This project ensures the facility continues to provide reliable wastewater treatment for Calgarians with a focus on protecting the environment. Other benefits include new high quality odour control systems, the reduction of noise, and the incorporation of visual berming, landscaping and lighting.



As we step into a brand-new year, let's take a moment to reflect on the highlights and achievements of our vibrant community over the past 12 months. Thank you to everyone who contributed to making Deer Run a warm and welcoming place to live, work, and play. Here are some memorable moments from 2024:

January 2024



The 2025 Property Assessment notices are out. When you receive your notice, check the property details and review your property value. Your property assessment reflects the market value of your property on July 1, 2024, and the characteristics and physical condition of the property on December 31, 2024.

To help you review your property assessment we offer general resources on calgary.ca/assessment and property specific tools through the secure logon feature of Assessment Search at calgary.ca/assessmentsearch. By logging onto your property specific account on Assessment Search, you can:

- Check the property details used to determine the assessed value of your property.
- Update your residential property details. It's important you keep your information current, as incorrect property details may result in assessments that do not accurately reflect the value of your property.
- Compare your property's assessed value to other similar properties in your area to ensure fairness.
- Review real estate market trends and learn how your property was assessed.

New to Assessment Search? Visit calgary.ca/about-assessment-search to learn how to set up your account.

We offer a property tax calculator at calgary.ca/ assessment to help you estimate your 2025 Property Taxes and find out where your tax dollars go.

If you have questions about your 2025 property assessment, please contact us during the 2025 Customer Review Period which runs from January 2 to March 11, 2025. Your property is used to calculate your annual property tax bill, which is mailed in the spring.





Happy New Year! Wishing you and your loved ones a 2025 filled with endless opportunities, cherished memories, and boundless joy. May your holiday season have been full of love, laughter, and warmth, paving the way for a bright and hopeful year ahead.

The Alberta Legislature concluded its fall session on December 4, 2024, passing 13 laws focused on protecting Albertans' rights and freedoms. Highlights include:

- Alberta Bill of Rights Amendment Act: Reinforced rights
 protections.
- Health Statutes, Education Amendment, and Fairness in Sport Acts: A suite of legislation that preserves choice for minors, supports student success and well-being in schools, and protects fairness and safety for Albertan athletes in sport.

Privacy legislation was modernized by replacing the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act with the Protection of Privacy Act, which introduced Canada's strictest privacy protections, and the Access to Information Act, streamlining processes for faster response times.

The second motion of the Alberta Sovereignty within a United Canada Act passed, enabling strong provincial action against potential federal emissions caps threatening Alberta's economy.

Additional laws passed include:

- Early Learning and Child Care Amendment Act: Enhanced accountability, transparency, workforce stability, and safety in child care.
- Meat Inspection Amendment Act: Increased penalties for illegal meat sales, protecting consumers.
- Service Alberta Statutes Amendment Act: Strengthened economic protections and fairness.
- Justice Statutes Amendment Act: Improved crime reporting, court processes, and infrastructure definitions.
- Financial Statutes Amendment Act: Ensured sustainability of benefit programs and long-term economic growth.
- All-Season Resorts Act: Promoted sustainable tourism development to preserve Alberta's natural beauty.

This session modernized key laws to address Alberta's evolving needs while safeguarding its economic and social future.


