- Stay alert and watch for pedestrians.
- Share the road with cyclists.
- Be kind to your neighbours.

As pedestrians, we are also responsible for contributing to traffic safety, which includes:

- Crossing streets safely, at a corner or intersection.
- · Watching for turning vehicles.
- Making eye contact with drivers.
- · Being kind to your neighbours.




