Walks and Talks: Let's Dream About the Future of Shawnee Evergreen Together

The parks and public spaces in our neighbourhoods are wonderful - but we know that over time they may need to grow and change. This summer we have been exploring new ways to engage our diverse community and learn more about what they value. We believe that everyone has something to contribute - ideas, dreams, or unique perspectives that we can all benefit from.

The SECA Walks and Talks program is simple. First, we invite and support someone from the community to lead a short, themed walking tour in the neighbourhood. Second, we end the walk with a creative thinking session where we collect the ideas and observations that folks had on the walk about how to improve the community. Finally - we will be creating a living library of these ideas that in the future we can bring to life through popup programs, new equipment or installations, and in collaboration with the city and parks teams.

The first Walks and Talks have been a great success. We are sorting through all the contributions and can't wait to share what's been created. Some of the early themes that participants have highlighted include:

- How we provide a safer, welcoming, and inclusive environment through more accessible designs, spaces for all ages, and more visible crosswalks.
- How we can think about creating spaces that encourage community engagement and connection, continue supporting sports and outdoor activities, and more community events.
- How we cultivate a sense of community identity through public art, murals, unique local signage, and green spaces.
- How we provide more places to gather in every season
 places to connect, enjoy music, picnics, art, sports, and play.

The best part about the Walks and Talks program is that it's by neighbours, for neighbours. It also provides a unique opportunity to learn from each other and maybe see parts of Shawnee Evergreen in a new way or with fresh eyes.

Do you have a passion for finding amazing trees or beautiful gardens? Or know where all the best birdwatching spots are hiding? Or maybe you have some interesting historical facts or design criticism you want to share? Come join us on a walk either as a participant or a host! We would love to build a roster of potential hosts to lead a walk. Walk hosts will be supported to plan and lead their walk by the program team and will receive an honorarium.

The 55+ programs and presentations are returning in September. These are designed to support healthy ageing and reduce social isolation by providing opportunities for seniors to be connected and active members of our community.





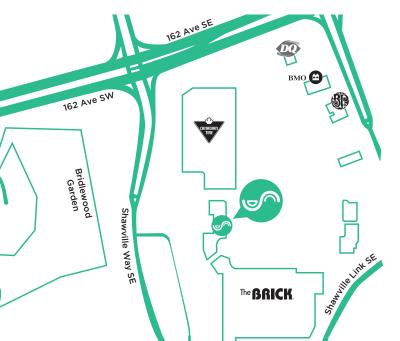

Hydration and You

Water keeps every part of your body working properly. It helps your body flush waste and stay at the right temperature. It can help prevent kidney stones and constipation.

You lose water throughout the day through your breath, sweat, urine, and bowel movements. If you live somewhere hot, you could lose even more fluid.

It is important to replace this lost fluid to stay healthy. If you don't get enough water, you could become dehydrated. If you get very dehydrated, your body no longer has enough fluid to get blood to your organs which can be very dangerous.

What is the Right Amount of Water to Drink Each Day?

All liquids help you stay hydrated, but water is usually the best choice. A common recommendation is to drink six to eight glasses of water per day (250 ml or 8 fl oz). Some adults may need more depending on your overall health, how much you exercise, and how hot or dry the climate is.

Most people get enough fluid through the beverages they normally drink each day. You also get water through food. Some fruits and vegetables contain a lot of water, such as watermelon and lettuce.

Did you know? Experts say it is not true that beverages containing caffeine – coffee, tea, and cola drinks – are

dehydrating. Healthy individuals who consume moderate amounts of caffeine do not lose more fluid than people who don't have any caffeine. A moderate amount of caffeine is about 200 to 300 mg per day which is about two to four cups (250 ml or 8 fl oz) of coffee.

If you are feeling well, you urinate every few hours during the day, and are not feeling thirsty often, you are likely drinking enough water.

People with certain health problems, especially heart and kidney problems, need to speak with a doctor about how much water to drink.

Ways to Consume More Water During the Day

If you struggle with consuming water or remembering to drink enough throughout your day, these suggestions may help:

- Drink a glass of water when you get up in the morning, before drinking coffee or tea.
- Keep a cup or water bottle by your desk at work. Take several sips of water each hour. If you don't have a desk job, carry a container of water with you and take sips throughout the day.
- Take a sip whenever you pass a drinking fountain.
- Mix it up! Add sugarless flavouring to your water or a slice of lemon/lime. Alternate with sparkling water.

SAFE AND SOUND

Accidental Poisoning

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) would like to remind parents and caregivers of precautions to prevent accidental childhood poisonings around the home. Ingesting prescription or over the counter (OTC) medications is a significant cause of accidental childhood poisonings. Other causes of poisoning include ingesting or coming into contact with household items such as dishwasher tablets, mouthwash, or chemicals such as paints, solvents and cleaning products.

Medication Storage

- Place all medications in locked containers and store in an area inaccessible to children.
- For easy identification, store all medications in their original packaging; do not mix multiple medications in a single bottle.
- Install child locks on all cabinets, or drawers where medications are stored.

Safety Tips

- Child-resistant medication bottles are not child proof. They can still be opened by a child.
- Take extra precaution with medicines designed to appeal to children such as chewable vitamins or flavored cough and cold syrups.
- Promptly dispose of any medications or toxic household products no longer in use.

Prevention

- Store household products, cleaning supplies, and cosmetics in locked cabinets or drawers.
- Install child latches on cabinets children might also access by climbing on counters or chairs.
- Label all plants in and around your home and garden.
- Antifreeze, windshield washer fluid, and pesticides are extremely poisonous. Even small amounts of these can cause serious illness if ingested.

Poisoning information can be obtained by calling the Poison and Drug Information Service (PADIS) at: 1-800-332-1414.

In case of a poisoning emergency, call 9-1-1. Provide the name of the product ingested and, if it is safe to do so, a sample of the substance for EMS to inspect on their arrival.
