Enhancing Mobility in Marda Loop: Construction Updates and Optimizations

Dear Marda Loop Community,

As we embark on the Marda Loop Main Streets project, a significant investment in our community, we are excited to share updates and enhancements aimed at improving mobility and safety. This project, representing Calgary's largest Main Street endeavour to date, encompasses a range of improvements designed to enhance the cultural, social, and economic vibrancy of our beloved neighbourhood.

What Are We Building?

Our efforts entail a comprehensive reconstruction of roadways, accompanied by the installation of new street furnishings to brand Marda Loop as a premier destination. This includes the addition of streetlights, benches, bike racks, waste bins, and the refurbishment of historic signs, all contributing to the unique character of our community.

Safety and traffic flow improvements at eleven intersections are a key focus. Through the installation of curb extensions or bump outs, we aim to shorten crossing distances for pedestrians while enhancing visibility for both pedestrians and drivers, ultimately creating a safer environment for all.

Plaza and gathering spaces will be created, alongside new landscaping tailored to thrive specifically in Marda Loop, based on a detailed climate analysis. Additionally, utilities will be upgraded to manage future growth, in collaboration with Enmax, ATCO, and other stakeholders, ensuring a sustainable infrastructure for years to come.

Addressing Community Concerns

We understand the community's concerns regarding traffic patterns during construction. Rest assured, once construction is complete, 33 and 34 Avenues S.W. will revert to two-way traffic. Temporary one-way detours have been implemented to facilitate ongoing work while maintaining traffic flow and on-street parking.

Regarding cycling infrastructure, a multi-use path (MUP) will be installed along the south side of 34 Avenue, providing a safe facility for cyclists and pedestrians alike, while preserving on-street parking, a high priority for the community.

Parking will be available on both sides of 33 and 34 Avenues S.W. after construction, ensuring accessibility to local businesses and promoting a vibrant pedestrian experience.

Construction Timeline and Information

Construction is anticipated to span two years, with completion scheduled for the end of 2024, followed by landscaping and final touch-ups in 2025. Regular updates will be provided through our website (www. calgary.ca/mardaloop) and newsletter subscriptions.

having three documents: a current and legal will, a personal directive and a living will. Amanda spoke to the appointment of single and multiple executors, the complications of family dynamics in the probate process with legal counsel. Ms Bruni emphasized that gifts to family, loans, annuities, or bequests be clearly outlined in the will. She brought up the possibility of trusts for minors or family members with disabilities and answered questions, leaving us her card and a handout on various Legal Education websites including www. cplea.ca (The Centre for Public Legal Education Alberta).

Thank you to Patricia Paterson, one of the attendees for the above report on our March gathering. Patricia adds "Amanda Bruni was friendly, informative and on point. Wills and related powers of attorney and health directives are obviously her legal specialty."




