Construction is expected to begin in the coming days, starting with water utility upgrades between 14 Street SW and 18 Street SW. To reduce impacts, the project has been divided into east and west segments on either side of Crowchild Trail, each with its own construction phases. Phase 1 of the west segment (25 St SW to 26 St SW) begins this month, while Phase 1 of the east segment (14 St SW to 16 St SW) will begin once utility work is complete.

special. Events like this remind us of the incredible businesses we have right here in our own community and the important role they play in making Marda Loop such a great place to live, work, and connect.

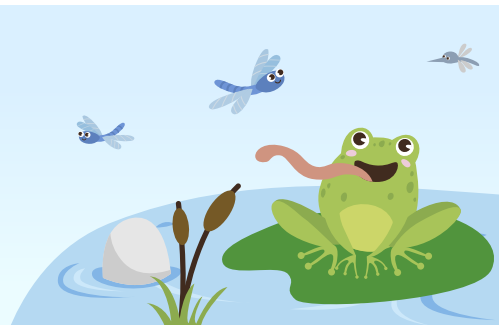
