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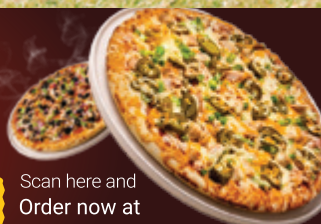
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Support Victoria Fortuna and Her Family After a Tragic Highway Accident

Tanghulu

Looking for a fun way to use your fruit? Try making tanghulu at home! This classic Chinese snack is easy to make and the perfect treat, check out the recipe below!

Ingredients

- Any fruit that can be pierced on a skewer.
- 1 cup of sugar
- 1/2 cup of water
- Wooden skewers

Directions

1. Wash and dry your fruit of choice, cut it into 1 to 2 inch pieces. For berries keep them whole.
2. With your wooden skewers, pierce the fruit, pushing each one down until your skewer is full, leaving enough room at the end for you to hold. Set aside.
3. Pour your sugar and water into a pot, making sure the pot is not too full.
4. Stir the water and sugar together until fully combined, then turn the heat on medium and cover with a lid.

Do not stir while the pot is heating! The water will prevent the sugar from burning, stirring only agitates the crystals making the mixture clumpy.

5. Once the sugar water begins to boil, you can remove the lid and let it cook.
6. You are waiting for the sugar to become golden in colour, do not stir with a spoon, but you can lift the pot above the heat and gently swirl the contents, so it cooks evenly.
7. Once you think the sugar is close to being done, prepare an ice bath in a large container that will fit your skewers.
8. When the sugar turns that golden shade, remove it from the heat immediately and begin carefully dipping your prepared skewers. The sugar will be very hot, so be careful not to burn yourself.
9. As soon as they have been dipped, place them into the ice bath so the sugar hardens, and you're done!
10. Enjoy your hard-earned treat with family and friends.

COOK'S CORNER

Orange Creamsicle Bars



Prep Time: 20 minutes

Cooking Time: 10 minutes

Total Time: 4 hours 30 minutes

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 cups graham cracker crumbs
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, melted
- 2 cups cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 tablespoon orange zest
- 1/2 cup fresh orange juice
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350°F (175°C).
2. In a medium bowl, combine graham cracker crumbs, granulated sugar, and melted butter. Mix until well combined.
3. Press the mixture firmly into the bottom of a 9 x 9-inch baking pan to form the crust.
4. Bake the crust for 8 to 10 minutes, then remove from oven and let cool completely.
5. In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese until smooth.
6. Add powdered sugar, vanilla extract, orange zest, and orange juice, beating until creamy and well combined.
7. In a separate bowl, whip the heavy cream until stiff peaks form.
8. Gently fold the whipped cream into the cream cheese mixture until fully incorporated.
9. Spread the filling evenly over the cooled crust.
10. Refrigerate for at least four hours, or until set.
11. Cut into bars and serve chilled.

Tips

Use fresh orange juice and zest for the brightest, most authentic creamsicle flavor.

Chill the bars overnight for a firmer texture and easier slicing.



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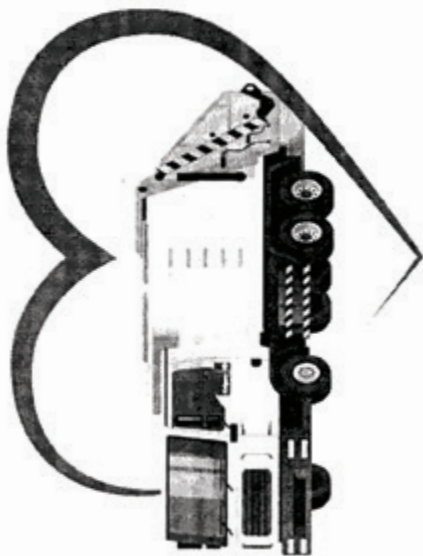

Diamond Cove Homeowners Bylaw Update

Over the past year, the Board has been working to update and modernize our community bylaws.

