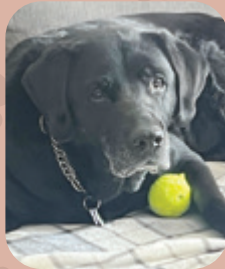

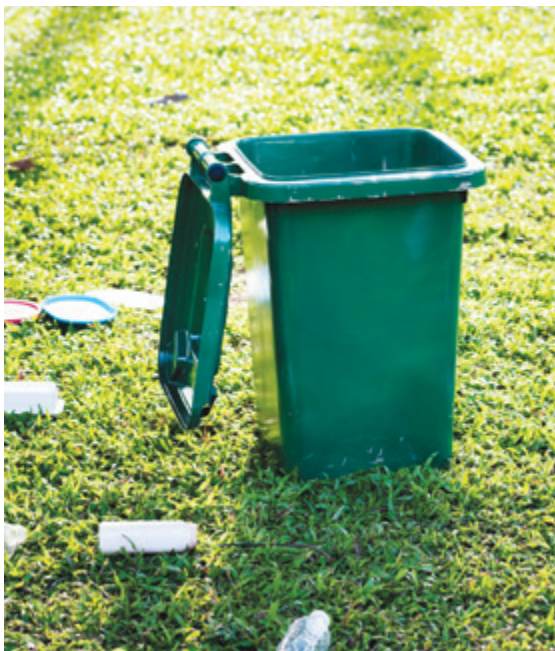

Green Bins Are for Food Scraps and Yard Waste

by The City of Calgary, Waste and Recycling Services



Food scraps belong in the green cart, but packaging does not. Plastic does not compost and can break into small pieces during processing, which can contaminate the finished compost. All food scraps must be separated from packaging before composting, even if the packaging says it is biodegradable or compostable.

A few simple habits can make a big difference:

- Remove all plastic before putting food scraps in the green bin.
- Empty and clean plastic, glass, and metal containers go in the blue cart.
- Plastic wraps, foam, and other non-compostable packaging belong in the black cart.

Putting food scraps in the green cart and packaging in the right bin helps keep compost clean. If you are not sure where an item goes, visit <https://www.calgary.ca/waste/what-goes-where/default.html>.

Temple B’Nai Tikvah Visit

As a start to our plan to improve our knowledge of world religions, we were invited to visit the B’nai Tikvah synagogue where Rabbi Mark Glickman leads a Jewish Reform congregation. On entry to the Casino, we got our first taste of chance. Each put their name into the draw bucket. We got off to a great start – Anna won the first draw and Liz won another. They generously donated a part of their winnings back to the Marda Loop Community Association. Draws were held at specified hours for amounts determined by a plinka board draw. If you didn’t win, there was always the next time!

It was noon so we were anxious to try the buffet for which casinos are famous. And the one at Grey Eagles didn’t disappoint. Main courses included both hot and cold plates of Western and Asian dishes along with numerous salads. Desserts were just as plentiful and varied from fruits to sweets, it was difficult to make choices! Coffee and tea were served at your table.

While dining, our host, Colleen Waskewitch Runner, Guest Services Manager, filled us in on the Tsuu’tina – a First Nation on Treaty 7 territory. She told us about

the immense piece of land belonging to them, which is slowly being developed into commercial entities, some of which are in operation today.

After lunch, it was time to try our luck at the slot machines. Everyone got a \$20 voucher to start. Some seemed luckier than others – was it the machine? If you kept the bidding low, the \$20 lasted longer – but you’d never get rich that way. Anna, Stacy, and Terry were the luckiest and sharpest in our group on the slots.

Sensory overload? Yes, but the brain needs some of that too! With Grey Eagle bags of donated merchandise, their Eagle Mobile escorted us back to Marda Loop. Not all of us returned with more change in our pockets, but we felt richer through this experience. Thanks to Heather Bhatti the Seniors Director who organized this event for the Seniors in the Loop.
