- 3. This was the first tov ever advertised on television. featuring parts that could be stuck into a fruit or vegetable.
- 4. Max Park holds the record for solving this 3D combination puzzle toy at 3.13 seconds.
- 5. This stretchy, bouncy, moldable toy was used aboard Apollo 8 to help secure tools and equipment in zero gravity.
- 6. This toy was named after Theodore Roosevelt who famously refused to shoot a captured animal during a hunting trip in 1902.

4-H in the City: Fun and Learning for Calgary Kids

4-H isn't just for life on the farm anymore! In Calgary, 4-H Intro Clubs are offering city kids a chance to explore a wide range of exciting hands-on activities. These six-week programs give youth ages 9 to 15 the opportunity to learn about and try things like pottery, sourdough baking, food science, hydroponics, and even reptiles. It's a great way for kids to discover new interests, learn practical skills, and make friends along the way.



One of the most fun activities in the clubs is making smoothies. Each week, members experiment with different ingredients, learning about nutrition, measurement, and recipe creation. The first smoothie they'll make is an oatmeal cookie-flavoured

smoothie—healthy, delicious, and a great way to dive into cooking. It's a perfect mix of fun and learning, with a focus on balancing flavours and understanding the science behind food.

Here's one of our favourites you can try at home!

Oatmeal Cookie Smoothie

Single Serving

Ingredients:

- ¼ cup old-fashioned oats
- 1 cup unsweetened coconut or almond milk
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 tablespoon honey (to taste)
- ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- Pinch of nutmeg
- Pinch of salt
- 1 frozen banana (peeled)

Directions:

- 1. Add oats to the blender and pulse until finely ground.
- 2. Add milk, vanilla, honey, and spices.
- 3. Add the frozen banana.
- 4. Blend until smooth.

In addition to making smoothies, kids also get the chance to practice leadership, teamwork, and communication by running their own business meetings. These skills are key for personal growth and work well in any area of life.

What Is a Community Association?

A community association is a volunteer-run non-profit organization that represents the interests and concerns of a community.

What Does a Community Association Do?

Calgary's Community Associations:

- Provide an association for residents to join where they can work together to improve their community's quality of life.
- Create opportunities for residents to participate in social events, recreational programs, and educational activities in their communities.
- Develop and maintain facilities and infrastructure in their communities.
- Promote the protection of their communities' natural resources and beauty.
- Foster a sense of community and civic pride, and promote inclusiveness, diversity, and respect for all their residents.
- Partner with The City and other organizations to improve their community.
- Inform community residents with a website and newsletter.
- Voices community concerns on issues affecting their community.
- Provides an association that brings residents together to work collaboratively to create a strong, vibrant, and resilient community.

Responsibilities

Calgary's Community Associations are responsible to:

- Act in the best interests of its members and residents.
- Act with transparency, prudence, and accountability to their board, members, and residents.
- Build trust and confidence among its board, members, and residents to ensure long-term sustainability of their community and their community association.

Difference Between CA and HOA

The main differences between a Community Association (CA) and a Homeowners' Association (HOA) in Calgary are:

- Membership: CA membership is not mandatory, but HOAs have mandatory fees.
- Amenities: HOAs are responsible for amenities that are not under the City's purview, such as gated amenities. CAs manage community activities and programs, but do not operate a building.
- Funding: HOAs have a guaranteed source of revenue through fees, while CAs fundraise on public land.
- Collaboration: CAs and HOAs often work together to accomplish things for the community.

Here Are Some Other Things to Know About CAs and HOAs in Calgary:

Community Associations

CAs registered as a Not-for-Profit under the Societies Act connect with the City and other levels of government, and are a place to discuss concerns with others. CAs also organize events and programs for the community.

Homeowners' Associations

HOAs are organizations registered as a Not-for-Profit under the Companies Act that manage and maintain a community. HOAs are responsible for maintaining amenities installed by the developer, such as landscaping, shrub beds, snow removal, beach club, and lake facilities.

Federation of Calgary Communities

The Federation of Calgary Communities (FCC) provides support to Calgary's Community Associations.




