

We Need Your Vote to Keep Our LEAF Program Alive!

Have you experienced and felt the beauty and serenity of Hawkwood's flower displays lining our streets and entrances? Have you simply enjoyed spending valuable time in our caringly groomed parks and greenspaces with family, friends, or solo? Does the greenery and spice of our winter displays provide a little warmth on those cold winter days?

Hawkwood Community Association's LEAF Program provides all of this and more!

In the late 1990s and early 2000s, Hawkwood residents endured a growing deterioration of our community from its age and ever dwindling parks services. In 2004, Hawkwood homeowners subsequently voted strongly in favour of implementing our LEAF program. Community volunteers with the Hawkwood Community Association direct the program and oversight is provided by the City of Calgary. Our program's success has inspired growth to 11 additional communities within Calgary.

For a once-per-year tax levy of \$73.91 (for 2024) collected with our property taxes, 100% of these funds is directly used to provide:

- Flowers in 88 large flowerpots throughout the community
- Winter features in all 88 flowerpots
- Weekly mowing of all 62 greenspaces and parks in Hawkwood
- Watering of medians during prolonged dry weather
- Weekly litter pickup and inspection of the 62 greenspaces and parks
- Irrigation in eligible small parks

- Spring and Autumn cleanup of all greenspaces and parks
- Liaising with Calgary Parks on improvements, efficiencies, and policies
- Fast response times with 3-1-1 or other parks related concerns
- Customized administration of the program

Since the LEAF program's implementation, Hawkwood has enjoyed many benefits, including at a minimum:

- The only part of our property tax of which 100% goes directly back into Hawkwood
- In addition to our contribution, Calgary Parks grants Hawkwood the money they would have spent in our parks, work which the Hawkwood Community Association now carries out at 1/3 of the cost
- The benefit of flexibility and customization of care in our parks
- Reduced vandalism (taking care of the "Broken Windows" theory)
- Increased desirability of real estate purchases in Hawkwood
- Inspires homeowners to take pride in their own landscaping and yard care
- · Creates a wonderful feeling to come home to!

Every five years, communities with LEAF Programs are required to confirm program participation by holding a public vote, open for all homeowners who pay the levy.

We know our schedules can be hectic, but please consider showing your support for keeping the program alive! Your vote to keep the program matters a lot and it is simple to do.

Please stop by the Uplands Recreation Centre on Tuesday, October 8, anytime between 4:00 and 8:00 pm to submit your vote.

Please bring a copy of your Property Tax form and matching Government Issued Identification to ensure you are the owner of the property to vote.

There will be information and people to answer all your questions on hand.

Please watch for the community entrance signs, and our website, hawkwoodca.com, for reminders and updates as the vote approaches. We look forward to seeing you and hearing any feedback you may have a well. This is your program! This is your Hawkwood!

News from the Community Garden

The Community Garden organizing group is small (six members) and some of us are new, so we have appreciated the support we have received this year from HCA Board Members Michele del Valle, Laurie Robertson, and Heather Kovach.

All 42 of the garden's raised beds were in use this year. In addition to renting a bed, each gardener takes on responsibility for one of the communal areas, which include beds around the perimeter of the garden, boxes beside the backstop, and trees and shrubs. Calgary's water restrictions took effect in June just as plants were getting started. Some gardeners began bringing non-potable water from home, but we were subsequently notified by the City that community gardens are permitted to use City water during restrictions. As requested by the City, we encouraged gardeners to use the minimum required by plants and trees. The restrictions appear to have made many gardeners more conscious of our water use.

The six fruit trees supplied by the City and planted in 2023 seem to be thriving. The cherry and apple trees each produced a small amount of fruit.

We're happy to welcome students from nearby schools. Classes in grades one, two, and four from Hawkwood School used a total of five raised beds. Several classes from St. Maria Goretti School spent time with one of our volunteers learning about the garden.

The leader of a local Scouting group, Beavers (aged five to seven), contacted us with the offer of a community service project: bee baths, which are now located in several spots. These are shallow containers with rocks where bees can land and safely drink. We love our pollinators!

Additions to the garden this year included the donation of a water barrel which has been placed on a stand near the backstop. We hope the barrel will improve accessibility to water for gardeners who find it challenging to use the hoses. A seed library has been set up to provide for the ongoing exchange of seeds.

Gardeners got together for two work bees - one in spring, and the other on August 24, for weeding,

working on the perennial beds, and general cleanup. A group of volunteers also picked up a load of compost from the City of Calgary.

As always, we are happy to have community members visit the garden. All are welcome - whether it's two friends having a snack at the picnic table, a preschooler looking for ripe strawberries, or a community member making the garden part of their daily stroll. We love it when people ask questions and are always happy to explain how we grow those giant zucchinis!





Nose Hill Park is one of the largest urban parks in North America and is distinguished by its unique geological, ecological, and anthropological history (https:// inaturalist.ca/projects/nose-hill-park-bioinventory). With an abundance of remarkable flora and fauna, this project aims to record observations made by Park users. This information and a quick update were posted on our Facebook page about how the Nose Hill Park iNaturalist project is going. There have been many awesome observations this year. Since January over 2,600 observations have been added. We have nearly 10,000 iNaturalist posts made for the Park. Let's keep the momentum going! Hopefully, we will be close to 11,000 by 2025 and encourage everyone to share their photos of flora and fauna on the Hill. We recently surpassed 200,000 posts made within the City of Calgary municipal boundaries. Of course, you can post (on iNaturalist generally) your biodiversity photos from anywhere in the world, including your own yard and other favourite parks. All this data will help to guide the Nature Calgary updated "Green Book" which is currently in the data collection phase.

World Migratory Bird Day is on the second Saturday in October and again in May. The goal is to raise awareness of issues affecting migratory birds and to inspire action around the world to take measures for their conservation. Migrating birds may fly from 24 kms to 960 kms or more per day. Hawks, swifts, swallows, and waterfowl migrate primarily during the day, while many songbirds migrate at night. Calgary has over 200 bird species and is one of Canada's first Bird Friendly Cities certified by Nature Canada. Bylaws preventing off leash dogs and encouraging people to stay on designated paths can lessen disturbance and decrease the risks to sensitive grasslands species.
