

#### **MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD**

Well, everyone – more good news. We got about \$68,000 in funding from the City for projects around the centre. What are we doing with the money? New gym doors to fix the hinges (people keep wedging the hinges to keep the gym doors open – so it's around \$6,000 each time they need to be replaced), a new sump pump system to ensure we don't flood, some plumbing repairs, gym lighting remediation, new wooden light poles for our rink/outdoor area, new fire shutters in the kitchen and new bathroom vanities. We are hoping for the provincial grant to cover the other 25 to 50 percent of the costs above.

Other repairs that are going on around the centre are electrical circuit tracing and bathroom door repairs – exciting? Not really but it gives you some insight into what happens around the centre.

#### DRCA Casino, May 22 and 23

We need volunteers! Please sign up online by clicking the button at the top of deerruncalgary.com. Put your contact information so we can get you the official form. This could mean anywhere from \$50,000 to \$70,000 of funding for your community. The money is spent on items that affect all community members (the AGLC are quite strict). This year's casino is at the Deerfoot Inn and Casino – as always.

The Daycare improvements are coming along. There is a super-secret team picking the colours of the new daycare space. It's super-secret because such topics split organizations (no I am not kidding), so we have decided to just let them decide on the colour scheme. Just look at what happened downstairs; people love it, with the exception of a few critics. It is bright, cheerful, and plain fun, especially compared to the old drab colours which were likely "in" when those colours were updated. Lastly, the designs for the new day care are in! We are just waiting for permits.

We believe we have someone to lead the flower planters. We have money coming for new asphalt for the rink, but we really need project management and admin volunteers to finalize the placement, dot all the i's and cross all the t's. We are likely turning the hockey rink to allow a pleasure rink in front of the hockey rink. If you have experience writing business plans, communicating with your neighbours via writing and working with project planning or procurement – we really need a few hours a week. ## Program Spotlight: South Calgary Wado Kai Karate Club

It has been almost three decades since sensei Heather Fidyk and sensei Darren Fidyk founded the South Calgary Wado Kai Karate Club (SCWKKC), a non-profit organization dedicated to enhancing health, fitness, and martial arts understanding. Thirty years of teaching have left a stamp on the community, but the club has also imprinted itself on its longtime leader.

"The organization has become a characteristic of who I am and a part of the lives of many of our ranking members," says Sensei Heather Fidyk, a seventh-degree black belt with over 25 years of coaching experience. "Some, like me, have been part of the club for over half their life."

The SCWKKC offers services to Southern Calgary communities through various activities, including classes, workshops, and tournaments. As part of the Shintani Wado Kai Karate Federation and Karate Alberta, the club upholds a commitment to quality martial arts education.

Sensei Heather Fidyk's background as an international competitor and a seasoned coach enables her to develop athletes through effective guidance, coaching, and mentoring. Heather's approach to coaching extends beyond karate training to include valuable life skills such as respect, discipline, humility, listening, and communication. She emphasizes learning, working hard, and playing sports a fun, lifelong endeavour. This has created a welcoming, student-centric, and fun learning environment for kids, families, and athletes of all levels within the Deer Run Community. She also works with para-athletes and finds the mentoring process both rewarding and exciting.

The South Calgary Karate club has classes for all ages and people, from our Just for Kicks (JFK) program for three to five year old kids, family classes for all ages, and ranges from beginner up, advanced belt classes for higher ranks, black belt training for senior ranks, and competitive training in association with Karate Alberta. Students can train in basic movements and forms of martial arts, family classes, kata (pre-arranged sequences of movements), kumite (sport fighting), Shindo (short stick weapons form), as well as local, provincial, and national tournaments, clinics, and workshops.

## Fall In Love with Pickleball: The World's Fastest Growing Sport Needs to Grow a Little More In Deer Run – And Here's Why

Kyle May showed up to the courts to play tennis. He left the court that day with an unexpected passion for a quirky new game.

