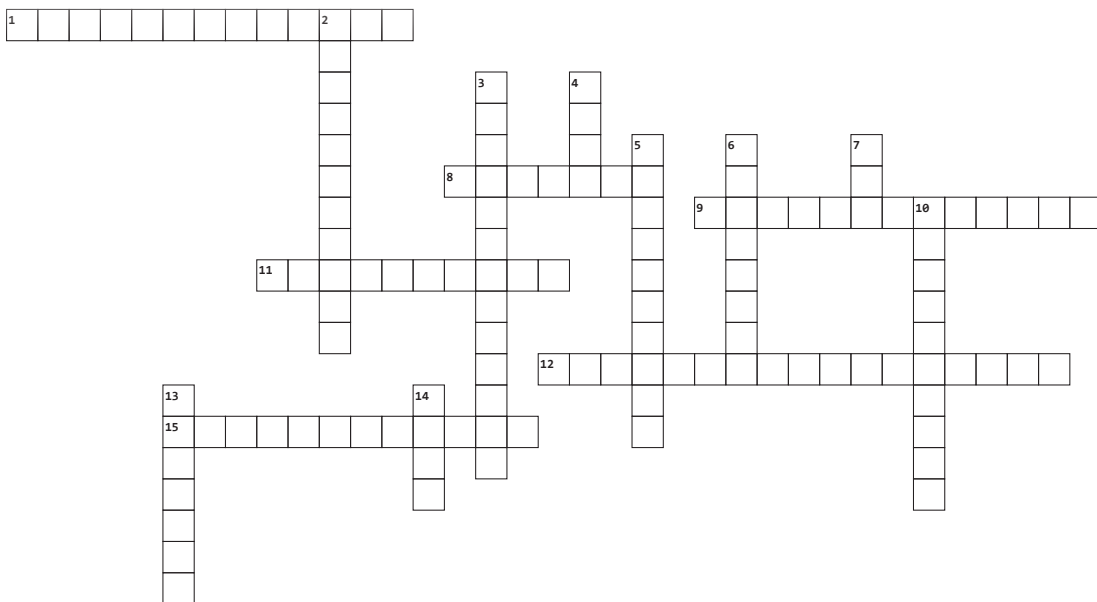


Midsummer Day
