Kids Club – July 6 – August 26th, 2015





Crowchild Trail Corridor Study

The City of Calgary is restarting the transportation corridor study for Crowchild Trail between 24 Avenue N.W. and 17 Avenue S.W. The study will look at short-term improvements and the amount of space (right-of-way) required for the long-term upgrades needed to move high volumes of vehicular traffic and accommodate pedestrians, transit users and cyclists while minimizing impacts to adjacent communities. The Study will also look at the impacts of a no-build option for Crowchild Trail—that is, what happens to travel along and across the Crowchild Trail corridor if no changes are made.

The City previously started the study in 2010 but was directed by City Council to cease work until a Transportation Corridor Study Policy that guides how the public will be engaged on all corridor studies is developed. Council approved the Policy July 2014 and directed the project team to restart the Crowchild Trail Corridor Study.

The Crowchild Trail Corridor Study has a new six-phase study process. Phase 1 established an 18-person team with members from communities adjacent to Crowchild Trail and the general public. The team participated in three workshops to share their ideas about engaging Calgarians for the study and reviewed results from an online questionnaire completed by more than 500 Calgarians. In the last workshop, the team collaborated on a series of recommendations to the draft engagement program for Phases 2 to 6 of the Crowchild Trail Corridor Study.

Starting in May/June 2015, Calgarians will be invited to provide input on the project goals and objectives that will help guide the remainder of the study. Visit www. calgary.ca/crowchild for more information on how to get involved and to sign-up for email updates.





Jell-O can be used in desserts, salads, relishes, and confections. The recipes are simple and easy to make and Jell-O is light with a fresh fruit taste and has only 83 calories per half cup serving.

This recipe is from an old General Foods Kitchens book, Joys of Jell-O. There is no copyright information so I am just guessing this was published in the 1950's.

Remember when Mom used to make Fruit Cocktail Salad?

FRUIT COCKTAIL SALAD

A recipe you can change at will—almost any canned fruit may be used.

1 package (3 oz) Jell-O (any flavour)

1 cup boiling water

1 can fruit cocktail

1 tablespoon lemon juice

1/4 cup coarsely chopped nuts

1 banana, sliced

Dissolve Jell-O in boiling water. Drain fruit, measuring 3/4cup syrup. Add syrup and lemon juice to Jell-O. Chill until very thick. Then fold in fruit and nuts. Pour into a 1 quart mold or bowl or individual molds. Chill until firm. Unmold.

Makes about 3 ½ cups or 6 servings.

PARTY SALAD

1 package Lemon Jell-O

1 package Lime Jell-O

1 can crushed pineapple

1/2cup cottage cheese

1 cup whipped cream or Dream Whip Topping

1/4 cup chopped maraschino cherries

1/4 cup chopped blanched almonds

Dissolve Jell-O in boiling water. Drain pineapple, measuring $\frac{1}{2}$ cup syrup. Add to Jell-O. Chill until very thick. Fold in pineapple, cheese, whipped cream, cherries, and almonds. Pour into individual molds or a 9x5x3 inch loaf pan. Chill until firm. Unmold. Makes $4\frac{1}{2}$ cups or 8 servings.


