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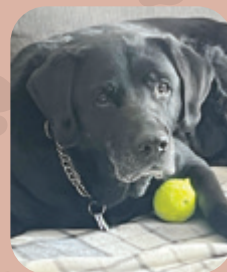
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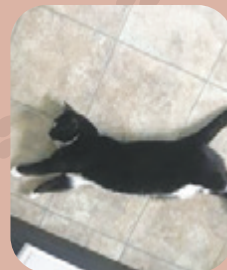

55+ Happy and Healthy Programs Return September 3

After a summer break, our 55+ Happy and Healthy Programs return every Thursday from 9:15 to 11:15 am at Peace Lutheran Church.



The fall lineup includes:

- The Game's Afoot! – Team rummy, bingo, word games, and more.
- Great Gains Exercise Classes – Seven weeks of chair-supported strength, mobility, and balance training led by Tanya.
- September Talk: First Aid and CPR for Seniors – Learn the basics from a certified first aider.

Placekeeping: It's Ours to Care For

Over several years, we've talked about placemaking—reimagining everyday spaces and seeing new potential in our parks and gathering places. Just as important is placekeeping—the ongoing care and stewardship of those spaces by the people who use them. Placekeeping is a simple shift from the to our—not the libraries, but our libraries.

Last summer, we experienced some challenge—intentional damage to community chairs, graffiti on fences, and on our Little Free Libraries. While this is discouraging, it also highlights how much these shared spaces matter, and how important it is that we care for them together.

Placekeeping shows up in small, everyday actions:

- Treating shared items with respect.
- Picking up litter, leaving spaces clean and welcoming.
- Reporting or helping address damage.
- Pitching in when something needs attention.

It's neighbours looking out for neighbours and taking pride in the spaces we all share. When we actively care for our community, we build more than amenities—we build connection, belonging, and resilience. We invite residents to become placekeepers and to encourage family members and neighbours to do the same.

Community Garden and Gathering Space Project

This multi-phase project in the Evergreen Dr SW park will combine community gardens with an outdoor gathering space for events, education, and connection. The pace and scope of this project will be determined by the number of volunteers involved and the skills they bring. To help us plan the next phases of this project, we're creating a skills and interests register of residents willing to contribute as the project evolves. If you're

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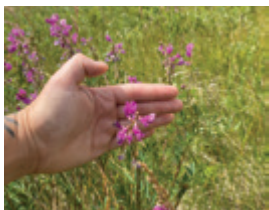

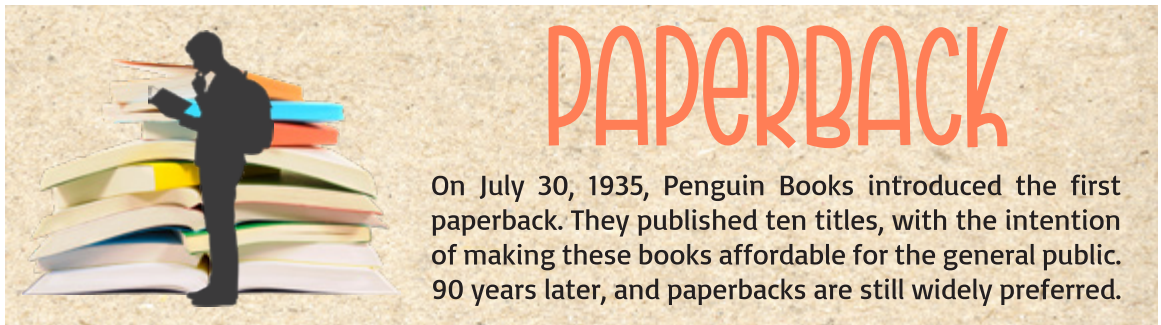

Taxing Homeowners Guide

The City offers some helpful hints in their Homeowner's Guide. Pay your property tax bill on time to avoid penalties. Every property has its own unique nine-digit roll number. If you moved, make sure you have the correct one. If you sold a property, cancel your previous enrolment and then join with your new address. If you own multiple properties or a condo, pay the tax for each property using its unique roll number. For condos, each titled space (e.g., living space, parking, storage) has its own roll number and is considered a separate property. You can use a property tax calculator to estimate your bill. You will find recent previous tax bills in myTax, an online resource for more detailed information. Register for a secure account and sign up for eNotice to receive your assessment online. Join the Tax Instalment Payment Plan (TIPP) to pay your property tax month-by-month. Review your property assessment every year. If you have concerns submit a request to discuss your property information and details. The team can explain how the market value was determined and refer you to sales of similar properties in your neighbourhood. You may also file a complaint about your assessment with the Assessment Review Board, if you believe the value is incorrect or if other information on your assessment notice is not accurate. You cannot appeal your taxes, but you can appeal your property assessment during the Customer Review Period. You must still pay your taxes on time, even if you plan to appeal. Call 3-1-1 if you have any questions. The assessment complaint process resets annually. If you disagree with your current assessment, you must file a new complaint. Assessment Notices and Property Tax Bills are translated into the most requested languages. Visit www.calgary.ca/property-owners/taxes/new-homeowner-guide.html for more information.

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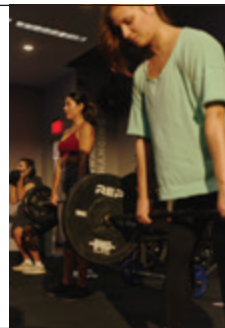


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