"We showed up with our tennis rackets and gear, then Craig Button came over," says May, dropping the name of former Flames General Manager and currently one of Sportsnet's top hockey analysts. "They asked us to play, and I fell in love with it."

What kind of game could divert your carefully planned tennis match and create such a strong connection in a single afternoon? Pickleball.

It's the fastest growing game in North America. Its surging popularity pushed by celebrities like reality TV queens The Kardashians, former NFL star receiver Larry Fitzgerald, supermodel Heidi Klum and yes, even our own rumpled Craig Button. Button himself would be surprised to see his name in the same sentence as those other celebrities, but that's what makes pickleball so unique; it's played by seniors, teenagers, and toddlers alike - all who can learn it in fifteen minutes and fall in love by match end.

It all started when a group of ragtag rowers in the "pickleboat" needed something to keep their kids busy while they were on the water. They had ping pong paddles, a badminton net and a plastic wiffle ball. Pickleball was born. Essentially, it's wiffle-ball tennis played on a much smaller, badminton-sized court – which has its advantages.

"You can fit two pickle ball courts on a standard tennis court," says May. "Eight people can fit on a court that would usually have a max of four."

Later, it became the perfect pandemic pastime. Pickleball courts can be set up in a typical Deer Run driveway, and the game is such that highly skilled players can match up against beginners, and the young can play and compete against the old. It was the perfect way to spend time with your family outside, while staying home.

Today, Major League Pickleball projects the sport to grow at 30 to 40 per cent every year in the next ten years, increasing amateur players from 5 million to 40 million, and vaulting itself in popularity over golf and tennis in the process.

"If you've ever taught someone to play tennis, it's difficult. The ball is flying everywhere and you're either hitting it too hard, or not hard enough," says May. "Pickleball is a game where anyone can pick it up and rally."

That versatility is spreading the sport like wildfire. And it's spread here, too. Come down to the Deer Run Community Centre on Sunday mornings between 9:45 am to 12:45 pm and try for yourself. Grab paddles and balls from the front desk on your way into the gym.

Sceptical? Scared? Even avid players like May were hesitant before finally picking up the paddle, but he's an advocate now.

"Just try it once and you'll love it."

Budget 2024 – a plan that prioritizes investments in health, education, and safety, and that ensures our province will continue to grow and thrive for generations to come.

Health care is a key pillar of Budget 2024. If passed, the budget would invest \$1 billion over three years to transform the continuing care system in response to the Facility-Based Continuing Care Review; \$475 million to support the continued implementation of the Modernizing Alberta's Primary Health Care System initiative, including \$200 million over two years to improve access to family physicians; \$10 million for primary health care initiatives in Indigenous communities; and \$15 million to further develop a compensation model for nurse practitioners.

Budget 2024 also focuses strongly on education. This budget would invest \$1.9 billion to support 98 school projects over the next three years. \$681 million in new funding would be invested to support priority school projects, including 43 new projects announced in the budget, creating a total of 35,000 new or modernized student spaces for children around the province. And an additional \$1.5 billion would be invested for educational learning supports for vulnerable students, children with specialized learning needs, and other students requiring additional supports.

Alberta provides among the most generous affordability measures and social supports across the country and Budget 2024 continues to help alleviate the financial burdens on Albertans. This includes \$717 million in capital grants over three years to advance Alberta's Affordable Housing Strategy, which incorporates \$254 million in new funding to help build about 3,300 new affordable housing units and complete 1,800 units already underway.

Finally, Budget 2024 focuses on paying down debt. An estimated \$6.4 billion in surplus cash is projected at the end of 2023-24 and Alberta's government is using half to pay off maturing debt this fiscal year. Of the remaining \$3.2 billion surplus cash, a forecast \$2 billion will be put in the Alberta Fund, and the other \$1.2 billion is being allocated to debt repayment to limit new borrowing required in 2024-25.

Budget 2024 is a responsible plan that prioritizes the needs of Albertans and their families and will help ensure Alberta continues to be one of the best places in the world to live, work, play, raise a family, or start a business.
