

Keeping Our Streets Clean and Safe



The winter is always unpredictable in Calgary, with the constant temperature change from positive to negative. These changes of temperature can make even just a little snow on a sidewalk melt and turn into a skating rink within a couple of hours, and icy sidewalks are a big hazard for people walking in our community—kids going to school, adults walking to bus stops, etc. Navigating these frozen paths is more than an inconvenience; it is dangerous and can cause serious injury. The importance of clear sidewalks cannot be emphasized enough.

So please, clean your sidewalks and keep them dry and ice-free. If you like to wake up early in the mornings to shovel your snow and live on a street with sidewalks, you can make someone's day by shovelling someone's sidewalk on your street.

Let's not forget the impact of driveways on our morning commute. Shovelling the road in front of our driveways, while ensuring we don't pile up the snow in the road (as of 2024 you can get a ticket for that) can significantly contribute to preventing ice dams and icy roads. This small effort will make it easier for everyone to drive safely. This is especially helpful on narrow streets; for example, it can make it easier to pull on the side of the road to let someone pass. And one other benefit is that you won't have water buildup constantly making new ice dams every time the temperatures go up.

Let's make and keep our streets and sidewalks cleaner and safer, thank you all.



Protect Your Household Water Lines and Meter from Freezing

Every winter, some Calgarians will experience frozen water pipes, service lines, and water meters, resulting in a water outage. The City's Frozen Pipes Prevention Program works proactively with homes considered at higher risk due to factors such as location, depth and configuration of water pipes, and a history of freezing.

Recently we have noticed an increase in frozen pipes in homes that are typically at a lower risk, where taking some of the steps below could have prevented household pipes from freezing. Ways to avoid freezing include:

- Keep your thermostat at a minimum of 15°C, even if you're away from home.
- Eliminate any cold drafts in unheated areas where water supply lines are located. This can include basements, crawl spaces, attics, garages, and under bathroom and kitchen cabinets.
- Repair broken windows, check doors, and insulate areas that allow cold exterior air to enter.
- Insulate your hot and cold-water pipes located in cold areas.
- Open interior doors and cabinets in cold areas to allow heat from the house to warm unprotected pipes.
- Turn off, disconnect, and drain the water line to outside faucets, garden hoses, pools, or decorative water features.
- If your hot water tank is in a maintenance room outside of your home, make sure the area is adequately heated.
- Regularly run water in your pipes through everyday use.

Tax Instalment Payment Plan (TIPP) is the most popular way to pay property tax in Calgary. Here's why:


- You pay the same amount as your tax bill, but in smaller, easier to manage monthly payments.
- Automatic monthly payments come out on the first day of each month, helping you avoid late payment penalties.
- No extra fees and no need to re-enroll each year. TIPP continues until you cancel.

It's easier than ever to join TIPP. Our online process streamlines registration and confirms your enrolment, allowing you to join fast and easily from the comfort of your home. All you need is your property's roll number and your banking details.

You can enroll anytime during the year, and we'll adjust your payments to ensure your tax bill is fully paid by year's end. If you join for January 1, your tax payments will be spread over 12 months, if you join for February 1, your payments will be spread over 11 months, and so on.

Your 2026 property tax bill will be mailed out in May. To avoid late payment penalties, you must join TIPP or pay the total amount of your 2026 property tax bill before the payment deadline of June 30, 2026.

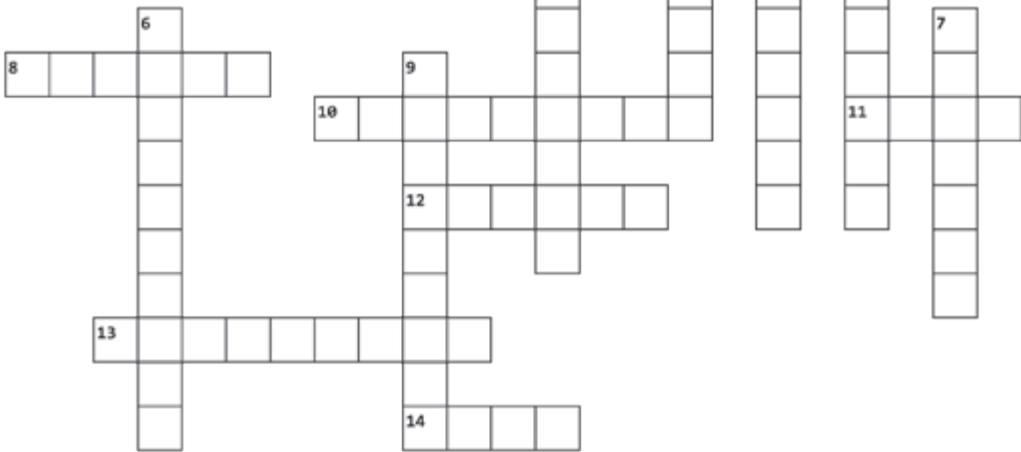

Snow Removal

The New Brighton Residents Association Board of Directors has carefully reviewed the community's snow removal needs for the 2025/2026 winter season. Upon careful consideration, the NBRA Board of Directors has selected several high traffic areas which will be maintained by the NBRA maintenance team throughout the winter months. The NBRA will ensure snow removal, as well as sanding/gravel (within 24 hours of the end of snowfall), of the following areas: all four New Brighton entrances and the regional pathways. To ensure maximum enjoyment for residents, snow removal will be completed on NBRA property before the designated areas within the community (NBRA property includes both the hockey and pleasure skating rinks, all entrances into the facility and shop, as well as the parking lot). Once these areas are complete, the NBRA team will proceed into the community. The map indicates in detail these areas with the community that will be maintained by the NBRA for the 2025/2026 winter season. All other days will remain open during regular hours from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm.


