President's Message



September is a month where you are not quite sure what kind of weather you are going to face. Often, it seems to me to be the nicest time of the year with warm days, cool nights, and the landscape changing colour. You certainly need to break out your sweaters. The first

year I moved to Calgary we had snow days toward the end of the month, and I had to pull my parka out of storage. Let's hope that's not the case this year.

Have you been enjoying the flowers in our flowerpots and flower beds? They seem to have been particularly vibrant this summer and will likely flourish well into the fall. Thanks to the ELM Committee and Mark Koelbl for their stewardship of this program. It is one of the most visible projects the Edgemont Community Association undertakes, and I often get compliments from residents who say how much they value this aspect of Edgemont.

We continue to follow up on residents' concerns about irresponsible dog owners, particularly in John Laurie Park, as well as the speeding issues on various Edgemont thoroughfares. I'd like to acknowledge the support we have had from DJ Kelly and his team in helping us get some action on these matters. I'll continue to follow up until we have a satisfactory response.

ECA, under the leadership of Barb Elms, is working on the security upgrades for our Community Centre. We have a tentative plan thanks to a security review done by the Calgary Police Service and have applied for funding. Once we have funding in place and have had additional conversations with Trotter Morton, the vendor who will be doing the work within the Centre, I will have more information to share. The work is likely to interrupt the use of ECC somewhat, but we will do our best to keep disruptions to a minimum.

Bridging Two Beautiful Seasons in Edgemont!

September bridges two seasons beautifully, offering a mix of lingering summer warmth and the fresh, crisp promise of fall in Edgemont. We hope to cling on to our flower colour and texture as long as nature will decide for us.

From a wet, cool start to a hot, dry mid-summer, peppered with our fair share of hail, our flowers endured another season to brighten our community. We are not nearing the end of the ELM program for the year, but rather just one of many seasons that flow into each other without end. ELM provides care in Edgemont during all 12 months of the year. While we cherish the remaining weeks of summer, we look forward to the next season!

Late this summer, we made efforts to take care of some aging landscape features and rejuvenate some shrub beds. Pruning was done on our median shrubs, and we worked with Urban Forestry to identify areas for improvements.

We are expecting to see some savings with irrigation this year. The wet, early summer caused the irrigation system to automatically throttle back on water delivery quantities, and the planned water restrictions in September to bring the Bears paw water main into reality will shorten the irrigation eligibility season.

Preparations are already underway to plan for 2027 summer and winter displays, and to continuously improve the delivery of the ELM program behind the scenes to ensure good end results.

As we make our way through into autumn, probably too quickly, let's make the most to enjoy Edgemont's ELM program!

Curbside Treasure Hunt: One Weekend, Countless Finds.



On September 12 and 13, join the city-wide Curbside Treasure Hunt! Set out gently used items on your curb and label them with a sign saying “free” for neighbours to take and/or explore your neighbourhood for free finds as well. It’s a fun and easy way to give your things a second life and keep usable items out of the landfill.

How it Works:

1. Clear the Clutter

Look around your home for items you no longer need, but someone else might love.

2. Label it “Free”

Clearly mark each item with a “free” sign so people know it’s part of the Treasure Hunt. Download a template at calgary.ca/treasurehunt.

3. Set it Out

Place your items neatly at the curb Saturday morning.

4. Remove Items That are Not Part of the Hunt.

Make sure anything on your lawn or on the curb that you plan to keep is removed, put away, or secured, so it’s clear what’s free to take and what’s not.

5. Treasure Hunt!

Explore your neighbourhood and discover free finds all weekend long (only take items clearly labelled free).

6. Wrap it up

By Sunday, September 13 at 5:00 p.m., remove any untaken items from your curb and consider donating them to a local charity.

For safety reasons, please don’t put out items that could be hazardous or not safe to reuse, such as:

- Mattresses
- Toilets
- Unsafe or recalled items
- Baby gear or safety equipment that may not meet current standards

Do you live in a condo or apartment? You can participate as well! Coordinate with your property manager to establish a shared drop-off location. Let’s keep good things out of the landfill. Happy treasure hunting!
