

Traffic

Traffic Survey

It is time to conduct another survey for the community to make sure that we are addressing all of the traffic concerns we have in the community. This will help towards making the community safer for everyone.

The survey is eighteen questions long but should only take ten to fifteen minutes to complete. Your participation is appreciated, and there will be a draw for a CECA membership for all those that enter. Current members will be extended by one year. Shortcutting Traffic

Evergreen continues to be a shortcutting area of drivers travelling from other areas along Fish Creek Blvd to get to the ring road. Please be wary of this when getting around the Fish Creek Blvd area.

Alleyways

Got an alleyway in need of gravel or are there too many ruts? This past winter may have caused some deep ruts in places and spring rains will cause some damage on gravel alleyways. For bad spots please contact 3-1-1. Lane repair is done between June and October. 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