These proposed changes were presented at the April AGM, and with the support of the community, we anticipate the updated bylaws will be approved and adopted. The revised bylaws align with current legislation, clarify Board roles and responsibilities, and provide a strong foundation for the Association moving forward.

Enhanced Landscape Maintenance (ELM) Program

Maintaining the appearance of Diamond Cove remains a priority. The Board has been reviewing how our landscaping budget is allocated to ensure we are maximizing impact across seasonal planters, flower beds, and general maintenance.

We have also participated in city-led discussions regarding updates to the Enhanced Landscape Maintenance (ELM) Program. These changes are intended to improve how communities manage and enhance shared spaces, and we will continue to keep residents informed as more details become available.

Diamond Cove Attenuation Wall

The Board continues to work with the City of Calgary and other partners to clarify responsibilities related to the attenuation wall along Bow Bottom Trail.

As part of this process, a sound assessment is expected in 2026 or 2027. This work will help better understand current noise levels and inform any future considerations.

Urban Forestry and Tree Planting

We are also working with the City's Urban Forestry team to explore additional tree planting opportunities within Diamond Cove, including the playground, soccer field, and dog park.

Enhancing our tree canopy supports both the beauty and environmental health of our community. Updates will be shared as plans progress.

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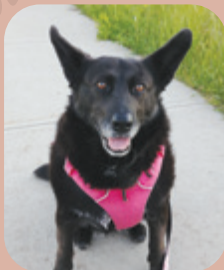

This summer, the Listen Garden is taking shape.

Located in the heart of Fish Creek Provincial Park, the Listen Garden is a collaboration between the past and the future; the land and the people; Indigenous and newcomer communities. Our team of staff and dedicated volunteers have been hard at work prepping the site, from harvesting and processing native plant seeds to spraying the site to remove invasive species and distributing an impressive seven truckloads of sand. 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It is hard to believe we are halfway through summer. July was a very busy month with the many community events and Stampede events that I was able to attend. I want to thank everyone who attended my constituency Stampede BBQ. It was so nice to see so many new and familiar faces; it was a great day filled with community fun!

Despite the afternoon downpour, Canada Day was fantastic, and I was lucky enough to celebrate it with the residents of Parkland and Lake Bonavista at each of their events. I also really enjoyed the Deer Run Pre-Stampede Breakfast! It was a fantastic event where I was lucky enough to talk with many constituents while I served pancakes.

I want to share some important information with everyone. The Canadian Bankers Association has launched a new Financial Abuse Prevention Hub to help protect older Canadians, including Albertans, from financial harm and strengthen their financial security. This centralized resource offers practical tools and guidance to help seniors recognize the signs of financial abuse, understand what it looks like, and know where to seek help. It also includes a Fraud Prevention Toolkit and access to Your Money Seniors, a free seminar program delivered by volunteer bankers in communities across Canada, which local seniors' groups can request online or by phone. The need for these resources is significant: nearly one in three Canadians knows someone who has experienced financial abuse, yet only about a quarter of incidents are reported.

The Hub includes practical tools such as guidance on identifying financial abuse and where to get help, a Fraud Prevention Toolkit, and access to the Your Money Seniors seminar program delivered by volunteer bankers across the country.

I hope everyone is able to enjoy the last month of summer vacation with family and friends before the business of the new school year starts in September.

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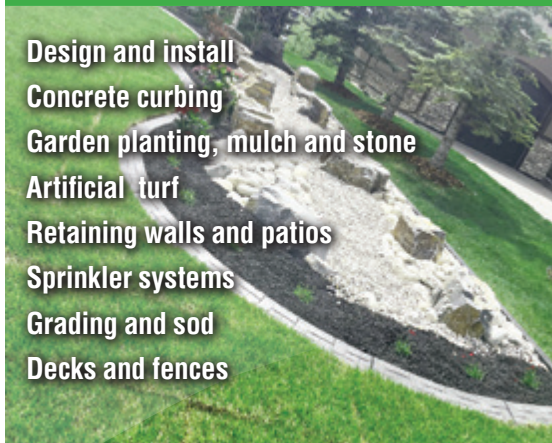


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
