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Hall Update

The De Winton Community Hall Gets a Facelift!

De Winton Hall has long been a cornerstone of our community, bringing neighbours together for generations of events, gatherings, and celebrations. In 1996, a devastating fire destroyed the original hall, but through the determination and support of the community, it was rebuilt—stronger and more vibrant than ever. Now, nearly 30 years later, our beloved hall continues to serve us well, but it is time to update, replace, and fix some of our infrastructure.

Through the hard work of the Board of Directors—we have secured several grants and additional funds to move forward with a number of critical infrastructure improvements which will cost us just excess of \$200,000. It is important to note that we received support from volunteers in the community who helped secure quotes, tracked down vendors, and other important jobs which helped our Board. We are very grateful for their time and effort. Many, many hours of work went into creating presentations, creating grants, securing estimates for the services, and presenting our needs to various support groups. We are so pleased to advise this hard work and commitment has provided us with funds that will enable us to move forward with our critical projects as outlined below.

Roof Replacement

Our roof was showing its age and was in dire need of an overhaul. Over the past year, particularly as we lived through an unusually rainy period last June and July, Board members and our Office Manager were called out at all times to grab buckets and mops to clean up the latest leak. We did many patch repairs, but the answer was obvious. We needed a new roof. As you can image a new roof is very expensive for a non-profit such as ourselves, and we took on the challenge to secure additional funds to make this renovation occur.

We are so pleased to confirm we received funding covering a large portion of our costs from CFEP (Community Facility Enhancement Program), the Dunbow Recreation Board, and a much-appreciated discount from our roofing company, First Class Roofing and Renovations, Inc.

Our new roof has now been installed and just in time as we are enduring the early rains in June. A big thank you to the volunteers who put in countless hours planning, researching, grant writing, and doing the post construction garden and grounds cleanup.

Furnaces, Boiler and Air Conditioning

30 years down the road and our very outdated furnace and boiler system is beginning to fall apart. This component is critical to our operations. Without the boiler we would have no hot water and our facility would have to shut down in accordance with Alberta Health Care requirements. We must have hot water for our kitchen and for our other operations. Through the mastery of our President Mike Kosinec and our Officer Manager Matt Coveart, we have held our furnace and boiler together with love and buttons, but the time has come to deal with this major beast. Because it is not a high efficacy system, we were incurring addition operating costs that are no longer justifiable.

In addition, one of our major sources of revenue is the rental income generated from our weddings. Unfortunately, over the years, we have lost a few potential rentals because we do not have air conditioning. As a result, we looked into what the additional expense would be to include this feature as we update our facility, and we are thrilled to confirm that we will be adding air conditioning to our facility.

Again, we had many helping hands securing quotes, putting together presentations, and applying for grants wherever possible. We are so grateful and appreciative to the Dunbow Recreation Board who have provided a grant which will cover roughly a significant portion of the budgeted cost to replace this system.

New Road Signs

Getting our information out to our community is an essential task for this Board. We want to ensure we are meeting the needs of our community and enjoying time together as a community. Although we use various forms of media, we have found that our signage boards have been very effective over the years. Just like our infrastructure, our signage was aged and dated and due for an overhaul. Thanks to our Communication Director, Mia Staysco, for taking the lead with our volunteers to redesign our signage and to the Dunbow Recreation Board who helped us with a generous contribution towards the upgrade. You will be seeing our newly designed signs up and around as we get the last of the bugs worked out and get them out throughout our community. Again, over 40 hours of volunteer labour plus designing, planning, and grant writing went into this project. Thank you!

A couple of years ago at our famous annual Canada Day Breakfast, we had an unfortunate incident when one of our long-standing members tripped on a protruding step and injured herself. As we reviewed the incident at the next Board meeting, we were concerned and felt we needed to fix the problem. As with all things, it wasn't that simple, and what had initially appeared to be a quick fix turned into a major project. We couldn't simply remove the step, we had to rebuild, re-enforce, and re-cover the entire deck. Again, our amazing Board stepped into action and applied for grants and were thrilled to receive a grant from the Dunbow Recreation Board which supported this project for a significant portion of the cost. The project was completed in the spring of 2025 and the feedback was outstanding. It was a grand success that has received many compliments from our community and our rental users.

