Traffic

Traffic Around Schools

There is still a lot of concern with the way people are driving around the schools. Slow down, make sure your kids cross safely, do not stop on Fish Creek Blvd, no U-turns, etc. If you are unsure where the proper hug and go area is, please contact your school.

Traffic Survey

A traffic survey will be completed this year. This will provide feedback of the traffic use in Evergreen from residents. This will be used for data gathering and planning potential traffic changes in Evergreen, and eventually a traffic forum. The traffic study will focus on traffic around the schools, and the main routes through the community!

Traffic Feedback

Traffic safety concerns all of us and CECA is working to be part of the solution by consulting with decision makers and experts. Our first priorities are the areas near schools and the main routes through the community. Watch for upcoming invitations to participate in this process, such as surveys, and/or forums.

Slowdown in Playground Zones!

At this time of year is when daylight starts lasting a little bit longer. I ask everyone to be safe when driving in the playground zones and watch out for one another. Please be safe around the school buses, watch for kids, no U-turns and be mindful of the people living nearby. They are your neighbours, be courteous. Playground zones are in effect till 9:00 pm.

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

City-Wide Rezoning

The City's in-person, online, and email engagement for the proposed rezoning has closed. The majority (60%) of neighbourhoods are currently zoned for single family homes. The new strategy will rezone established neighbourhoods to RC-G which allows single-detached, semi-detached, duplexes, secondary suites, and row housing. 

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
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
