We've all been there, throwing not so nice words towards the drivers who treat us badly in traffic. But let's take a moment and look in the mirror to make sure we don't do the same things we don't like about the other drivers. We are all on the same roads, and the more graciously we share them the better people we are at the end of the day. We've been talking about these things year after year because we think there are some simple things that can make our driving experience better. When more of us do our part, we will see a change. We are the change, not new bylaws or the police.

Merge Lines

When you are on the main highway, and you race a car that is trying to merge, where do you think the merging car can go when the merging line ends? We see rollovers at merging lines and if you take a closer look, you will notice the majority of accidents take place at the merging lines. Please adapt your speed and be courteous and mindful at the merging lines, let's all get home safe. Make sure your speed is different than the person trying to merge and let the merging car get safely into main traffic.

Use Your Signals

How do you tell the person next to you how you feel and what you want? By talking. How do you talk with people in traffic? By using your signals. If you think that "I saw in my mirrors there was no one behind" can justify not using your signals, think twice. Using the signals should be in the blood of every driver, even when you get out of your driveway you should, involuntarily, use the signal. How many times have people cut you off and stepped on your nerves? When you see a signal, you are aware and informed of the move that some other driver wants to make, and you can accommodate that move/ change. How many times has someone slammed on the brakes for no reason and then stopped with no signal, endangering everyone around? The law and common sense say you need to use signals before you hit your brakes (except in emergencies), and make sure to use your signals when changing directions or lanes. We do not like to be told what to do but please think about these two simple things that can get us all home safely.



Snow Removal

The New Brighton Residents Association Board of Directors has carefully reviewed the community's snow removal needs for the 2024/2025 winter season. Upon careful consideration, the NBRA Board of Directors has selected several high traffic areas which will be maintained by the NBRA maintenance team throughout the winter months. The NBRA will ensure snow removal, as well as sanding/gravel (within 24 hours of the end of

snowfall), of the following areas: all four New Brighton entrances and the regional pathways. To ensure maximum enjoyment for residents, snow removal will be completed on NBRA property before the designated areas within the community (NBRA property includes both the hockey and pleasure skating rinks, all entrances into the facility and shop, as well as the parking lot). Once these areas are complete, the NBRA team will proceed into the community. The map below indicates in detail these areas within the community that will be maintained by the NBRA for the 2024/2025 winter season.

To ensure the safety of both residents and employees, the NBRA has implemented an extensive safety program which adheres to the standards of the Alberta Safety Construction Association. The program consists of 13 components which contribute to the overall success of the program. In December 2018, the NBRA received COR certification through the ACSA for this program.

How to Be a Great Communicator

Just because we speak and understand the same language doesn't necessarily mean we are good communicators. One of the most common reasons couples seek my services is to learn better ways to communicate. The list below is for anyone who would like to hone their own skills.

Let's Start with Some Bad Habits in Communication:

- **1. Interrupting** This can make it seem like you don't care what the other person is saying. Yes, sometimes I get excited and blurt things out but it's important to acknowledge the other and be respectful to allow them to continue. This can also be an issue if you are neurodivergent, and the speaker doesn't know this.
- **2. Story-Topping** This can shift the conversation from connection to competition.
- **3. Bright-Siding** Always encouraging others to be positive or look on the bright-side can be invalidating. Toxic positivity is a thing, allow others to feel what they are feeling.
- **4. Being Right** The conversation becomes a debate or about being right. Try to listen to understand the other's point of view... you might learn something new.
- **5. Being All-Knowing** Explaining information without being asked for your expertise. This can sometimes make you look like a know-it-all.
- **6. Advising** Sometimes people just want empathy or just to be heard. They didn't ask for your advice. Do not offer it unsolicited. This can also be seen a boundary violation.

Here Are Some Habits of Good Communicators:

- **1. They create conversational safety** free from judgement, fault finding, or rejection. Just be there to listen.
- **2.** They validate other people's feelings with statements like; that makes sense, of course, or I get that. It doesn't mean you have to feel the same way, but you are showing that how they feel is valid.
- 3. They follow their natural curiosity by asking



questions that show interest and seeking to know more. Nothing feels better than someone showing interest in what you have to say or wanting to get to know you better.

- **4.** They listen with their whole body by being fully present while listening; not looking around or looking at their phone and are giving non-verbal cues that they are fully engaged such as eye contact and facing the speaker.
- **5. They hear what's beneath the words** by reading the speaker's body language, tone of voice, and facial expressions. This is an art form of attuning to another.

The 2025 Property Assessment notices are out. When you receive your notice, check the property details and review your property value. Your property assessment reflects the market value of your property on July 1, 2024, and the characteristics and physical condition of the property on December 31, 2024.

To help you review your property assessment we offer general resources on calgary.ca/assessment and property specific tools through the secure logon feature of Assessment Search at calgary.ca/assessmentsearch. By logging onto your property specific account on Assessment Search, you can:

- Check the property details used to determine the assessed value of your property.
- Update your residential property details. It's important you keep your information current, as incorrect property details may result in assessments that do not accurately reflect the value of your property.
- Compare your property's assessed value to other similar properties in your area to ensure fairness.
- Review real estate market trends and learn how your property was assessed.

New to Assessment Search? Visit calgary.ca/about-assessment-search to learn how to set up your account.

We offer a property tax calculator at calgary.ca/ assessment to help you estimate your 2025 Property Taxes and find out where your tax dollars go.

If you have questions about your 2025 property assessment, please contact us during the 2025 Customer Review Period which runs from January 2 to March 11, 2025. Your property is used to calculate your annual property tax bill, which is mailed in the spring.
