We at CECA are busy this summer. We had our ever-successful Community Cleanup, which was held in late June. The event was run by a great group of CECA board members and Evergreen resident volunteers. On behalf of myself and CECA's board of directors. I would like to thank everyone for making this year's Community Cleanup another success. I would also like to thank the office of MLA Eric Bouchard and Councillor Dan Mclean for their support of the association and their participation. We have also finished, with great success, the Parade of Garage Sales where we had more than 40 participants. At the time this newsletter issue is published, we should also have our Home Alone and Babysitting event done. This program is targeted at children over nine years of age and youths. We are each other's eyes! As many of your neighbours may be on holidays, keep an eye on their property. See something suspicious? Call the non-emergency number (403-266-1234) to report it. If you have a porch cam and you record something suspicious. Please forward it to the police as they may be able to use it in an investigation.

Keep Your Doors Locked and Your Garages Closed! Follow the 9pm Routine.

Seems like common sense, doesn't it? But you would be surprised how many doors are left unlocked and garages open. Don't give thieves easy pickings! This goes for bikes and kids' toys left in the yard.

There have been many social media posts about people checking cars. This usually is the highest reported crime. People have left their car door unlocked and thieves will wander the street looking for open vehicles, then swipe the valuables. The CPS promotes the 9pm lock down quite a bit. At 9pm lock everything down before you go to bed. A good habit to get into.







SECA REPORT

SECA Walks and Talks: Let's Dream About the Future of Shawnee Evergreen Together

The parks and public spaces in our neighbourhoods are wonderful - but we know that over time they may need to grow and change. This summer we have been exploring new ways to engage our diverse community and learn more about what they value. We believe that everyone has something to contribute - ideas, dreams, or unique perspectives that we can all benefit from.

The SECA Walks and Talks program is simple. First, we invite and support someone from the community to lead a short, themed walking tour in the neighbourhood. Second, we end the walk with a creative thinking session where we collect the ideas and observations that folks had on the walk about how to improve the community. Finally - we will be creating a living library of these ideas that in the future we can bring to life through popup programs, new equipment or installations, and in collaboration with the city and parks teams.

The first Walks and Talks have been a great success. We are sorting through all the contributions and can't wait to share what's been created. Some of the early themes that participants have highlighted include:

- How we provide a safer, welcoming, and inclusive environment through more accessible designs, spaces for all ages, and more visible crosswalks.
- How we can think about creating spaces that encourage community engagement and connection, continue supporting sports and outdoor activities, and more community events.
- How we cultivate a sense of community identity through public art, murals, unique local signage, and green spaces.
- How we provide more places to gather in every season
 places to connect, enjoy music, picnics, art, sports, and play.

The best part about the Walks and Talks program is that it's by neighbours, for neighbours. It also provides a unique opportunity to learn from each other and maybe see parts of Shawnee Evergreen in a new way or with fresh eyes.

Do you have a passion for finding amazing trees or beautiful gardens? Or know where all the best birdwatching spots are hiding? Or maybe you have some interesting historical facts or design criticism you want to share? Come join us on a walk either as a participant or a host! We would love to build a roster of potential hosts to lead a walk. Walk hosts will be supported to plan and lead their walk by the program team and will receive an honorarium.


