Bylaws For Helping to Be a Better Neighbour

Community Cleanliness Issues

Composting: Under the Community Standards Bylaw, you must ensure composting piles or composting containers are maintained, so they do not create offensive odors or attract pests. Fines for violations range between \$50 and \$100.

Drainage: The Drainage Bylaw, the Wastewater Bylaw, and the Community Standards Bylaw all outline rules for drainage to ensure nothing inappropriate ends up in our rivers. For information on fines, search for the Bylaws Related to Drainage page. It is an offence to allow any prohibited material into the Storm Drainage System. Examples of prohibited materials include soil, waste, animal waste, fecal matter, cooking oils, greases, gasoline, motor oil, transmission fluids, solvents, paint, cement, sawdust, yard waste, pesticides, biomedical waste, hazardous waste, soaps, odorous materials, detergents, and water from hot tubs.

Vehicles must be washed at a car wash and not on a road, an alley, or a driveway. Drain hot tubs and swimming pools directly into the wastewater drain located in the basement of your residence.

Downspouts and eavestroughs must not terminate within two meters of a surface drainage facility (unless located in a side yard) or a street, which includes alleys and lanes.

It is a requirement to keep surface drainage facilities on private property (known as "Overland Drainage Right-of-Way" (ODRW), including swales and catch basins/drains) clear of any soil, silt, yard waste, or any other matter that may obstruct, restrict, or prevent the flow of water. Buildings or structures cannot be constructed or placed on or over the surface drainage facility. If a fence must be built over the facility, there must be at least six inches (15 cm) of clearance between the facility and the bottom of the fence.

The use of any storm drainage for activities such as construction or irrigation purposes is prohibited without the written consent of the Director of Resources.

Fines for violations of these regulations range between \$75 and \$3,000 for the first offence.

Grass and herbaceous plants: Under the Community Standards Bylaw, private property owners must ensure that grasses and herbaceous plants do not exceed 15 cm (six inches) in height. Fines for violations range between \$100 and \$300. Property owners are also responsible for caring for, and maintaining, the area adjacent to their property (i.e., boulevards) up to the middle of the alley and the street.

If you know of a bylaw infraction and would like to report it to Animal and Bylaw Services, please call 3-1-1 (from within Calgary) or 403-268-CITY (2489) (from outside Calgary).

Shrimp And Rice Noodle Stir Fry

Seafood has a variety of nutrients that contribute to our well-being and is also low in calories.

A great source of lean protein, seafood is good for our eyes, heart, brain, muscles, skin, and bones.

Generally, fatty fish such as salmon and mackerel are better as they contain fat soluble nutrients our bodies can absorb.

Raw shrimp should be firm, and their shells should always be translucent, greyish green, light pink, or a pinkish tan in colour.

Seafood is delicious, healthy, cost-effective, and easy to prepare as shown in the recipe below.

Prep Time: 15 minutes **Cook Time:** 15 minutes

Servings: 3 to 4

Ingredients:

- 225 g rice noodles
- 16 jumbo size shrimp
- ½ red pepper thinly sliced
- 16 snow peas
- 12 baby carrots, sliced
- · 8 broccoli florets
- 4 green onions thinly sliced
- 4 tbsp vegetable oil
- 4 to 5 tbsp dark soy sauce
- 4 tbsp green curry paste
- 1 tbsp red chilli flakes

Directions:

- 1. Prepare rice noodles in accordance with package instructions, drain and set aside.
- 2. Heat 3 tbsp of oil in a wok or skillet, add green onions and sauté until they turn a light brown.
- 3. Add the sliced carrots, red pepper, broccoli, and snow peas. Stir fry for about five minutes or until tender, then add the green curry paste and soy sauce and sauté for another two to three minutes. Remove from heat while you cook the shrimp.

- 4. In a frying pan or wok, heat the remaining oil, add the shrimp, and sauté for three to four minutes or until the shrimp turn pink and are no longer translucent.
- 5. Add cooked shrimp and noodles to the veggies and return skillet to the stove allowing it to heat through before serving.
- 6. Garnish individual bowls with sliced green onion and some chilli peppers if desired.

Get to Know the Green Line

by the City of Calgary

With main construction of the Green Line LRT kicking off later in 2024, we know Calgarians are overwhelmingly supportive of the project, but they have some questions. Which is great, as we have answers! Calgarians want to understand what we are building. Where exactly will it go? How long will construction take? How much will it cost? And what do we get for this level of investment?

It's time you got to know a bit more about us! The Green Line is a project for Calgarians, being delivered by Calgarians. Phase One of the Green Line will span 18 kilometres from Shepard Station at 130 Ave SE to Eau Claire at the north end of downtown. With 13 stations, it will provide connections to the Red and Blue LRT lines and three MAX rapid bus routes. But how much will it cost? Currently, Green Line has \$5.5 billion in funding to complete Phase One, from The City, the province, and the federal government.

Main construction of tracks, stations, bridges, and tunnels will begin in 2024, and the project will take approximately six years to build. However, did you know that \$400 million of early works construction is already completed or underway?

Phase One of the Green Line LRT is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history. Construction starts this year, and the benefits will last a lifetime. We want Calgarians to know all about the Green Line and encourage you to learn more at calgary.ca/GreenLine.
