependency program clinic.
- Virtual Opioid Dependency Program: Available anywhere in Alberta, VODP provides same-day access to addiction medicine specialists. There is no wait list. To access, call 1-844-383-7688, seven days a week, from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm daily.
- The Digital Overdose Response System (DORS):

 A free, discreet mobile app that can help prevent overdose deaths among people using opioids and other substances while alone.
- Naloxone Kits: Naloxone is a drug that temporarily reverses effects of an opioid poisoning.

Friends and Family

- People in need of support are encouraged to reach out to someone they trust. Talk to a family member, friend, or someone you can be honest with to talk through your concerns.
- If you notice people in your life who may be struggling, reach out to them. Offering support can include mentioning what you have noticed, listening to their concerns, and connecting them with some of the resources noted above. Starting a conversation does not require you to be a counsellor or an expert, just a caring person offering support and hope.



Hello, Ward 6,

With the approval of Home is Here: The City of Calgary's Housing Strategy on September 14, 2023, Council directed Administration to take actions to address the housing crisis. These actions address housing affordability, non-market housing; housing for a city that will grow to two million people in the near future.

One of these actions, Rezoning for Housing, is a proposed rezoning to new base residential districts of either R-CG in established communities, R-G, or HGO in newer communities. With rezoning, Calgarians would have access to a wider variety of housing to meet their needs and it would contribute to increasing the overall housing supply. Increased supply is crucial to addressing affordability.

The Rezoning for Housing report, including the 'What We Heard' report will be delivered to City Council through Calgary Planning Commission on March 7, 2024. Calgary Planning Commission's recommendation will be considered by City Council at the Public Hearing of Council on April 22, 2024.

By granting the Alberta Sheriffs more authority, Alberta's highways have become safer. In 2023, Alberta Sheriffs removed over 1,200 impaired drivers from our highways, bringing the total to nearly 4,000 impaired drivers removed from provincial highways since July 2021. In addition to making Alberta's highways safer by immediately removing impaired drivers from the road, the Sheriff Highway Patrol's enforcement efforts help the RCMP keep units on patrol and available to respond to other incidents. The safety of all Albertans and their families remains top priority for me, and for our government.

Albertans who depend on Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH), Income Support, and the Alberta Seniors Benefit have seen a 4.25% increase in their monthly benefit starting in January 2024. Nearly 200,000 Albertans on the Alberta Seniors Benefit have seen this increase on their January cheques. This increase will assist vulnerable Albertans to ensure benefits cover the increasing costs of food, housing, and other essential goods and services. This amounts to an increase from \$1,787 to \$1,863 for AISH, \$790 to \$824 in Income Support for those who are expected to work, \$919 to \$959 in Income Support for those with barriers to full employment, and \$303 to \$316 for those who receive the Alberta Seniors Benefit. Beginning in March 2024, to make it easier for recipients to pay their monthly bills on time; benefits will be sent out four business days before the end of each month.

The tourism industry is a key driver in diversifying Alberta's economy, bringing \$10 billion a year in visitor spending in our province. The Alberta government is committed to growing this sector, resulting in a strong and resilient provincial tourism industry that continues to be a key player in driving our economy now and in the future. I support the Alberta government's efforts as we work towards an ambitious goal of growing our province's visitor economy to more than \$20 billion by 2035.


