Guess the Flower

1. This native wildflower, known as the Devil’s Nettle, grows in small clusters of single-coloured blooms. The most common variety is white, but other light colours, such as yellow and peach, may also be found.
2. This flower, featuring bright red and orange hues, became the floral emblem of the province of Saskatchewan in 1956.
3. This member of the buttercup family is one of the first plants to bloom during Alberta’s spring.
4. This flower is famously known for following the sun – but mature plants primarily face east.
5. This plant, known for its unique heart-shaped bloom, has cultivars native to both North America and Eastern Asia.
6. This blue flower, a native perennial, is easy to remember from its distinctive yellow centre!

- Large Box (\$45): Approximately 35 to 40 lbs of produce

During an eclipse, the Earth, moon, and sun align to form a syzygy.



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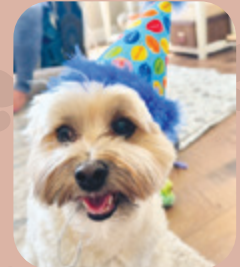

Airplane Noise? Your Community Association is on It!

Have you noticed a bit more rumble in the skies over Fairview lately? You aren't alone.

At a recent Ward 11 President's Meeting, community leaders from across the area raised concerns about increasing aircraft noise. Thanks to advocacy from our Ward 11 team, the Calgary Airport Authority provided an update to clarify what's going on in our skies.

What's Behind the Noise?

A Return to Normal: Following the completion of the West Runway rehabilitation in December 2025, airport operations returned to their standard configurations. What feels like "new" noise is actually flight patterns shifting back to pre-2023 conditions.

No New Flight Paths: Nav Canada, the body responsible for air traffic control, not the airport itself, confirms there have been no recent changes to Calgary's flight paths. Shifts in daily noise are typically driven by weather, safety protocols, and operational needs.

How to Make Your Voice Heard

The Calgary Airport Authority monitors noise levels and relies on community feedback to track potential issues. If a particular flight or time of day is causing a disruption, residents are strongly encouraged to log it.

You can submit a concern directly through the YYC Noise Management portal: yyc.com/en-us/noise-management/submit-a-concern.

Please note: To ensure your feedback is processed effectively, keep submissions constructive. The Airport Authority aims to respond to all legitimate inquiries, but aggressive or abusive language will not receive a response.

Summer Gardening Made Easy

The City of Calgary's YardSmart program offers tips to keep your yard thriving, rain or shine.

1. Make the most out of rainy days. Plants prefer rainwater over water from the hose. Collect water with a rain barrel and use it to water your yard. Point downspouts towards your lawn or garden, so they soak up every drop.
2. Mow less often. Keep your grass two to three inches high to shade the soil and leave clippings on your lawn.
3. Add mulch to garden beds. Mulch helps prevent water evaporation and reduces weeds. Use two to four inches of mulch on top of garden beds, leaving an inch around the base of plants.
4. Water plants at the roots – low and slow, allowing the soil to fully absorb the water. Hand watering with a watering can, using drip irrigation, or using soaker hoses are all effective ways to water plants at the roots. If you're watering with a sprinkler or irrigation system, remember to water on your scheduled days. Visit calgary.ca/whentowater for more information on Calgary's lawn and landscape watering schedule.

Accidental Poisoning

Emergency Health Services (EHS) paramedics would like to remind parents and caregivers of precautions they can take to help prevent accidental childhood poisonings around the home. Ingesting prescription or over-the-counter medication is a frequent cause of accidental childhood poisonings. Other causes include ingesting or contact with household items such as dishwasher/laundry tablets, mouthwash, chemicals such as paints/solvents, cleaning products, and button batteries.

Storage

- Place all medications in locked containers and store in an area inaccessible to children.
- For easy identification, store all medications in their original packaging; do not mix multiple medications in a single bottle.
- Install child locks on all cabinets, or drawers where medications and button batteries are kept.

Safety tips

- Child-resistant medication bottles are not necessarily child-proof. They can still be opened by a child.

- Take extra precautions with medicines designed to appeal to children such as chewable vitamins or flavoured cough and cold syrups.
- Promptly dispose of any medications or toxic household products no longer in use.

Prevention

- Store household products, cleaning supplies, and cosmetics in locked cabinets or drawers.
- Install child latches on cabinets children might also access by climbing on counters or chairs.
- Label all plants in and around your home and garden.
- Antifreeze, windshield washer fluid, and pesticides are extremely poisonous. Even a small amount can cause serious illness if ingested.

Find poisoning information by calling the Poison and Drug Information Service (PADIS) at 1-800-332-1414.

In Case of a Poisoning Emergency, Call 9-1-1

Provide the name of the product ingested and, if it is safe to do so, a sample of the substance for EHS paramedics to inspect on their arrival.

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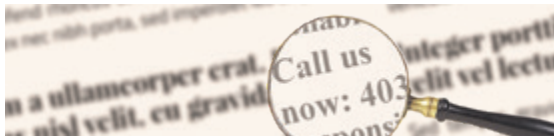
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Support Victoria Fortuna and Her Family After a Tragic Highway Accident
