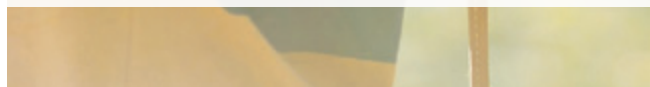

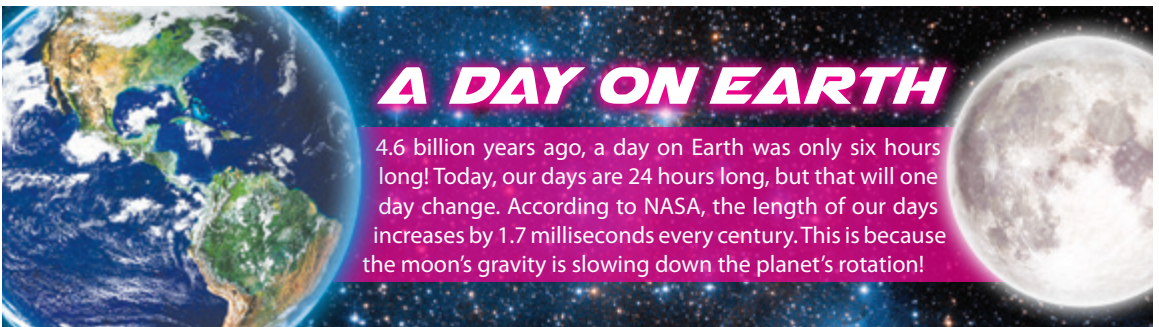
Shawnee-Evergreen Community Association Area Boundaries

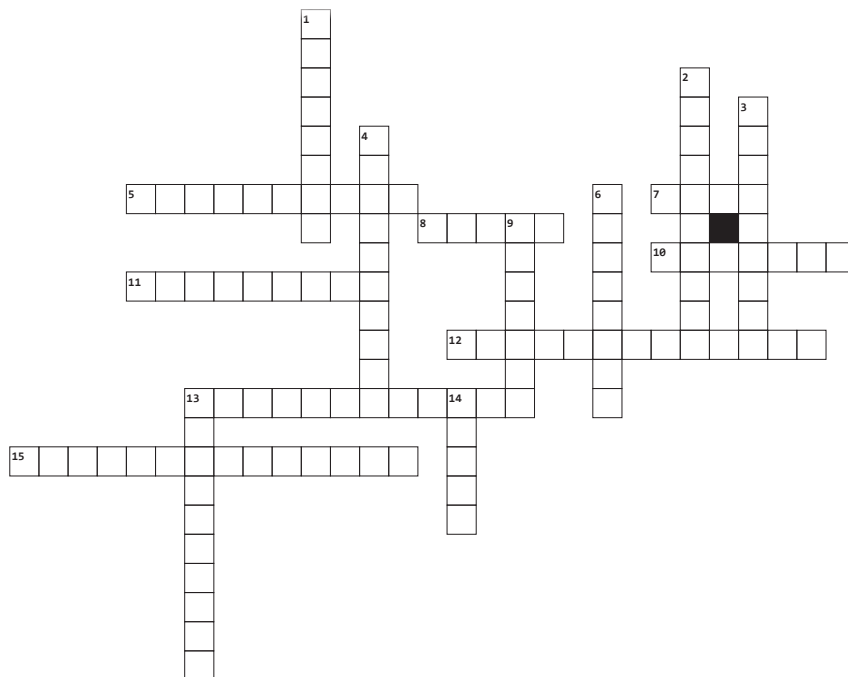

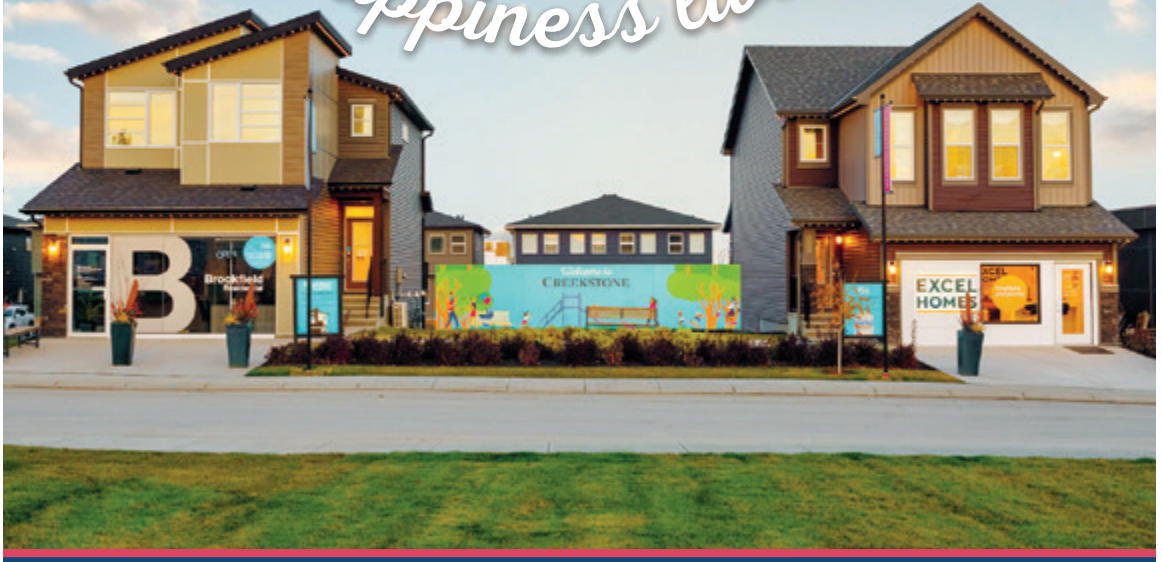