Stack them high for all to see

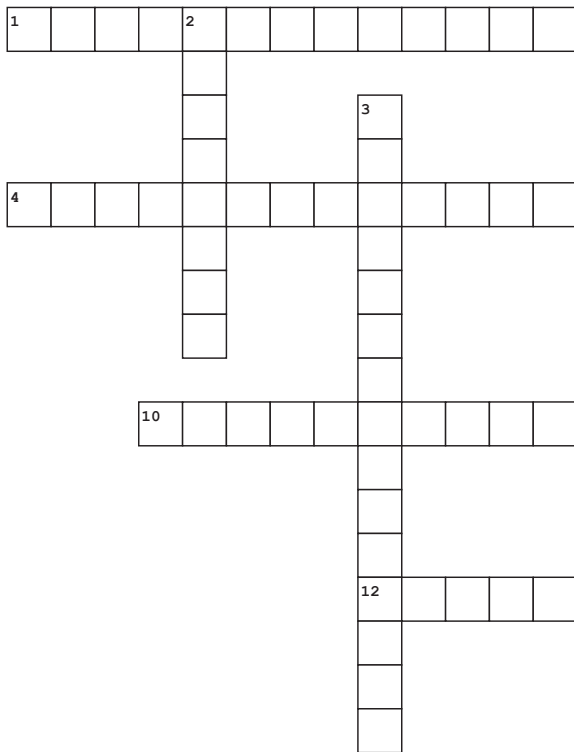

Grab a fork and find a ladder

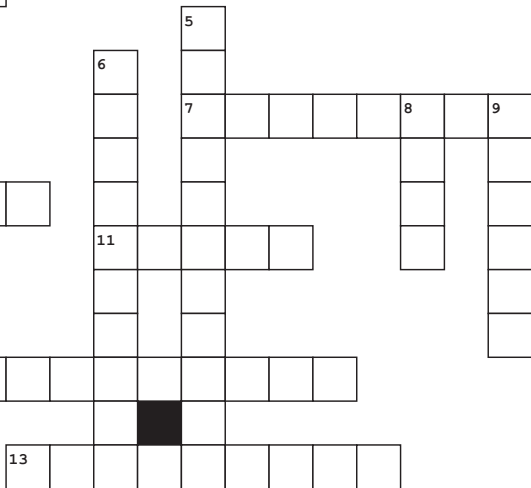
Stack those pancakes to the sky

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RECIPE OF THE MONTH

July 30 is National Cheesecake Day!

Try baking one of your own to celebrate!



Ingredients

- 2 cups of graham crumbs
- 1/2 cup of butter or margarine, melted
- 1/4 cup of white granulated sugar
- 2 tsp of nutmeg (optional, make it whatever flavour you would like)
- 2 blocks of cream cheese (6oz)
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 3/4 cups of white granulated sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 tbsp vanilla extract, or vanilla bean paste

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 325° F. The lower temperature will help the centre cook without burning the exterior.
2. In your 9' spring pan or baking dish, pour in your graham crumb, 1/4 cup of sugar and melted butter. Using your hands gently combine everything until it becomes equally incorporated. It should feel like wet sand. If mix seems too dry you can add a little more butter to help it stick.
3. Spread the mixture evenly across the base of the pan and firmly press down into an even layer. Feel free to use a heavy glass or another pan to help pack it down.
4. Set aside while preparing the filling.
5. In a large bowl add your cream cheese blocks, sour cream, nutmeg, and sugar.
6. Beat the two ingredients together either with a hand mixer on speed 2, or by hand if you prefer. We are looking for the mixture to be smooth and fluffy.
7. Add the eggs and vanilla and continue mixing. At the end you should have a smooth, thick batter that coats the blades of your mixer.
8. You've made it! This is the easy part. Simply pour your batter overtop of the prepared base, smooth out the top to make it as even as possible, and place it in the oven. Let it bake for 45 minutes to an hour. If you're feeling fancy, you can spray some water into the oven around the halfway point. This steams the oven and can give the cheesecake a more even tone. You know it is done when you gently shake the pan and there is little to no movement in the centre
9. Remove from the oven, rest at room temperature until completely cooled, and enjoy your delicious cheesecake.



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The Half-Finished Things Taking Up More Space Than You Think

By July, most of us have settled into the rhythm of the year. The ambitious goals we set in January have either become habits or quietly disappeared. Summer calendars are booked up. Vacation plans are underway. Work remains busy. Life keeps moving.

On the surface, everything seems manageable.

Yet many people carry a lingering feeling that they can't quite shake. A sense that there's always something they should be doing. Something they forgot. Something waiting for their attention.

Often, the source of that feeling isn't a major problem. It's the accumulation of half-finished things.

- A passport renewal that still needs to be submitted.
- A dental appointment that hasn't been booked.
- The pile of paperwork on the kitchen counter.
- The quotes you need to get to fix the garage door.
- The email that requires a response.
- The donations that have been sitting in your trunk for months.

None of these tasks are particularly difficult. Most could be completed in a few hours. Yet they remain unfinished, quietly occupying mental space day after day.

What makes these tasks so draining is not the amount of time they require. It's the fact that our brains continue to track them. Every unfinished task becomes an open tab. We may not be actively thinking about it, but part of our attention remains attached to it.

Over time, dozens of small open tabs can create a surprising amount of mental clutter.

This is one reason so many people feel busy even when they haven't accomplished anything particularly

demanding. Their energy is being divided among countless loose ends.

I've noticed that when people feel overwhelmed, they often assume they need a vacation, a new productivity system, or a complete life overhaul. Sometimes what they actually need is far simpler.

They need to close a few open tabs. July is an ideal time to do exactly that.

The halfway point of the year offers a natural opportunity to revisit the tasks and responsibilities that have been quietly following us for months. Not everything needs immediate attention, but most of us can identify a handful of lingering items that would bring an immediate sense of relief if they were finally completed.

A useful place to start is with appointments. Health checkups, vehicle maintenance, home services, and routine administrative tasks are often postponed because they feel inconvenient to schedule. Yet once they are booked, the mental burden often disappears.

The second area is paperwork. Forms, renewals, applications, and documents have a way of accumulating until they feel far more intimidating than they actually are.

Third, consider household projects. Not the major renovations, but the small repairs and organizational tasks that repeatedly catch your attention every time you walk past them.

Next, look at financial loose ends. Unused subscriptions, unanswered insurance questions, budget reviews, or savings goals that haven't been revisited since the start of the year.

Finally, take inventory of the decisions you've been avoiding. Some unfinished tasks are not tasks at all. They are decisions waiting to be made. The longer they remain unresolved, the more energy they consume.

The purpose of a mid-year reset isn't to become more productive. It's to create more breathing room.

Sometimes the biggest improvement we can make is not adding something new to our lives. It's finally completing the things that have been quietly following us around for months.

As the second half of the year begins, that may be the most valuable fresh start of all!
