Please slow down, drive safely, and watch out for each other!

#### **Traffic**

#### Don't be a Phantom Car, Turn on Your Lights!

There is less daylight now and so you will need your lights more often. Do not rely on your daytime running lights as these do not turn on your rear lights, and rear lights will allow others behind you to see you clearly. A reminder to also make sure you have outfitted your car for winter with a snowbrush, emergency kit, and have put on your winter tires.

#### Traffic Around Schools and in Playground Zones-Slow Down!

Playground zones run 7:30 am to 9:00 pm, seven days a week. Since it gets darker now, the kids are harder to see, but trust me they are there! In a rush to pick up your own kid watch out for your neighbour's kids. Playground zones are also utilized by the school buses prior to 7:30 am for pick-up and after 3:00 pm for dropoff. Slow down here as there is a good chance a school bus is using the area.

#### **Parking**

If you have on-street parking in front of your house, please know that it is not specific to your address nor belongs to you. We all share the on-street parking. If you must park in front of a neighbour's house for a prolonged period of time, please take a moment to talk to them. Let them know why and for how long. This is especially needed if you have guests or have multiple vehicles for your household and no garage.

Once again, if you witness any traffic issues on an ongoing basis, please take the time to both report it to me at traffic@myceca.ca and via the Traffic Service Request directly to the police. This can be done at http://www.calgary.ca/cps/Pages/Traffic/Traffic-Service-Requests.aspx.

#### **Lock Your Doors!**

The stats for Residential Break and Enter and Theft from Vehicle are the highest reported categories for Evergreen.

Please remember to lock your doors and keep valuables out of sight. Especially the garage door opener. If a thief can get a hold of this, they will have access to your garage and potentially your house if you do not have your man door locked. Follow the 9:00 pm routine!

### **Cold Weather Safety**

Emergency Medical Services (AHS EMS) responds to many cold weather emergencies each winter. You can reduce your risk of sustaining a cold weather emergency by taking a few precautions. Dress by wearing warm, insulating layers close to the body covered with wind and waterproof layers on the exterior- and don't forget a toque! Carry an emergency roadside kit in your vehicle containing extra clothing, blankets, and emergency supplies and ensure your cell phone is fully charged.

#### Hypothermia

- Hypothermia is abnormally low body temperature, less than 34°C (as compared to normal body temperature of about 37°C).
- Early hypothermia may manifest as profound shivering; moderate hypothermic patients may act inappropriately: stumbling, mumbling, and fumbling, as their body temperature continues to drop resulting in severe hypothermia (<30°C).
- Left untreated, severe hypothermia may progress to unconsciousness or death.
- Early recognition and prompt medical attention is key. Don't forget to protect yourself from the factors that originally lead to the patient's situation.
- Initiate gentle re-warming as quickly as possible.
   Remove any wet or constrictive clothing; cover with blankets or sleeping bags. Protect from further heat loss: eliminate contact with cold surfaces, and shield from wind and moisture.

#### **Frostnip**


- Frost-nipped skin is extremely cold, but not yet frozen.
- It commonly affects the ears, nose, cheeks, fingers, and toes.
- The skin may look red and possibly feel numb to the touch.
- When treated promptly, frostnip usually heals without complication.
- Move to a warm environment and immediately, but gently, re-warm the affected area through skin-to-skin contact (i.e., hand covering tips of ears).



#### **Frostbite**

- Frostbite occurs when skin becomes so cold, the skin and underlying tissues freeze.
- Affected skin may look white and waxy and will feel hard to the touch.
- Move to a warm environment immediately and place the affected area in warm, not hot, water, until fully re-warmed.
- · Seek further medical attention as required.


