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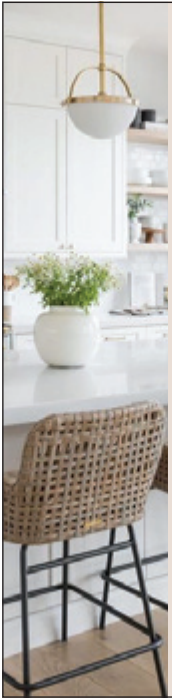
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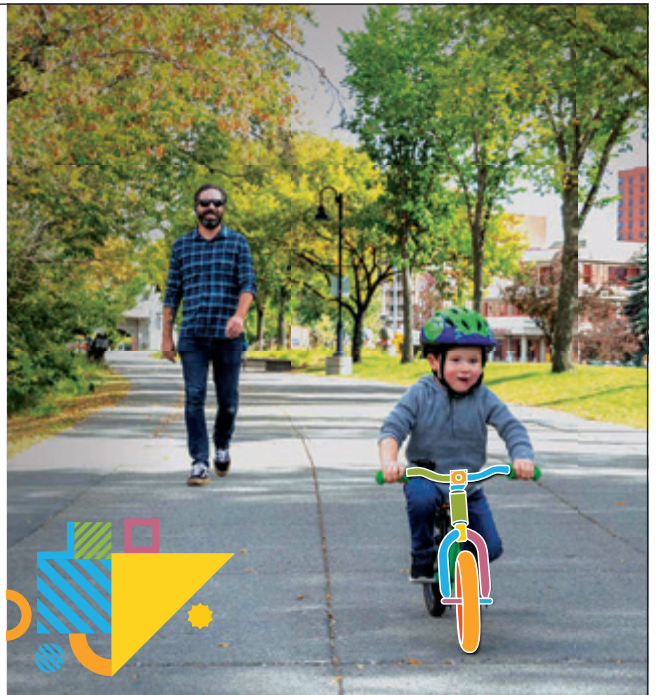

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Easy Raspberry Muffins



Ingredients

- 2 ½ cup all purpose flour, I use unbleached
- 1 ¼ cup brown sugar, packed
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 egg
- 1 cup milk, I use almond milk
- 2/3 cup oil
- 2 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 ½ cup raspberries, washed

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 375°F and grease muffin tin with cooking spray or use cupcake liners.
2. Mix flour, brown sugar, salt, baking soda and cinnamon in a large mixing bowl.
3. Mix in egg, milk, oil, and vanilla. Stir just until moistened. Don't over stir.
4. Fold in raspberries.
5. In a greased or lined muffin tin, add batter to cups about ¾ full.
6. Bake in a preheated, 375°F oven for 15 to 17 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the centre comes out clean.

Diamond Cove Homeowners Bylaw Update

Over the past year, the Board has been working to update and modernize our community bylaws.

These proposed changes were presented at the April AGM, and with the support of the community, we anticipate the updated bylaws will be approved and adopted. The revised bylaws align with current legislation, clarify Board roles and responsibilities, and provide a strong foundation for the Association moving forward.

Enhanced Landscape Maintenance (ELM) Program

Maintaining the appearance of Diamond Cove remains a priority. The Board has been reviewing how our landscaping budget is allocated to ensure we are maximizing impact across seasonal planters, flower beds, and general maintenance.

We have also participated in city-led discussions regarding updates to the Enhanced Landscape Maintenance (ELM) Program. These changes are intended to improve how communities manage and enhance shared spaces, and we will continue to keep residents informed as more details become available.

Diamond Cove Attenuation Wall

The Board continues to work with the City of Calgary and other partners to clarify responsibilities related to the attenuation wall along Bow Bottom Trail.

As part of this process, a sound assessment is expected in 2026 or 2027. This work will help better understand current noise levels and inform any future considerations.

Urban Forestry and Tree Planting

We are also working with the City's Urban Forestry team to explore additional tree planting opportunities within Diamond Cove, including the playground, soccer field, and dog park.

Enhancing our tree canopy supports both the beauty and environmental health of our community. Updates will be shared as plans progress.

More details will be shared on our Facebook page in the coming months, but now is the perfect time to start setting items aside.

