Giving Thanks in Edgemont

Thanksgiving and the whole month of October bring the culmination of another growing season as we embark into the longer nights and the promise of dramatic change in our community's landscape and weather affecting our day to day lives. Yes, we bid farewell to our intense display of flowers, but our iconic winter displays are ready to jump into our scenery once again, adding warmth to our colder days.

Your ELM Program made efforts this year to take care of some ageing landscape features and rejuvenate some shrub beds. Pruning was done on our median shrubs, and we are always identifying areas for improvements for next year.

We saw some savings with irrigation this year. The wet, early summer caused the irrigation systems to automatically throttle back on water delivery quantities, and the scheduled water restrictions this fall to bring the Bearspaw water main into reality shortened the irrigation eligibility season.

Preparations are well underway for 2027 summer and winter ELM program deliveries and displays, and to continuously improve the delivery of the ELM program behind the scenes to ensure good end results. New City of Calgary ELM policy and initiative changes are in development and provide an ever-solidifying foundation for the program for decades to come.

One new initiative will be to reduce water usage 30% by 2030. ELM programs are beginning to find new and proven ways to adapt while continuing to deliver the epic community-led landscape enhancements that are the program's fundamental purpose. The prospect of water savings unfortunately does not necessarily translate into cost savings, as the price we all pay for water will likely increase as Bow Valley water users increase in numbers while our small headwater sources continue to decrease in volume and reliability. Reducing water usage is therefore not an optional undertaking if we wish to have a sustainable program which keeps the same level of beauty and displays throughout. We are looking forward to this responsible challenge!

Thanksgiving. Halloween. Perhaps you will have an

opportunity to walk through our many parks and pathways on a moonlit October night, kicking and shuffling your feet through layers of fallen leaves. This month has so much to offer in Edgemont! Our seemingly ever-present chinook arch is back, keeping us company as we look forward to the cumulus clouds of spring and summer to return signaling another growing season is upon Edgemont.

Bylaws Related To Dogs

Navigating Calgary's dog bylaws is crucial for fostering a positive neighborhood and ensuring your furry friend's well-being. Abiding by these regulations is an integral aspect of responsible dog ownership. Please find the full Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw here:





Here's a breakdown of the key points:

Licensing:
Every dog, by the age of three months, must have a City of Calgary license.

Leashing:
Keep your dog on a leash at all times unless indicated otherwise by posted signs or on your property where you have the right of occupation.

Transportation:
Dogs transported in the back of a truck must be secured in a fully enclosed trailer, a truck bed covered with a topper, or a ventilated kennel secured to the truck bed.

Waste Management:
Carry a suitable means to pick up after your dog, both on and off your property.

Off-Leash Areas:
In designated off-leash areas, dogs must remain in sight of their owners and respond to sight or sound commands.
