Hall Rentals Basics

Can I Rent the Hall?

Any person over the age of 21 may rent the hall. The hall can be rented for independent group programs, presentations, and personal events such as birthday parties.

When Can I Book Hall Rentals?

Hall rentals must be booked at the Lake office. You must come into the lake office to book your rental, as we must go through a rental contract and necessary information with you.

What Do I Need to Rent the Hall?

You need your photo ID, payment for the hall rental, and a damage deposit cheque for \$400 at the minimum. If you will be having alcohol at your event, you must obtain a liquor license and Party Alcohol Liability Insurance. Proof of these must be given seven days prior to the event.

Hi Arbour Lake Residents! Summer is finally here!

The lake is fully open! Come on down for some fun in the sun. See our website for information on the lake status or call the office if you have any questions.

Watch the Flags!

- Red = Full closure. Please stay off and far away from the water.
- Yellow = Partial closure. Contact the lake office or check the website for updates.
- Green = The lake is open for all activities.

Water Safety

As a reminder, here are some safety tips:

- Arbour Lake is an unsupervised lake. Use of the lake and its amenities is at your own risk.
- There is no lifeguard on duty. Please always watch children.
- Always keep your small children within arm's reach.
- Life jacket rule: children twelve and under must wear a life jacket when swimming or their legal guardian must sign a waiver at our office. We highly recommend that children wear a PFD at all times.
- Children should remain in the buoyed swim area.
- Swim aids and toys must remain in the swim area.
- Swimming with a buddy is safer and way more fun.
- · No divina.
- No swimming, diving, or playing in the water by the fishing docks!
- No swimming or boating during lightning storms.
- If your children are under the age of twelve, you must remain at the lake with them at all times. They cannot be left unsupervised.

Prohibitions

- Open fires or portable BBQs.
- Personal watercraft equipment.
- Glass bottles, glass containers, glass cups, etc.
- Alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, vapes, or similar substances.
- · Animals.
- Bicycles, skateboards, or other vehicles.
- Motorboats or snowmobiles.
- Digging deep holes in the beach.
- Inflatable water toys or equipment. Only infant water wings are permitted.

- There is no smoking inside the park or parking lot.
- No person shall at any time discharge, deposit, throw, dump, or place any trash or debris of any kind whatsoever in the lake, on lake property, or in lake dumpsters.

TAKE ON WELLNESS

Putting Yourself First!

Life brings with it everyday stresses, but it is important to have coping strategies that can be used to regulate and balance our feelings and emotions. Sometimes we don't have control of stressors that cause the stress, but we can control our emotions or how we react to those stressors. Calming strategies help slow down the immediate response that we have by decreasing the amount of cortisol in our body, also known as the stress hormone. There are many coping strategies, and it is important to find what works best for you.

Here is a list of strategies that can be used by anyone, anytime, and anywhere:

Managing Emotions

Commonly referred to as "name it, to tame it", is a technique that involves naming your emotions to allow you to pause and reflect rather than allowing your emotions to spiral or cause impulse decisions. Make it a habit to recognize how you feel. Did you feel embarrassed, sad, jealous, or upset? Simply notice that emotion and name it in your mind.


Mindfulness

Focusing on the present moment will help calm your mind and manage your emotions. What can you see, hear, touch, feel, or move in the environment you are presently in? This technique will help your brain focus on the present rather than the "what if".

Breathwork

Slowing and deepening your breaths have been shown to help you self-regulate. Use breathing techniques that work for you; these can include box breathing or even paced breathing.

The key to all the above strategies is focusing on yourself. Everyone is different, so find techniques that resonate with you so you can be the best version of yourself!

Fishing is Catch and Release Only!

At this time, only catch and release fishing will be permitted at Arbour Lake, until further notice. There will be no keeping of any fish of any kind of size! This is a result of Alberta Environment and Parks shutting sown all fish stocking within the bow river drainage area, of which Arbour Lake is included. Due to whirling disease found in the Bow River and commercial fish culture operations, no fish may be kept. Any fish that cannot be returned to the water, must be surrendered to a staff member.

Fishing

- May only be done from the designated fishing docks.
- Hooks must be Barbless and egg hooks are not permitted. No triple hooks are to be used. This ensures the survival of released fish.
- No live bait, corn, bread, minnows, smelts, fish or nets may be used to catch fish.
- Only one rod per resident may be cast at any one time and fishing lines must be attended to at all times.
- Random tackle box, bag and hook checks will be performed to ensure all Rules & Regulations are being followed.

Eutrophication

Here is some information on how important it is to be careful with how much fertilizer you use on your lawn. When you use too much fertilizer on your lawn, the excess nutrients are carried away by the rain and other forms or irrigation. The nutrients mix with water and find their way into our beautiful lake. These nutrients cause the algae and plants in the water to multiply rapidly, creating an algae bloom. This excessive amount of algae prevents sunlight from reaching the bottom of the lake. The plants lacking sunlight will die at the bottom of the lake where decomposers will use up the oxygen. When a bloom occurs, there is too much organic matter ready to decompose and all the remaining oxygen in the water is used by decomposers to decompose dead plants. This can cause all our fish to suffocate from the lack of oxygen. With your help in preventing the overuse of fertilizer, we can work together to keep the lake healthy and beautiful for all residents to enjoy.



CHILDSPLACE LEARNING CENTRE





Childsplace Learning Centre is a licenced childcare program located in Arbour Lake at the Residents Association building. We offer childcare for children ages 19 months to 5 years in our daycare and before and after school care for children in kindergarten to Grade 6. Our hours are 6:30 am to 6:00 pm, Monday to Friday. Our program is open all year round and closed only on weekends and stat holidays. We offer low rates based on the affordability grant and BAS families can apply for a subsidy.

We offer a flight-inspired program where your child gets to help develop what we are learning about and what activities are exciting. We learn through play and have lots of discussions to help the children learn concepts of literacy, math, science, art, and music. We go outdoors into the field daily. Our school children have care for all the days off from school and we offer field trips to our BAS children as well.