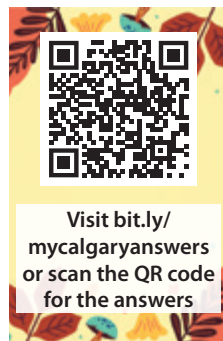
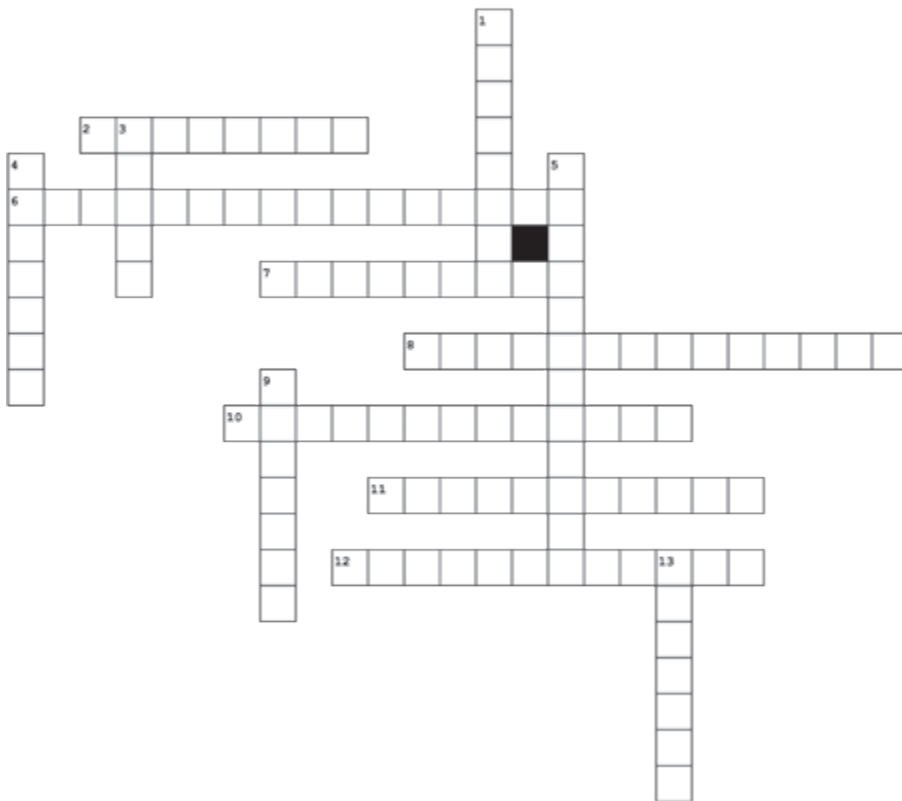

Making Your Calgary Garden More Drought Tolerant

In partnership with the City of Calgary, we're expanding our Grow with Us program to include native plant plug giveaways starting this September. Thank you to the City and to our partner, the Alberta Native Plant Rescue Foundation (ANPRF), who this wouldn't be possible without. Read on to find out more about native plants, the ANPRF, and how you can sign up to get free native plant plugs.

Why Native Plants?

Native plants are not only beautiful and great for native pollinators and all our other native wildlife—they're also highly drought tolerant. Since Alberta often has long stretches without much precipitation, and these plants evolved alongside its dry climate, they have ways of making it through long dry periods that other, non-native species don't have. A great example is long roots that can tap into water reserves deep below the ground's surface.

This means that once native plants are established, whether in their native grasslands or in your garden, they're extremely resilient. Perennial native plants can not only weather our hot and dry summer conditions; they make it through our winters to pop back up in spring to show off beautiful foliage and flowers each year. I'm sure many of the gardeners reading this have

lost a perennial or two (or more, with some of the particularly frosty winters we've had here) to the cold Southern Alberta climate. While native species aren't totally immune to the effects of the cold, their deep roots are often safe from the deep freeze, and you'll see them coming back strong in spring after some of our colder winters.

Looking For Free Native Plant Plugs?

Sign up for our Grow with Us mailing list at www.friendsoffishcreek.org/gwu. We'll email you letting you know when we're running giveaways and provide a registration link for each giveaway.

When you register for a giveaway, we'll ask you to complete a short survey about your experience with native plant gardening and why you're interested in getting free native plants. We'll be in touch later in the year with a follow-up survey.

Show up, grab your plugs, and get them into your garden! Once you've claimed your plugs, you'll need to wait until our next round of giveaways in 2027 to participate again. If you're interested in sourcing more plugs or mature plants than what were giving away, you can follow our partner, the Alberta Native Plant Rescue Foundation and sign up for their email list to go out to a plant rescue!
